I hope this message finds you well. I just spoke with our USPS liaison and we have been informed that the USPS Office of the Inspector General unfortunately decided not to pursue the investigation because it is a management issue (i.e. manager operations). The liaison followed up with management at the Madison facility and shared that there have been several "stand ups" or group talks where general discussion among employees has taken place. Also, the manager shared that a supervisor has been assigned to monitor employees to ensure that they are taking proper timed breaks and that no one is overstepping their bounds on break time. We are hopeful this will aid the situation.

While I know this response may not be the outcome we had hoped for, I am encouraged that efforts are being made to change the culture of the workplace. From the OIG's perspective, this is their final response to your concerns. If you have further concerns, I have been informed that you may appeal.
