DEATH REPORT

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Officers responded to Goodyear, 1901 Goodyear Blvd., for a report of cardiac arrest.

Upon arrival Off. Godfrey and Cpl. McCormick were taken to the in-plant medical facility.

There on a gurney was a W/M with obvious injuries to his left chest and blood coming from his left armpit area. The W/M's face appeared to be swollen and his eyes were swollen shut.

Clothing had been cut off of the W/M and it was obvious that some medical procedures had been performed.

The W/M was deceased.

The W/M was identified by DLSC member Jordan Moorefield.

This information was on a EMS Quick Registration Form.

The W/M was William Scheier [REDACTED]

Ronnie Setliff, Emergency Response Brigade member for Goodyear, stated that Scheier was a maintenance worker.

He stated that Scheier was working on an Alphashear machine #16 adjusting a switch when he was injured.

He states that it is believed that Scheier was leaning through an access panel into the machine when the machine activated and pinned Scheier in the machine.

Alan Sampson was reportedly working with Scheier at the time. Sampson left work before Officers arrival and has not been spoken to at this time.

Setliff states that Scheier was unresponsive and that CPR was started at 6:20am.

Scheier was at some point taken to the medical area of the plant.

Setliff stated that at the time he and his crew arrived at the machine Scheier had no apparent injuries.

He states that they did not notice the puncture wound until CPR was started and blood started spurting from the left armpit area.

He also states that the swelling did not occur until CPR was started.

Keith Carrol, DLSC, stated that he contacted DRMC ER and explained the situation to Dr. Lekwuwa.

He states that Dr. Lekwuwa pronounced Mr. Scheier at 6:46am and Carroll states that he verified this with DRMC RN Brittany Gauldin.
