This is the initial agency decision on your October 17, 2017, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, 5 U.S.C. § 552, to the Department of State (DOS) for documents sufficient to show how long the portion of the U.S. DOS website on which individuals apply for the immigrant visa lottery has been usable. You also requested additional records related to this topic.
