Dear Judge Motz:

I am writing to advise the Court of an incident involving the above-named defendant that took place on January 31, 2012. At approximately 2:20 PM that afternoon, the defendant refused to "lock in" to his jail cell. As a result, he was cuffed and transferred to another section of the facility. The defendant's cell was inventoried, and among the defendant's personal items, which he identified for the jail guards, was a banner he had made. The banner was subsequently turned over to the FBI.

I have attached a photograph of the banner, which depicts crossed swords, an AK-47, and Arabic writing, including Chapter 9, Verse 20 from the Qu'ran with the defendant's translation written below. The second photograph is a close-up of the defendant's translation of Verse 20. This particular passage from the Qu'ran has been interpreted as an incitement to violent jihad and martyrdom. FBI Language Services has reviewed the Arabic writing and translated it as follows:

There is no god but Allah, and Muhammad is the messenger of Allah

In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful

Those who believe, and have left their homes and striven with their wealth and their lives in [Crossed Swords] ALLAH [AK-47] Allah's way are of much greater worth in Allah's sight. These are they who are triumphant. (20)

I provided all of the materials relevant to the jail incident to Mr. Balter a number of weeks ago. For reasons to be explained further at the hearing on Friday, the government believes that the sentence provided for in the plea agreement is appropriate in this case.
