What are the types of establishments that do not accept EBT cards? What specific foods, products, or services cannot be purchased using EBT cards?

Cash assistance (Temporary Assistance to Needy Families) benefits cannot be transacted or used in any liquor store, casino, gambling casino or gaming establishment, jewelry store, tattoo parlor, massage parlor, body piercing parlor, spa, nail salon, lingerie shop, tobacco paraphernalia store, vapor cigarette store, psychic or fortune telling business, bail bond company, video arcade, movie theater, swimming pool, cruise ship, theme park, dog or horse racing facility, pari-mutuel facility, or sexually-oriented business, or any retail establishment which provides adult-oriented entertainment in which performers disrobe or perform in an unclothed state for entertainment, or in any business or retail establishment where minors under age 18 are not permitted. Cash assistance may not be used to buy items such as alcohol, cigarettes, tobacco products, lottery tickets, concert tickets, professional or collegiate sporting event tickets, or tickets for other entertainment events intended for the general public or sexually oriented adult materials. Cash assistance may not be used for purchases at points of sale outside the state of Kansas.

The Kansas Benefits Card with SNAP benefits may only be used at retailers authorized by United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Services to accept the card. The USDA website lists eligible food items.
