That respondent Shannon Bushey withdraw certification of the August 1, 2017 petition to recall Petitioner, and that real parties in interest, the sponsors of the recall petition, be enjoined from circulating the petition while it has the misleading and inaccurate statement: "We demand an election of a successor to that office."
