

An ordinance authorizing and permitting the Confederate Monument Association of St. Louis, Missouri, to erect and maintain a monument to the confederate soldiers and sailors in Forest Park, and directing the Park Commissioner to select a suitable location therefor such as may be mutually agreed upon between the Park Commissioner and the representatives of the confederate monument association.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Assembly of the City of St. Louis, as follows:

Section One: The Confederate Monument Association of St. Louis, Missouri, is hereby authorized and permitted to erect and maintain a monument to the Confederate Soldiers and Sailors in Forest Park in the City of St. Louis, Missouri.

Section Two: The Park Commissioner of the City of St. Louis, Missouri, is hereby directed to proceed at once to select, locate and set aside suitable place in Forest Park on which said Confederate Monument Association can erect said monument.

Section Three: Said monument is to be erected and maintained at the expense of said Confederate Monument Association of St. Louis.

Section Four: The location of the said monument shall be such as may be mutually agreed upon between the said Park Commissioner of the city of St. Louis and representatives of the Confederate Monument Association of St. Louis, Missouri.
