

- 1. I have probable cause to believe that between the dates of 10-01-1997 until 05-23-1998, Matthew C. Lindsey W/M 11/23/1968 at 508 Crispin Street, Richmond, Ray County, Missouri, 64085 committed one or more criminal offense(s): Statutory Rape-RSMO 566.034
- 2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 11-16-2016 at 0956 hours, I Detective Scott Childers conducted an interview with who graduated Richmond High School in 1999 and attended all four years of High School at Richmond. Advised she gave rides to Lindsey's home located on the corner of Crispin and Ralph Street in Richmond. She can remember at least two times in which she drove to the residence. Would drop off down the street and would walk to the house because Lindsey did not want yehicle parked outside of the house. Could not remember the exact dates but is certain she and were sixteen because was pregnant at the time and did not give birth to her child until four days after she turned seventeen.

#### COUNT I

in violation of Section 566.034, RSMo, committed the class C felony of statutory rape in the second degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or between October 1, 1997 and May 23, 1998, in the County of Ray, State of Missouri, the defendant had sexual intercourse with A.N.W. and at that time A.N.W. was less than seventeen years old and the defendant was twenty-one years of age or older.

### RANGE OF PUNISHMENT:

Class C FELONY:

The range of punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years of not less than 2 years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine.

#### Class C FELONY:

The range of punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years of not less than 2 years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine.
