PRELIMINARY REVIEW ORDER-VEHICLE (FINAL)

Spencer Byrd on court on temporary Hardship mg/v

This matter coming before the Court pursuant to the provisions of 725 ILCS 150/3.5 or 720 ILCS 5/36-1.5, the Court having been appraised of the facts, and having made a finding of probable cause to seize, the matter now before the Court for a determination as to whether the seizure of the above captioned vehicle has created a substantial hardship, there is a finding that:

A substantial hardship exists A substantial hardship does not exist _____

If a substantial hardship does not exist, it is further ordered that said vehicle shall be held pursuant to the provisions of the applicable statute noted above pending administrative or judicial forfeiture proceedings as set forth therein.

If a substantial hardship exists, it is hereby ordered that said vehicle shall be released to: Spencer Byrd and said vehicle may be driven only by this person or persons pursuant to the following conditions: over State object

Fair Market Value is set at \$ 1,600. A cash security shall be posted with the Clerk of the Circuit Court in the amount of \$ 30,000. The designated driver(s) must possess a valid driver's license. The vehicle may not be removed from Cook County. The vehicle must be properly registered, have valid license plates, a city sticker (if applicable), and be insured. The vehicle may only be driven subject to the following:

SHALL NOT DETERMINE THE VALUE OF THE VEHICLE OR ENCUMBER IT IN ANY WAY. MUST ALSO SAFEGUARD THE VEHICLE. CLAIMANT SHALL MAINTAIN FULL LIABILITY AND COLLISION INSURANCE.

Failure to comply with any of the above provisions or committing a new traffic, cannabis, methamphetamine, or controlled substance offense while driving this vehicle may result in the forfeiture of the cash security and such other sanctions as deemed appropriate by the Court, including, but not limited to, re-seizure of the vehicle by any peace officer wherever the vehicle may be found in the State of Illinois. Additionally, a failure to return the vehicle, in substantially the same condition as when released, to the seizing law enforcement agency, within seven days of the issuance of a Declaration of Forfeiture, pursuant to the above noted statutes, will result in the forfeiture of the cash security in the same manner as the vehicle and shall render the vehicle subject to seizure by any peace officer wherever the vehicle may be found in the State of Illinois.
