You will recall granting Admiral Hillenkoetter an appointment at 10:15 A. M. on October 24, 1950. After leaving your office the Admiral confidentially advised Agent DeLoach that he had conferred with Admiral Souers regarding the apparent stupidity of Mr. William Jackson, new Deputy Director of CIA, and he felt that Admiral Souers would attempt to do something about replacing Jackson as soon as this could be done without raising too much fuss.

The Admiral also commented that he was indeed relieved to know that you fully "knew the score" about the blundering and corruption of OSS and certain elements of CIA.
