**CONSENT MOTION OF THE ANTI-DEFAMATION LEAGUE FOR LEAVE
TO FILE AMICUS-CURIAE BRIEF IN SUPPORT OF INTERVENOR-
PETITIONERS**

The Anti-Defamation League respectfully requests leave to file an amicus-curiae brief in support of the challenge of Commonwealth of Virginia and other intervenor-petitioners to Executive Order 13,769, 82 Fed. Reg. 8977 (Feb. 1, 2017), which purported to “Protect[] the Nation From Foreign Terrorist Entry Into the United States.” ADL sought and has received consent from the parties to its motion.
