I am responding to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated December 16, 2015 that we received on December 23, 2015.

I am not able to send the information you requested by January 25, 2016, which is the 20 business-day period allowed by law. The FOIA allows an additional ten-day statutory extension in certain circumstances. To complete your request I require the additional time to:

- Search for and collect the requested records from other locations
- Search for, collect, and review a large volume of records
- Consult with another agency or Treasury component
- Consult with business submitters

We have extended the statutory response date to February 8, 2016, after which you can file suit. An administrative appeal is limited to a denial of records, so it does not apply in this situation. I apologize for any inconvenience caused by this delay.


You may file suit after February 8, 2016. Your complaint will be treated according to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure applicable to actions against an agency of the United States. These procedures require that the IRS be notified of the pending suit through service of process, which should be directed to:
