I have attached the Draft Policy that I will be submitting to the Deputy Chiefs and Chief. I understand that some of you have some experience with the SAVE program. I can appreciate that, and I know that you will add value to this project. The policy draft that I have added is close to SAVE. Let me also remind you that I've had to adapt to the "Infamous Video" and some minimal information that was passed on to me. Let me also add, that I have studied this subject and had a great appreciation to the Tactics used by industry leaders, all before SAVE was the big push.

April 12th: 2100-0400 ASI Exercise: Millenia Mall. I will coordinate with S& L for the use of 2 reserve Engines. That means I will need personnel to pick-up and return the units.

April 17th: Time TBA, Location TBA. Post Exercise Review and lessons learned. This meeting is to review everything that occurred and I expect some recommendations, not complaints.
