Dear Mr. Perez,

This letter is to acknowledge your email, dated April 30, 2018, in which you make an Open Records Act request, regarding the following:

Copies of all available emails, documents and email attachments exchanged, from Jan. 1, 2016 and April 30, 2018, between officials at the Oklahoma Attorney General's Office and the Federalist Society's Leonard Leo.

Known email addresses include: leonard.anthony.leo@gmail.com; ll@leonardleo.com; leonard.leo@hotmail.com; lleo@fed-soc.org; and leonard.leo@fed-soc.org. If your office is aware of any additional email addresses affiliated with Mr. Leo, please include them in this search as well.

Please understand "officials" to include individuals holding the following titles at any point during the time period specified: Attorney General; Solicitor General; Chief Deputy Attorney General; First Assistant Attorney General; and Deputy Attorney General.

Oklahoma's Open Records Act, 51 O.S.2011 & Supp.2016, §§ 24A.1 – 24A.30, requires an agency to provide "prompt, reasonable access" to records while employing reasonable procedures to



protect the integrity and organization of the records and to prevent excessive disruption of the agency's essential functions. 51 O.S.Supp.2016, § 24A.5(5).

We are reviewing your request and will be conducting a search for responsive records. Our review process includes initial intake, records search, legal review, and redaction of privileged or exempted records that may be captured by the search. Although the Oklahoma Open Records Act generally presumes all records are open, it includes many exemptions and exceptions to this general rule, such as an exemption which permits our office to maintain the confidentiality of our litigation and investigation files. 51 O.S. § 24A.12. If your request is particularly large in scope or includes any records subject to these exemptions or exceptions, it may take additional time to review and fulfill your records request.

Please do not hesitate to contact our office if you have any questions or you would like to narrow the scope of your request. We look forward to working with you.
