MS. MOONEY: I'm actually going to sustain his objection because we have limited this. It's the omission of the information rather than the reason for dismissal from USC is the relevant issue here.

MR. PYLES: Okay.

BY MR. PYLES:

Q. So, Dr. Finn, after learning for the first time that Mr. Isaacs had not included the USC dismissal, participation and dismissal in any of his materials, what did you decide to do?

A. I think at that stage, we were concerned about moving forward with his continuing in the program, although we had been more than willing to work with Jeff around performance issues. The issues of fraud and misrepresentation were those that we did not feel like we could tackle effectively in the training program and the decision, you know, was made that he could not return.

MR. PYLES: Thank you, Dr. Finn. I do not have any further questions.
