This office has been advised that your request for the investigation of Danny Ray Johnson involving a juvenile victim is denied pursuant to KRS 610.320(3) and 610.340 which state that all law enforcement and court records regarding children who have not yet reached their eighteenth birthday shall not be opened to scrutiny by the public. The release of the investigative file for this incident by LMPD's Crimes Against Children Unit would be in clear violation of the cited statutes. I can tell you the case / investigation was closed by exception which means the complainant either withdrew the complaint or refused to cooperate.
