

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) appeal dated February 13, 2006. You are appealing the January 31, 2006, decision of Mr. Darryl R. Aaron, the Initial Denial Authority (IDA), to deny your FOIA request (06-0100), for any and all information or records pertaining to "directed energy devices."

On January 31, 2006, the IDA stated:

"Please be advised that our search for responsive records encompassed only those records in existence as of January 10, 2006, the date your request was received by this office. We have conducted a thorough search of our files and found no records responsive to your request."

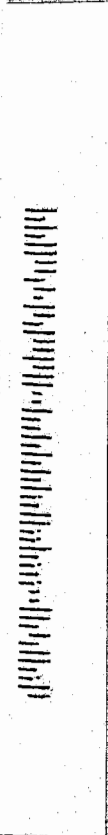

This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request submitted via the Internet on 19 January 2006, which was received by this office on 20 January 2006, for records on all private contractors affiliated with the Department of Defense and the National Security Agency currently working/operating/testing equipment/devices in Greene County, Tennessee and Tennessee to include:

- (1) Information related to the use/testing of all nonlethal weapons (to include directed energy devices: acoustic, microwave and other like devices);
- (2) Names of the contractors affiliated with these uses/experiments along with consensual and nonconsensual subjects used for testing; and
- (3) Any data obtained from these studies/tests.

Your request has been assigned Case Number 48099. For purposes of this request and based on the information you provided in your letter, you are considered an "all other" requester. As such, you are allowed 2 hours of search and the duplication of 100 pages at no cost. There are no assessable fees for this request.

Your request has been processed under the provisions of the FOIA. A thorough search of our files was conducted, but no records responsive to your request were located.

The fact that we were unable to locate records responsive to your request may be considered by you as an adverse determination, and you are hereby advised of this Agency's appeal procedures. Any person notified of an adverse determination may file an appeal to the NSA/CSS Freedom of Information Act Appeal Authority. The appeal must be postmarked no later than 60 calendar days after the date of the initial denial letter. This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of 22 December 2005, which was received by this office on 23 December 2005, for "all information relating to domestic surveillance activity by the United States National Security Agency, Department of Defense, and the Central Intelligence Agency on United States citizens in the United States and its territories from the dates of September 2001 until December 22, 2005. All information regarding the specific technology/technologies used by the aforementioned agencies to collect information on U.S. citizens in the United States and its territories."

We are also in receipt of your FOIA request dated 29 December 2005, which you sent to the Department of Defense (DoD). DoD referred the request to our agency on 6 January 2006, so that we could respond to the portion of your request for "information and records regarding the National Security Agency (NSA) surveillance of U.S. citizens in the United States and its outlying territories. Specifically any and all records and documents describing the types of technology/technologies used to surveill U.S. citizens. Please particularly disclose whether 'directed energy devices' (i.e., acoustic and microwave, radio devices) are/were used to surveill U.S. citizens and the specific types used and on which individual U.S. citizens and the dates of surveillance."

Your FOIA requests have been assigned Case Numbers 47889 and 47975, respectively. We have aggregated your cases to provide you with a single response letter. For purposes of these requests and based on the information you provided in your letters, you are considered an "all other" requester. As such, you are allowed 2 hours of search and the duplication of 100 pages at no cost. There are no assessable fees for these requests. Your requests have been processed under the provisions of the FOIA.

As you know, the President of the United States "authorized the National Security Agency [(NSA)], consistent with U.S. law and the Constitution, to intercept the international communications of people with known links to al

Qaeda and related terrorist organizations.” The President also noted that, “[t]his is a highly classified program that is crucial to our national security.”

So that we can provide you the clearest and most succinct response possible, we have divided your two requests into three sections. The following response is provided regarding sections #1 and #3:

Section #1: Information relating to domestic surveillance activity by National Security Agency

Section #3: Records that detail which individual U.S. citizens have been targeted and the dates of surveillance

Other than the two enclosed items, the information responsive to sections #1 and #3 of your requests has been found to be currently and properly classified in accordance with Executive Order 12958, as amended. The information meets the criteria for classification as set forth in Subparagraphs (c) and (g) of Section 1.4 and remains classified TOP SECRET as provided in Section 1.2 of Executive Order 12958, as amended. The information is classified because its disclosure could reasonably be expected to cause exceptionally grave damage to the national security. Because the information currently and properly classified, it is exempt from disclosure pursuant to the first exemption of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(1)).

Furthermore, this Agency is authorized by various statutes to protect certain information concerning its activities. Accordingly, the information responsive to these two portions of your requests is exempt from disclosure pursuant to the third exemption of the FOIA which provides for the withholding of information specifically protected from disclosure by statute. The specific statutes applicable in this case are Title 18 U.S. Code 798; Title 50 U.S. Code 403-1(i); and Section 6, Public Law 86-36 (50 U.S. Code 402 note).

Finally, the information responsive to these two portions of your requests is exempt from release pursuant to the fifth exemption of the FOIA. This exemption applies to inter-agency or intra-agency memoranda or letters which would not be available by law to a party in litigation with the agency, protecting information that is normally privileged in the civil discovery context, such as information that is part of a predecisional deliberative process, and/or attorney-client privileged information, and/or attorney work product.

The following response is provided in reference to section #2:

Section #2: Records describing the types of technology used to surveill U.S. citizens, and whether directed energy devices (acoustic, microwave, radio devices, etc.) are/were used

Because of the highly classified nature of the program, specific details regarding aspects of the program and the fact of whether or not any specific technique or method or activity is employed in that effort are exempt from release pursuant to the exemption provisions of the FOIA. That information is a classified matter in accordance with Executive Order 12958, as amended.

Thus, section #2 of your requests is denied pursuant to the first exemption of the FOIA, which provides that the FOIA does not apply to matters that are specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive Order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign relations and are properly classified pursuant to such Executive Order.

Moreover, the third exemption of the FOIA provides for the withholding of information specifically protected from disclosure by statute. Thus, this portion of your two requests is also denied because details of the program and the fact of whether or not any specific technique or method or activity is employed in that effort are exempt from disclosure pursuant to the third exemption. The specific statutes applicable in this case are Title 18 U.S. Code 798; Title 50 U.S. Code 403-1(i); and Section 6, Public Law 86-36 (50 U.S. Code 402 note).

Since most of your two requests has been denied, you are hereby advised of this Agency's appeal procedures. Any person notified of an adverse determination may file an appeal to the NSA/CSS Freedom of Information Act Appeal Authority. The appeal must be postmarked no later than 60 calendar days after the date of the initial denial. The appeal shall be in writing addressed to the NSA/CSS FOIA Appeal Authority (DC34), National Security Agency, 9800 Savage Road STE 6248, Fort George G. Meade, MD 20755-6248. The appeal shall reference the initial denial of access and shall contain, in sufficient detail and particularity, the grounds upon which the requester

believes release of the information is required. The NSA/CSS FOIA Appeal Authority will endeavor to respond to the appeal within 20 working days after receipt, absent any unusual circumstances.

(U) Today, the New York Times published the article "Bush Lets U.S. Spy on Callers Without Courts." In short order, it was proliferated by the national and international print and electronic media.

(U) In the face of public query or criticism the leadership and people of NSA have always attended to duty and respectfully declined to comment on intelligence operations - actual or alleged. I'm taking this opportunity to remind all members of the workforce that we will continue to perform in kind. We do not comment on intelligence operations, actual or alleged - to do so is professionally irresponsible and may put Americans or allied personnel in peril.

(U) As were my predecessors, I am committed to ensuring that NSA operates within the law. Charged with the obligation to secure our nation, we are equally obligated to preserve and protect our citizens constitutional rights. We do so collaboratively with our oversight committees; the legal and intelligence communities and the executive branch to ensure that any contemplated operations are done so lawfully. Rest assured that any operation, regardless of sensitivity, is conducted within the law and in the best interest of our nation.

(U) On Saturday, 17 December, President Bush confirmed the existence of a highly classified SIGINT program. At a press conference on Monday, 19 December, he elaborated on the program's legal basis. Transcripts of each address are available at:

(U) The President's confirmation came shortly after the New York Times revealed the program's existence and alleged that NSA was "... spying on Americans ...". As a result, our enemies may adjust their tactics, techniques, or procedures and in turn compromise our national defense. The President referred to the disclosure as "... a shameful act." The President stated that this classified program "is critical to the national security of the United States." The President further stated "the unauthorized disclosure of this effort damages our national security and puts our citizens at risk."

(U) The existence of a program and its legal basis were confirmed, but the operational details of the program and its execution remain highly classified and must be protected in order that we may effectively do our part to combat global terrorism.

(U) Media coverage surmises that Administration and Agency officials may have acted unlawfully -- notions I reject, categorically! The NSA operation is rooted in the President's constitutional authority as Commander-in-Chief. Attorney General Gonzales reiterated this position before the Washington Press Corps on Monday, 19 December 2005.

(U) The President authorized NSA to execute this program consistent with U.S. law and our Constitution. To guarantee adherence to the

law the authorization has been reviewed over thirty times, approximately every forty-five days, since inception. The authorization and the operation were reviewed and deemed legal by the previous and current Attorneys General. Over a dozen briefings were presented to key leaders of Congress and the intelligence oversight committees. Our NSA activities are thoroughly scrutinized by our General Counsel and Inspector General, and offices within the Department of Justice. The program has been implemented with careful and attentive oversight at multiple levels. This program, as authorized and as implemented, appropriately balances our charge to help secure the Nation against foreign threats and the privacy rights of U.S. persons.

(U) It is obvious to everyone that NSA has been prominent in print and broadcast coverage. I anticipate the debate to continue well into the new year. Congress may even schedule hearings related to the program. Overall, we are not concerned; our operations are carefully deliberated and measured; they are within the law; and they are nobly executed with strict oversight. What is important is that we at NSA must remember that we are still a nation at war – and that our cryptologic activities are essential to the success of our policy makers, warfighters, and allies. We must not allow public discourse to distract us from our work: to protect and safeguard our nation.



Please forward any and all information related to DOD and NSA's involved activities/surveillance/experimentation on persons in the United States and/or in Greene County, Tennessee.
