This petition is respectfully submitted to the court as a last avenue to stop and correct the unfair, biased and unconstitutional statewide televised U.S. Senate forum sponsored by LPB and CABL set for October 18, 2016 at Louisiana Tech University.

This petition seeks to challenge these groups' right to set unfair minimum criteria in which qualified U.S. Senate candidates can participate in this forum, in particular but not limited to the requirement that a candidate have ONE MILLION DOLLARS in their campaign fund. This is not only unreasonable but also discriminates against a citizen of Louisiana and the United States based upon their financial standing.

The urgency of this petition is due to the fact that this upcoming statewide-televised forum is only one of two that are planned and will prevent all of the uninvited candidates from getting their messages rightfully heard across the state.

LPB and LETA are funded by over \$8 million in state taxpayers' money. CABL enjoys a nonprofit, tax-exempt status and Louisiana Tech University is publicly funded. This forum's "Pay to Play" criteria undermines each of these entities' core missions and the very reason for their existence.

In no way should public funds be used to promote one candidate over another. This forum's criteria will use taxpayer money to promote the rich candidates and shut out the poor candidates.

It is incumbent upon all of us to protect the public's confidence in the election process and give voters the freedom to learn about all the candidates in deciding who they will cast their ballot for.
