On August 5, 2016, several local officers along with members of the United States Marshal executed an arrest warrant at 3129 Candlewood Dr., Apt. D in East Point, Georgia. According to their statements, the officers exchanged gunfire with Jamarion Robinson, causing them to fire over ninety (90) times and striking Robinson at close range more than fifty (50) times. United States Marshal Service Policy Directive 2.1 requires that a supervising officer complete a USM-122 Use of force form after each officer-involved shooting. Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. Section 552, please provide the USM-133 Use of Force report concerning the United States Marshals Service (USMS) Case No:1619-0804-3527-S. Furthermore, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. Section 552(a)(3)(B), please provide the requested information in an electronic format. Please note that 5 U.S.C. Section 552(a)(3)(B) states that an "agency shall provide the record in any form or format requested by the person if the record is readily reproducible by the agency in that form or format." If this request is denied in whole or part, please provide a justification for all exemptions by reference to the specific statutory code-section relied upon for said exemption. If any portion of this request is denied, please let this also serve as notice that the requester reserves the right to appeal any such denial. As I am requesting this information as a public organization and this information is of timely value. Thank you in advance.
