Narrative

On 1/7/08, I, Detective Hopkins #0705 was assigned to the Fugitive Unit of APD. My investigation revealed that the suspect had a warrant for a Malishia Booker, DOB [REDACTED] who was possibly living or staying at 7407 Lake Front Tr in Arlington.

The warrant was for theft of rental property. The bond was set by a judge at \$1000; warrant 0107596 out of APD. I made sure the warrant was in the PC file, cut a call sheet with Dispatch to attempt to make contact at the location.

Called for an officer and Officer Mathis #2101 arriving to assist. After briefing him on the situation and showing him a picture of the suspect, we both made our way to the front door of the location. It should be noted that Officer Mathis was in the marked squad car in full police uniform. I was in plain clothes with a black jacket on with a badge on my left chest and the word Police to my right chest. We knocked on the door at approximately 0625 hrs. After several minutes a B/F answered the door peering around the door, and at this point I did recognize her from the picture in my possession as my suspect. I advised her we were both police officers and requested we enter. At this point she did let us into the foyer. It should be noted again she matched the description of the picture I had in my possession. I asked her what her name was and she did in fact advise, Malishia Booker.

I advised her she was under arrest for the felony warrant. At this point she was compliant, and due to that compliance, she was in a state of semi-undress from waking her up out of bed and I allowed her, although she had apparently a long t-shirt or something on of a gown, I allowed her to put a robe on. It should be noted there were 3 small children all under the age I believe of 12 in the home. Again, due to her level of cooperation prior to handcuffing and physically taking custody of her, I allowed her to make several phone calls with a friend from down the street named Charlotte, came to in fact take custody of the small children.

Charlotte left the location with the children and the suspect was actually physically arrested. I handcuffed her behind her back and double locked the handcuffs. I locked her door on the way out and she was placed in the right back seat of Officer Mathis' car by Officer Mathis and seat belted in. She was transported to the jail by Officer Mathis.

Once at the jail I retook custody of the suspect and in fact allowed Officer Mathis to clear the scene. I booked her in, released her to the jailers on duty. She stated nothing of the original offense, other than it was a big mess. She also stated she does not have any of the property she was accused of stealing. I made sure the warrant was pulled out of the PC file, cleared the warrant with Dispatch. Again the arrest took place at 0630 hrs.
