President Obama Visit

Situation:

On Tuesday afternoon, July. 22, 2014, at [REDACTED] 1(c) President Barack Obama will arrive in Seattle, landing at King County International Airport (Boeing Field). The motorcade will depart Boeing Field at [REDACTED] 1(c) and will be escorted to a residence in the Madrona neighborhood of Seattle to attend a fund raising event. Following the event, at [REDACTED] 1(c) the President will travel via motorcade to a residence in Hunts Point for a second fund raiser. The President will leave that event at [REDACTED] 1(c) travelling back to the Boeing Field to reboard Air Force One. He will leave Seattle at [REDACTED] 1(c)

Mission:

The mission of all the law enforcement agencies participating in the security for this visit is to provide executive protection and escort for the President of the United States and those traveling with him.

Concept of Operation:

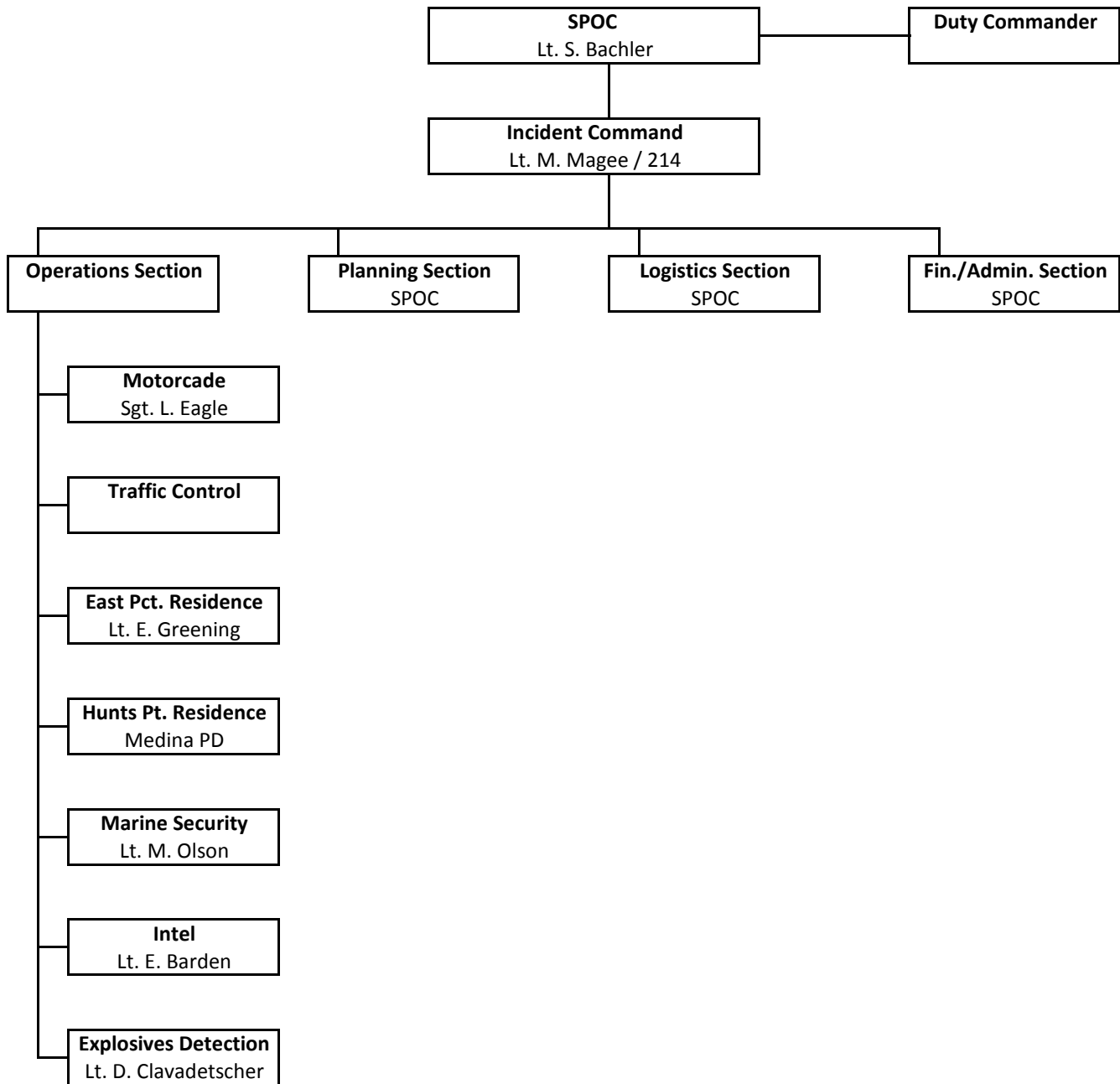
- Lt. Mike Magee will be the Seattle Police Incident Commander assigned to this visit. He will oversee the activities relating to the motorcade, the East Precinct residence event and the marine security.
- Medina PD Acting Chief Dan Yourkoski will serve as the Incident Commander at the Hunts Point residence.
- KCSO Captain Don Davis will serve as the Incident Commander for King County International Airport (Boeing Field).
- The Seattle Police Operations Center (SPOC) will be activated for this visit. The Operations Center will also serve as the communications and coordination center for the USSS. The [REDACTED] 1(c) [REDACTED] 1(c) in SPOC during this visit.
- SPD [REDACTED] 1(c) at the East Precinct residence, the Hunts Point residence and for the motorcade.
- KCSO will handle security and traffic control requirements at Boeing Field.
- The SPD Traffic Section will coordinate with WSP for all motorcade movements.
- CIS will provide on-going situational awareness throughout the event and will coordinate criminal intelligence information with the U.S. Secret Service.
- The SPD [REDACTED] 1(c) will assist the USSS with [REDACTED] 1(c) [REDACTED] 1(c).
- Marine security will be provided by the combined resources of SPD, KCSO, Mercer Island PD and the USCG. These agencies will coordinate to provide waterside security at [REDACTED] 1(c)

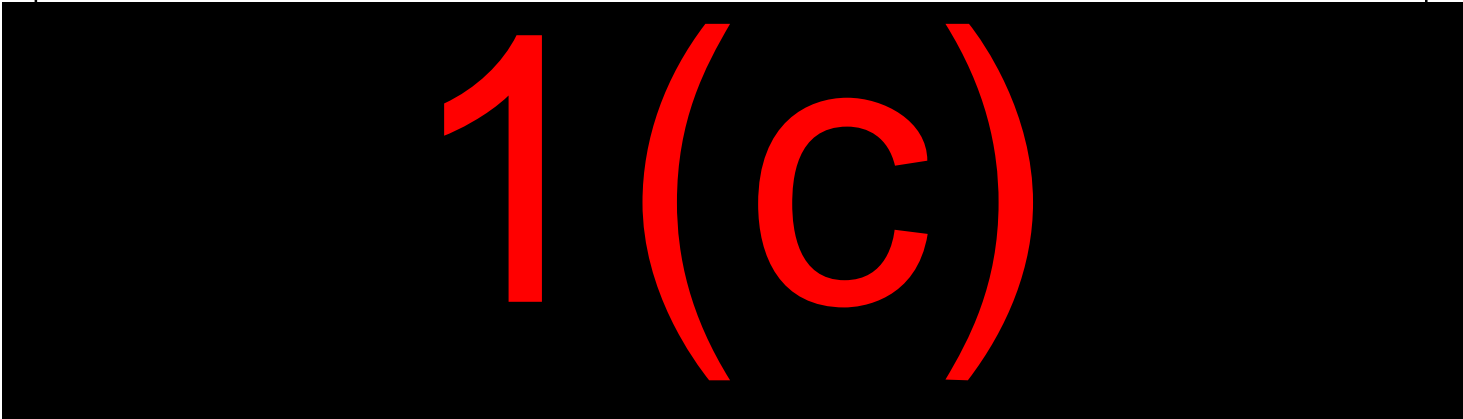
