Hi Tarryn

At this point I am uncomfortable coming in for an on-the-record interview without knowing the details of what you are going to talk about. It sounds like I would/could be walking into a situation that I do not want to find myself in. As you know, there is a lot of anti-refugee media out there these days and I want to be careful.

I have talked with the IRC Resettlement caseworkers yesterday and they have told me that they have not told clients not to talk to a landlord about how many people are on a lease. IRC's policy is to have everyone that is living in the apartment to be on the lease. If there is an oversight, then the refugees should absolutely talk to the property management company and fix the oversight.
