Just to follow up on these questions from Friday in terms of the campaign finance claim. Here's what we found going through Alter's campaign finance reports:

Alter raised \$10,886 from donors outside of the city, less than the \$36,000 cap; raised \$900 from non-individuals, under than the \$24,000 cap on donations from political action committees; spent \$61,556.74, less than the \$75,000 cap for the general election; and expended \$563.67 out of her personal funds, less than the \$3,750 cap. The figures come from the most recent campaign finance reports, which detailed spending and fundraising up to eight days before the election.

By our count and the city clerk's count, it appears she would have qualified for the public funds without needing a waiver. What do you guys make of this? Does the campaign have a response?
