Those present met on May 8, 1978 to discuss results of the 90 day animal studies carried out at International Research and Development Corporation. The dosing phase of the studies on rats using FC-95, FM-3422 and FC-143 have been completed. Results indicate that FC-95, FM-3422 and FC-143 are toxic.

After a review of the data and a review of the March 16, 1978 EPA guidelines for reporting substantial risk under the Toxic Substances Control Act, it was decided that the toxicity of FC-95, FM-3422 and FC-143 does not constitute a substantial risk and should not be reported at this time.
