As grounds therefor, Plaintiff alleges as follows: 26

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 1. The court has jurisdiction over this action pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(B) and 28 U.S.C. § 1331.
- 2. Venue is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1391(e).

PARTIES

- 3. Plaintiff Harold Edward Rutila IV is a resident of Grand Prairie, Texas. Plaintiff submitted the relevant FOIA requests while residing in Michigan, but has since moved. Plaintiff seeks to promote transparency, accountability, and integrity in government. Plaintiff has been impacted by Defendants' actions with respect to Plaintiff's employment with Defendant Federal Aviation Administration.
- 4. Defendant U.S. Department of Transportation ("DOT") is an agency of the United States Government, within the meaning of FOIA, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(f). DOT is a cabinet-level department. Through its various operating administrations, the DOT promulgates regulations and policies governing transportation within the United States, including aviation. DOT is headquartered at 1200 New Jersey Avenue, SE. Washington, DC 20590.
- 5. Defendant Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") is the national aviation authority of the United States. As an operating administration and component of the DOT, it has authority to regulate all aspects of American civil aviation. The

FAA retains possession, custody, and control over the records sought by Plaintiff.

FAA is headquartered at 800 Independence Ave SW, Washington, DC 20591.

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

- 6. Plaintiff challenges Defendants' failure to provide responsive documents, or an adverse determination, within the statutory time limits required by FOIA.

 Defendants have therefore constructively denied Plaintiff's requests, pursuant to 5

 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(C).
- 7. Plaintiff is consolidating several FOIA requests within the same action, in an attempt to conserve resources for all parties and this Court. All requests are not related, but all requests do involve the same requestor and agency.
- 8. The Department of Transportation is considered the "agency", within the meaning of FOIA, for FOIA requests submitted to the Federal Aviation Administration.
- 9. The Federal Aviation Administration is an operating administration and component within the agency that is the DOT. 49 CFR § 7.2.
- 10. The time limits with respect to FOIA begin "after the request is received by the appropriate FOIA Requester Service Center designated in [49 CFR] § 7.27." 49 CFR § 7.31.

2016-009143 - "Emails of FAA Academy Officials"

11. On or about September 7, 2016, Plaintiff submitted a FOIA and PA request via electronic mail seeking access to records under both the FOIA and PA concerning

- Plaintiff, including emails and chat messages from January 1, 2016 to the present for five named agency employees. See Exhibit 1 2016-009143 Submission.
- 12. Plaintiff submitted the above mentioned request to the appropriate component and operating administration of the DOT, the FAA, pursuant to 49 CFR Part 7.
- 13. Defendant FAA's timer to begin processing the request began on September 7th.
- 14. On or about September 7, 2016, Plaintiff received an electronic message from

 Defendant FAA Employee Terry Julian stating that he is "[...] no longer the FOIA

 coordinator. In the future please go to the FOIA website to submit your request

 [...]." See Exhibit 2 2016-009143 Julian Email.
- 15. On or about September 14, 2016, Defendant FAA acknowledged the request and assigned the request tracking number 2016-009143. *See* Exhibit 3 2016-009143

 Acknowledgment.
- 16. Defendant assigned the request to the Aeronautical Center and the Air Traffic Organization. *Id*.
- 17. On or about September 21, 2016, Plaintiff received correspondence from Defendant FAA Employee Dean Torgerson, assessing fees in the amount of \$184.00 for the request. See Exhibit 4 2016-009143 Fee Assessment.
- 18. On or about September 21, 2016, Plaintiff replied to the correspondence from Defendant FAA Employee Dean Torgerson, and agreed to pay \$184 for the request. *See* Exhibit 5 2016-009143 Fee Concurrence.

- 19. On or about September 21, 2016, Plaintiff was told by Defendant FAA Employee

 Dean Torgerson that payment would not have to be made in advance. *See* Exhibit

 6 2016-009143 Pre-Payment.
- 20. On or about October 11, 2016, Plaintiff notified Defendant of a change of address.

 See Exhibit 7 Change of Address.
- 21. Plaintiff has yet to receive any other communication from Defendant FAA regarding this request.
- 22. Plaintiff incorporates the original request and all correspondence as if fully restated herein.
- 23. As of the date of the Compliant, Defendants have failed to: (i) produce the requested records or determine that the requested records are lawfully exempt from production; (ii) notify Plaintiff of the scope of any responsive records

 Defendant intends to produce or withhold and the reasons for any withholdings; or (iii) inform Plaintiff that it may appeal any adequately specific, adverse determination.
- 24. As more than twenty working days have passed since the date the request was received by the appropriate component and operating administration of the DOT, Defendants have therefore constructively denied Plaintiff's request. Plaintiff is therefore eligible to bring forth the instant action. 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(A)(ii). 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(C)(i).

25. Defendant is unable to charge search fees for this request, as it has failed to provide responsive records within the statutory time limits. 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(viii).

- 26. On or about September 7, 2016, Plaintiff submitted a FOIA and PA request via electronic mail seeking access to records under both the FOIA and PA concerning Madeline Bostic's Equal Employment Opportunity ("EEO") informal complaint.

- 27. Plaintiff submitted the above mentioned request to the appropriate component and operating administration of the DOT, the FAA, pursuant to 49 CFR Part 7.
- 28. Defendant FAA's timer to begin processing the request began on September 7th.
- 29. On or about September 14, 2016, Defendant FAA acknowledged the request and assigned the request tracking number 2016-009145. *See* Exhibit 9 2016-009145

 Acknowledgment.
- 30. Defendant assigned the request to the Office of Audit and Evaluation and the Human Resources Office within the FOIA Program Management Branch and the Air Traffic Organization. *Id*.
- 31. Plaintiff alleges that the Office of Civil Rights is also likely to have responsive records.

- 32. Plaintiff has yet to receive any other communication from Defendant FAA regarding this request.
- 33. On or about October 11, 2016, Plaintiff notified Defendant of a change of address.

 See Exhibit 7 Change of Address.
- 34. Plaintiff incorporates the original request and all correspondence as if fully restated herein.

- 39. Plaintiff submitted the above mentioned request to the appropriate component and operating administration of the DOT, the FAA, pursuant to 49 CFR Part 7.
- 40. Defendant FAA's timer to begin processing the request began on September 7th.
- 41. On or about September 11, 2016, Defendant FAA Employee Edward Drake

 ("Drake") requested clarification regarding the time period subject to the request.

 See Exhibit 11 2016-009149 Clarification Drake Email.
- 42. On or about September 11, 2016, Plaintiff replied to Drake's request for a time period for the request. See Exhibit 12 2016-009149 Clarification Drake Reply.
- 43. On or about September 14, 2016, Defendant FAA acknowledged the request and assigned the request tracking number 2016-009149. *See* Exhibit 13 2016-009149

 Acknowledgment.
- 44. Defendant assigned the request to the Aeronautical Center and the Air Traffic Organization. *Id*.
- 45. On or about September 15, 2016, Plaintiff received an email from 9-AMC-FOIA-Request@faa.gov, stating, in part, that additional clarification was still needed.

However, no question was presented to Plaintiff. See Exhibit 14 – 2016-009149

September 15th Email.

- 46. On or about September 16, 2016, Plaintiff received an email from 9-AWA-FOIA-Request@faa.gov, stating, in part, that clarification regarding the request and the maximum dollar amount willing to be paid was requested. *See* Exhibit 15 2016-009149 September 16th Email.
- 47. On or about September 16, 2016, Plaintiff replied to the request for clarification regarding the request, and requested that a fee estimate be provided. *See* Exhibit 16 2016-009149 September 16^{th} Reply Email.
- 48. On or about October 6, 2016, Plaintiff again received correspondence from Drake requesting that clarification regarding the request and the maximum dollar amount willing to be paid be provided. See Exhibit 17 2016-009149 October 6th Rutila Email.
- 49. Plaintiff had already replied to Defendant's September 16th email for clarification.

 See Exhibit 16 2016-009149 September 16th Email.
- 50. Notwithstanding that Plaintiff had already replied to Defendant's clarification request, Plaintiff again replied to Defendant's clarification request, by forwarding a copy of the previous reply, as well as providing notice that a reply was previously sent. See Exhibit 18 2016-009149 October 6th Rutila Email. See Exhibit 19 2016-009149 October 6th Rutila Forward.

- 51. On or about October 7, 2016, Drake apologized to Plaintiff for not seeing the reply. Drake again asked for a maximum dollar amount. *See* Exhibit 20 2016-009149 October 7th Drake Apology Email.
- 52. On or about October 7, 2016, Drake requested confirmation regarding Plaintiff's phone number, and requested that a "maximum fee threshold" be provided for all requests. *See* Exhibit 21 2016-009149 October 7th Drake Phone Email.
- 53. On or about October 7, 2016, Drake provided Plaintiff a fee estimate in the amount of \$2,570.00. See Exhibit 22 2016-009149 October 7th Drake Fee Assessment.
- 54. On or about October 7, 2016, Plaintiff replied to Drake's fee assessment and phone number verification email, stating that the agency was overdue on the request and that it may not assess search fees. See Exhibit 23 2016-009149

 October 7th Rutila Fee Reply.
- 55. On or about October 11, 2016, Plaintiff notified Defendant of a change of address.

 See Exhibit 7 Change of Address.
- 56. On or about October 12, 2016, Plaintiff received an email from Drake, reiterating Defendant FAA's position that the request is not overdue. See Exhibit 24 2016-009149 October 12th Drake Email.
- 57. On or about October 13, 2016, Plaintiff emailed Drake regarding the request, restating Plaintiff's previous position that the statute is being read incorrectly with

respect to the due date for the request. See Exhibit 25 – 2016-009149 October 13th
Rutila Email. This email was sent after Drake left a voicemail message to Plaintiff.

- 58. On or about October 13, 2016, Plaintiff received an email from Drake, stating, in part, again, that Defendant FAA is still on time. *See* Exhibit 26 2016-009149

 October 13th Drake Email.
- 59. On or about October 13, 2016, Plaintiff replied to Drake's email, stating, in part, again, that parties differed on their reading of the statute. Plaintiff explained his position, again, and notified Defendant of intent to seek judicial review. *See*Exhibit 27 2016-009149 October 13th Rutila Email II.
- 60. On or about October 13, 2016, Plaintiff received an email from Drake, stating, in part, that a fee estimate letter was provided on October 7, 2016 via certified mail. Drake also stated that "Per FOIA requirements (32 CFR 701.8 (a)(1)), since fees are applicable to your request, and we have not received, in writing, a statement regarding your willingness to pay the fees, your request will be placed in abeyance pending your good faith commitment to pay the fees necessary to process the request." See Exhibit 28 2016-009149 October 13th Drake Abeyance Email.
- 61.32 CFR applies to National Defense.
- 62. FAA FOIA regulations are codified in 49 CFR.
- 63. FOIA regulations at 32 CFR do not apply to FAA.

- 64. The tracking number provided by Drake, 7006 0100 0003 0829 9740, does not identify any record of the letter being sent on October 7th. See Exhibit 29 2016-009149 USPS Confirmation.
- 65. A fee assessment sent by Defendant FAA after the due date for the request is untimely.
- 66. To the extent Defendant FAA sent a fee assessment on time, Defendant FAA would not have been able to charge fees for the request once the due date for the request lapsed.
- 67. Plaintiff challenges Defendant FAA's fee assessment as being excessive and unreasonable.
- 68. Plaintiff has yet to receive any other communication from Defendant FAA regarding this request.
- 69. Plaintiff incorporates the original request and all correspondence as if fully restated herein.
- 70. As of the date of the Compliant, Defendants have failed to: (i) produce the requested records or determine that the requested records are lawfully exempt from production; (ii) notify Plaintiff of the scope of any responsive records Defendant intends to produce or withhold and the reasons for any withholdings; or (iii) inform Plaintiff that it may appeal any adequately specific, adverse determination.

- 71. - 99. On or about September 14, 2016, Defendant FAA acknowledged the request and assigned the request tracking number 2016-009152. *See* Exhibit 35 2016-009152

 Acknowledgment.
- 100. Defendant assigned the request to the Air Traffic Organization. *Id.*
- 101. On or about October 11, 2016, Plaintiff notified Defendant of a change of address. See Exhibit 7 Change of Address.
- 102. Plaintiff has yet to receive any other communication from Defendant FAA regarding this request.

- 112. On or about September 22, 2016, Plaintiff received correspondence via electronic message from Defendant's employee Edward Drake stating, in part, that he would be the point of contact for the request. *See* Exhibit 38 2016-009192

 Drake Correspondence.
- 113. On or about September 24, 2016, Plaintiff replied to Defendant's September 22, 2016 email, and acknowledged receipt. See Exhibit 39 2016-009192 Drake Reply.
- 114. On or about October 11, 2016, Plaintiff notified Defendant of a change of address. *See* Exhibit 7 Change of Address.
- Plaintiff has yet to receive any other communication from Defendant FAA regarding this request.
- Plaintiff incorporates the original request and all correspondence as if fully restated herein.

- 117. As of the date of the Compliant, Defendants have failed to: (i) produce the requested records or determine that the requested records are lawfully exempt from production; (ii) notify Plaintiff of the scope of any responsive records

 Defendant intends to produce or withhold and the reasons for any withholdings; or (iii) inform Plaintiff that it may appeal any adequately specific, adverse determination.
- 118. Count I: Violation of FOIA: Failure to Comply With Statutory Deadlines

- 120. Plaintiff fully restates and incorporates by reference all previous paragraphs as if fully restated here.
- 121. Defendants are violating FOIA by failing to search for and provide all records responsive to Plaintiff's requests or demonstrate that the requested records are lawfully exempt from production.

- Plaintiff is being irreparably harmed by reason of Defendant's violation of FOIA, and Plaintiff will continue to be irreparably harmed unless Defendant is compelled to comply with FOIA.
- 123. To trigger FOIA's administrative exhaustion requirement, Defendants were required to determine whether to comply with Plaintiff's request within twenty working days of receiving the request, which is the same date as the initial submission, as the request was submitted to the appropriate component and operating administration of the DOT, the FAA.
- Plaintiff seeks that this Court order Defendant to provide responsive records and complete an adequate search.
- 125. Plaintiff is entitled to injunctive relief compelling the release and disclosure of the requested agency records.

REQUESTED RELIEF

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays this Court:

- (1) order Defendant to conduct a search for any and all responsive records to

 Plaintiff's FOIA requests and demonstrate that it employed search methods reasonably
 likely to lead to the discovery of records responsive to Plaintiff's FOIA requests;
- (2) order Defendant to produce, any and all claimed nonexempt records to Plaintiff's FOIA requests and a Vaughn index of any responsive records withheld under claim of exemption;

- (3) grant Plaintiff an award of attorneys' fees and other litigation costs reasonably incurred in this action pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(E);
 - (4) Expedite this proceeding as provided for in 28 U.S.C. § 1657;
- (5) Refer the inappropriate handling of FOIA requests for investigation, under the authority of 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(F);
 - (6) Declare the agency's actions to be arbitrary, capricious, and an abuse of discretion
