Thank you for reaching out to invite me to meet with TTFA President David John-Williams in Miami. I would be happy to meet with him this Friday, or next week if he will still be in the area.

Please know, however, that Telemundo rejects any suggestion that U.S. Spanish-language rights to World Cup qualifier home games of the Trinidad & Tobago men¹s national team are somehow still on the market. As I¹m sure you know, Telemundo acquired those rights, along with the rights to other CONCACAF qualifier matches, in a transaction with Traffic Group and Media World in December 2014. For more than two years after we acquired those rights, we never heard a word from TTFA that called into question the legitimacy of Traffic¹s sale of the rights to Telemundo. The dates of two of the Trinidad & Tobago games are swiftly approaching on March 24 and 28. Any attempt by TTFA to market the rights to the games, or to hinder Telemundo¹s ability to broadcast the games, would be an interference with Telemundo¹s contract rights.

I look forward to hearing from you about Mr. John-Williams<sup>1</sup> availability.
