Notes

- Aid & Assist Patients include those under ORS 161.370 and ORS 161.365
- As noted above, the final number of patients discharged in March, April and May of 2017 that readmitted as Aid & Assist within 90 days will not be known until the end of August 2017
- The number of patients who readmitted and readmitted as Aid & Assist could potentially increase as more patients are admitted – these data are current as of 6/8/2017
- The number of Aid & Assist patients discharged during the entire timeframe are not limited to unique patients only, this allows us to include any patient who was readmitted more than once - if limited to unique patients discharged over the time period you would capture the first readmission but not any subsequent discharge and readmission
