#### REFERENCE:

On Monday, July 24, 2017 at approximately 12:41 a.m. Mississippi Bureau of Investigation/Crime Scene Unit (MBI/CSU) received a crime scene request from MBI Captain Kenneth Bailey to respond to a police officer involved shooting in Southaven, MS. MBI Captain Bailey reported MBI Master Sgt. Jeris Davis was in charge of the investigation. Upon arrival Master Sgt. Davis and Southaven Police Department Investigator Mark Little reported that on Sunday, July 23, 2017 at approximately 11:50 p.m. Officer Maze and Officer Durden arrived at the residence to locate a suspect in a domestic violence incident that occurred in Tate County. After the victim, Rodriguez, reportedly opened the front door, a dog exited the residence and Rodriguez brandished his rifle. Officer Durden and officer Maze were reportedly standing in the front yard on opposite sides of the front porch. One officer fired one shot at the dog and the other officer fired four shots towards the front porch. The victim sustained an apparent gunshot wound to the base of his skull. EMT performed medical care to no avail.

#### **NARRATIVE SUMMARY:**

On Monday July 24, 2017 at approximately 1:15 a.m. the undersigned and MBI/CSU Analyst Kristopher Wingert arrived at the aforementioned address to begin the examination of the crime scene. The crime scene was at a single wide mobile home facing east and was located in a residential neighborhood. Upon arrival numerous law enforcement vehicles, an ambulance, and unmarked investigator vehicles were on scene. The area surrounding the property was dark and poorly lit with little or no ambient light. A utility pole with an orange light was in the back yard behind the mobile home. Yellow crime scene tape secured the crime scene and was tied across the front and sides of the property. Three mail boxes were near the

edge of the road in front of the residence. The south (left) black mailbox with a wooden pole attached was labeled "5881" on the side, the black middle mailbox with a blue pole attached with the word "SPEARS" in red above it had the letter "B" on the side, and the north (right) black mailbox with a wooden pole attached was labeled "A" on the side. The front yard was mostly dirt with little or no grass. A gravel driveway was on the south side of the property. Two large trees were on the north and south sides of the front yard. The large tree on the south side had two signs attached to it and were facing the street/drive way. The sign on top was black with red letters and was labeled "BEWARE OF DOG", the sign underneath was white with black letters and was labeled "NEVER MIND THE DOG BEWARD OF OWNER". A picture of a hand holding a handgun was also depicted on the sign. Numerous vehicles (Ford Sport Trac, Honda, and Dodge Truck), various tools, numerous buckets, trash items etc. were in front of the residence scattered along the south side of the front yard. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" and a projectile were on the ground southeast of the small wooden front porch. The projectile created an impact mark in the dirt next to a black tire iron tool beside a ladder leaning against the awning. The distance from the front of the vehicle near the cartridge case to the left edge of the front entry/exit door on the front porch was approximately 23'5". Three (3) cartridge cases stamped "WIN 9mm Luger+P", one (1) cartridge case stamped "Speer 9mm Luger+P12", and a magazine containing fifteen (15) live rounds stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" were on the ground northeast of the front porch. The distance from the center mass of the four cartridge cases and the magazine to the left edge of the front entry/exit door on the front porch was approximately 19' 1".

The dimensions of the mobile home was approximately 55'9" x 11'9". Blue under pinning (trailer skirt) was attached to the lower front portion of the home. Numerous windows, some partially covered with cardboard boxes, and curtains hanging from others were across the front of the mobile home. A concrete slab/patio approximately 9' 10 ½" x 9' 11" was across the center front of the mobile home. The concrete slab/patio was approximately 7" high. Various tools, a lawn mower, a large metal tool box, etc. were stored along the south area of the concrete slab/patio. An awning attached to the mobile home was above the concrete slab/patio which measured approximately 7'10" high. Along the north edge of the concrete slab/patio were three wooden steps on the east and south sides of a small wooden porch at the north edge of the concrete slab/patio. The east bottom step was approximately 5 3/4" high, the second step was approximately 7" high, and the top step was approximately 6 1/2" high. The small wooden porch measured approximately 4'1 x 4'1". One wooden handrail with planters and other various items on top was attached to the north edge of the small wooden front porch. An apparent entry projectile defect was on the outer (north) right side of the wooden hand rail. The porch light was on and the front door was open. The exterior side of the front entry/exit door was dark brown in color, constructed of metal, with a rectangular shaped window right of the door knob. The door opened to the inside and the door knob was on the left (south) side. Three apparent projectile entry defects were on the door. One defect was in the bottom portion of the window frame and the other two defects were in the lower center portion of the door.

Entrance into the residence was through the front door which led into the living room area. The living room was in complete disarray with various items (water bottles, blanket, pillow, shoes, papers, books, medical trash, etc.) scattered on the floor. The victim was face down in the center of the living room floor with an apparent entry gunshot wound to the base of his skull. Blood was on his upper back, shoulder, back of neck, and arms. His hands were handcuffed behind his back. He was wearing red athletic type shorts with a black stripe. A white "Nike" tennis shoe was on his right foot and his left foot was bare. The matching white tennis shoe was on the floor between his legs. A pool of wet blood was on top of a blue blanket and on the floor to the left (east) of him. A larger pool of wet blood with various drag mark patterns and footwear impression patterns in the blood were on the floor to the right (west) of him. After the handcuffs were removed by officers and the victim was turned over, numerous EKG pads with silver colored snaps were attached to his thighs and arms. Three (3) larger pads (AED) with electrical cords attached were on his chest and abdominal area. Blood was on his chest, abdominal area, arms, shoulders,

neck, and face. There were no other apparent gunshot wounds observed on him. A brown couch with a multicolored flowered sheet draped over it was against the east living room wall. A long rifle labeled "REMINGTON ARMS, MODEL 550-I, 22 S.L. & L.R. Rifle, oB9" was on top of a pillow on the couch. The serial number was not observed. The butt of the rifle was resting on the right arm of the couch, the trigger mechanism was facing the couch (east) and was resting on top of a white pillow, and the barrel was against the crease of the couch. A black card labeled "Ardell Wispies Multipack" was resting on top of the barrel. The safety latch was off, one (1) live round stamped "C" was removed from the chamber, and sever (7) live rounds stamped "C" were removed from the tube. A lap top computer with an electrical cord attached and a water bottle were on top of the left side of the couch. Candy boxes, a lotion bottle, a water bottle, a purple floral purse, etc. were scattered along the top portion of the couch. The couch was in front of a large window with a curtain. A television stand with a television on top and various other items was against the southwest corner of the living room. A brown armchair with a yellow blanket across it was against the south wall. A small amount of blood was on the lower portion of the yellow blanket. An ottoman and a chair was against the west wall next to the window with and air conditioner. The northwest corner of the living room was cluttered with tables, chairs, plastic bags containing various items, a paint can, water bottles, etc. A large window with a blue curtain draped over it was against the west wall. A window air conditioner unit (which was on) was in the window. An apparent projectile defect was in the upper left edge of the curtain. Behind the curtain near the left side of the window frame was a through and through projectile defect. The projectile exited the mobile home and continued and was not recovered. Left of the window frame against the west wall near cable connectors was an apparent through and through projectile defect. The projectile exited the mobile home and continued and was not recovered.

The kitchen was north of the living room. Unwashed dishes were in the sink, a table with chairs was in the center of the kitchen, the counters were cluttered with food items and dishes, a clothes dryer was against the west wall, etc. A hallway, two bedrooms, and a bathroom were south of the living room. The rooms were cluttered with various items on the floors, on top of the bed, dresser, bathroom counters, etc.

#### ASSISTANCE RENDERED:

The crime scene was documented with photographs and notes. The cluster of cartridge cases - three (3) stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" and one (1) stamped "SPEER 9mm LUGER+P12" on the ground northeast of the front wooden porch were photographed, collected, and marked for identification as Exhibit #1- #4. The magazine containing the fifteen (15) live rounds stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" on the ground northeast of the front wooden porch was photographed, collected, and marked for identification as Exhibit #5. The one (1) cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" southeast of the front wooden porch was photographed, collected, and marked for identification as Exhibit #6. The "REMINGTON ARMS Model 550-I, 22 L.R. Rifle" with the live rounds on top of the living room couch were photographed, collected, and marked for identification as Exhibit #7. The projectile collected from an impact mark on the ground southeast of the front wooden porch was photographed, collected, and marked for identification as Exhibit #8. The projectile collected from the wooden railing on the right (north) side of the front wooden porch was photographed, collected, and marked for identification as Exhibit #9.

Multiple trajectory rods, a laser, and colored string were used to document, locate, and determine the path of the projectiles.

Projectile defect #1 (D-1) was on the exterior side of the front entry/exit door below the window. Orange trajectory rods were used to document the defect. The directionality of this projectile originated from the outside. The trajectory had an approximate angle of departure (horizontal angle) of 129° from right to left and an approximate angle of elevation (vertical angle) of 86° with a slight upward slope. The projectile

entered the living room and entered/exited the west wall left of the window. The defect on the door measured approximately 3 '5 '4" from the bottom of the door and approximately 9 '4" from the left edge of the door. The defect on the west wall left of the window was also marked defect #1(D-1) and measured approximately 4'7" from the floor. String and a laser light were used to determine the trajectory of the projectile and if the door was open or closed. It was determined the door was slightly opened approximately 1 '4" when the projectile passed through it and exited the mobile home. The projectile was not recovered.

Projectile defect #2 (D-2) was on the exterior side of the front entry/exit door. Pink trajectory rods were used to document the defect. The directionality of this projectile originated from the outside. The trajectory had an approximate angle of departure (horizontal angle) of 139° from right to left and an approximate angle of elevation (vertical angle) of 88° with a slight upward slope. The projectile entered the living room and entered and entered/exited the west wall right of the cable connectors. The defect on the door measured approximately 2'9 ½" from the bottom of the door and approximately 1'6½" from the left edge of the door. The defect on the west wall right of the cable connectors was also marked as defect #2 (D-2) and measured approximately 2'9¾" from the floor and 1'4¾" from the left edge of the window. String and a laser light were used to determine the trajectory of the projectile and if the door was open or closed. It was determined the door was slightly opened approximately 3" when the projectile passed through it and exited the mobile home. The projectile was not recovered.

Projectile defect #3 (D-3) was on the exterior side of the front entry/exit door. Green trajectory rods were used to document the defect. The directionality of this projectile originated from the outside. The trajectory had an approximate angle of departure (horizontal angle) of 145° from right to left and an approximate angle of elevation (vertical angle) of 89° with a slight upward slope. The projectile entered the living room and entered the base of the victim's skull. The defect on the door measured approximately 2'5" from the bottom of the door and approximately 1'34" from the left edge of the door. String and a laser light were used to determine the trajectory of the projectile and if the door was open or closed. It is unknown if the door was open or closed when the projectile passed through it and struck the victim in the base of his skull.

Projectile defect #4 (D-4) was on the right side of the wooden hand rail. A red trajectory rod was used to document the defect. The directionally of this projectile originated from the outside. The trajectory had an approximate angle of departure (horizontal angle) of approximately 37° from left to right and an approximate angle of elevation (vertical angle) of 88°. The defect on the hand rail measured approximately 4'10 ½" from the ground. The projectile entered the right (north) side of the wooden hand rail and did not exit. The projectile inside the wooden hand rail and was photographed, collected, and marked for identification as Exhibit #9.

#### **EVIDENCE DISPOSITION:**

Exhibit #1- #9 were submitted to the Mississippi Forensics Laboratory (MFL) for Forensic Analysis under MFL Case #17-010893. Results of evidence examinations and reports thereof will be the subject of separate reports available through the Mississippi Forensics Laboratory.

Two hundred sixty-seven (267) color digital images in NEF format were taken with a Nikon D610 digital camera during crime scene processing and transferred to a compact disc. The original compact disc in NEF format and an additional working copy in JPEG format will be maintained in the Master File. A scanned copy of the report packet in (portable document format) pdf and a copy of the compact disc in JPEG format will be provided to the requesting agencies. An additional copy of the digital images and a copy of this report will be uploaded and saved to the Mississippi Department of Public safety ADSi Case Management System for long term retention.

#### **REMARKS:**

CSU was initially notified to respond to 5878 Surrey Lane, Southaven, MS and upon arrival it was discovered that the correct address was 5881 Southaven, MS

Brown paper bags were taped around the victim's hands by MBI/CSU to preserve potential evidence.

On July 31, 2017 at approximately 2:00 p.m. MBI/CSU Amber Conn went to the crime scene to take additional measurements outside the residence.

This shooting occurred while the Southaven Police Officers were attempted to locate Samuel Pearman of 5878 Surrey Lane, Southaven, MS, who was wanted for aggravated assault in Tate County. The officer arrived at 5881 Surrey Lane, Southaven and encountered Ismael Lopez, who pointed a loaded rifle towards Officer Durden after officers knocked at his door, which led to the shooting death.

## **Summary**

The purpose of this investigative report is to outline from all available evidence, the facts and circumstances that occurred before, during and after the death of Ismael Rodrigues Lopez on Monday, July 24, 2017 at 5881 Surrey Lane, Southaven (Desoto County), Mississippi.

This case was initiated when 26 year old W/M, Samuel Pearman allegedly committed Domestic Aggravated Assault against 26 year old W/F, Katie Sullivan in Tate County, Mississippi. Pearman fled prior to law enforcement arriving, which led to Deputy Perry requesting assistance from the Southaven Police Department locating Pearman at 5878 Surrey Lane, Southaven, MS.

Southaven Police Patrolman, Officer Zachery Durden, Officer Samuel E. Maze and SGT Thomas Jones responded to the area to attempt to locate Pearman at 5878 Surrey Lane. They approached a residence thought to be 5878 Surrey Lane, which was later determined to be 5881 Surrey Lane. The residence was occupied by 36 year old H/M, Ismael Rodriguez Lopez, 45 year old H/F, Claudia Gonzalez Linares and a dog. They were awakened by a knock and the barking dog. Ismael got up and went to the door.

According to the officers, the porch light went out, the door opened which allowed the dog to run out and Ismael was observed pointing a Remington .22 caliber rifle towards Officer Durden. At approximately the same time, Officer Maze encountered the dog and fired one shot as the dog charged aggressively.

As Officer Durden was giving verbal commands to Ismael to drop the weapon, he heard the single shot while he continued to observe Ismael with the rifle. Officer Durden fired numerous rounds towards Ismael, striking Ismael as he fled away from the door. Ismael sustained apparent gunshot wound to the back of his head, which Ismael later succumbed to his injuries, which resulted to death.

## Investigative Facts, Findings and Circumstances

On Sunday, July 23, 2017 at approximately 2022 hours, Tate County Sheriff

Department (TCSD) Deputy Stanley Perry (<a href="hereinafter referred to as Deputy Perry">hereinafter referred to as Deputy Perry</a>) was investigating a domestic assault at the Citgo located at 9670 Hwy 306 in Tate County Mississippi. It was alleged that Samuel Dwayne Pearman (<a href="hereinafter referred to as Pearman">hereinafter referred to as Pearman</a>) of 5878 Surrey Lane of Southaven, MS allegedly committed domestic aggravated assault upon Katie Sullivan of 5881 Sycamore Road of Coldwater, MS.

Pearman fled the scene prior to the arrival of TCSD.

At approximately 2350 hours, Deputy Perry contacted Southaven Police

Department (SPD) for assistance with in attempting to locate Pearman at 5878 Surrey

Lane, Southaven MS. The attempt to locate request was broadcast via police radio and

SPD Patrol Officers Zachary Durden (aka Zack), Samuel Maze (aka Sam) and SGT Thomas

Jones (aka Tom) responded to the area. (Hereinafter referred to as Officers Maze, Durden and SGT Jones)

At approximately 0019 hours, SPD Patrol Officers Maze, Durden and SGT Jones arrived on Surrey Lane, Southaven MS and located a mobile home thought to be 5878 Surrey Lane, which was later identified as 5881 Surrey Lane. Officer Durden knocked at the door of the residence, as Officers Maze and SGT Jones observed from a distance.

The officers could hear someone walking towards front door of the residence before they observed the porch light go out. As the door opened, an aggressive dog exited and a male later identified as Ismael Rodrigues Lopez (herein after referred to as

Lopez) appeared at the door aiming a rifle at Officer Durden.

At the same time, the aggressive dog charged at Officer Maze. This resulted in Officer Maze firing one shot at the dog with his duty weapon (Glock 17 9mm, serial # BAYZ260).

At approximately the same time, Officer Durden was verbally commanding Lopez to drop the weapon repeatedly while continuing to observe the threat of the rifle. Officer Durden allegedly fired numerous rounds from his duty weapon (Glock 17 Gen 4, 9mm, serial # BAY326). Officer Durden observed Lopez lying on the floor prior to being directed to take cover from addition threats.

Short time later, Southaven dispatch was informed of the shooting and EMS was requested to respond.

At approximately 12:30 a.m., I, Mississippi Bureau of Investigation (MBI) Agent Jeris Davis received a telephonic call from the MBI acting Lieutenant Bryan Sullivant regarding the officer involved shooting on Surrey Lane Southaven, MS.

#### On Scene Briefing

At approximately 12:50 a.m., I arrived and met with Southaven Police Detectives, Lt. Mark Little and Detective Seth Kern and received the following summary of information surrounding the shooting death.

## Summary of what was said...

< SPD Officers Zachary Durden, Samuel Maze and SGT Tom Jones were
 assisting Tate County Sheriff Dept. (TCSD) with locating Samuel Dewayne
 Pearman for the charged of domestic aggravated assault.

In doing so, Officer Durden, Maze and SGT Jones arrived and approached the

mobile home and Officer Durden knocked at the door, which lead to Ismael approached and opening the entrance door. As Ismael opened the door an aggressive dog charge at the Officers Maze and Lopez pointed a rifle at Officer Durden, which led to Officer Durden command him to put the gun down before firing numerous shots at Lopez >. **End of Summary.** 

Moments later, Mississippi Bureau of Investigations Crimes Scene Analyst Dywana Broughton and Kristopher Wingert arrived and received a briefing of the known details surrounding shooting incident. CSU examined the scene and collected the following items:

Item # 1. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard northeast of the porch.

Item # 2. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard northeast of the porch.

Item # 3. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard northeast of the porch.

Item # 4. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" form the yard northeast of the porch.

Item # 5. A magazine containing 15 live rounds stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard northeast of the porch.

Item #6. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard southeast of the porch.

Item #7. A Remington ARMS, MODEL 550-I, 22 S.L. & R.,OB9, Rifle, no serial number found,

containing one liver round stamped "C" removed from the chamber and seven live rounds

removed from the tube.

Item #8. A projectile remove from the ground from the found southeast of the porch.

Item #9. A projectile removed from the wooden railing north-side of the porch.

I observed yellow crime scene tape securing the wide area ranging from southeast area to the north area of the mobile home bordering Surrey Lane. At the edge of the roadway I notice several mailboxes. One was a black mailbox labeled "5881" attached

the letter "B" attached to a blue metal pole with the vertical numeric "5878" erected from the ground. The third was black mailbox, labeled with the letter "A" attached to pole erected from the ground. There was numerous Southaven Medical staff police personal and patrol vehicles present outside of the tape. The entrance door facing east towards Surrey Lane had a porch light illuminating to the right of the door. There was a concert pad with elevated steps that lead to the entrance doorway.





After entering the opened entrance door, I observed a male later identified as Ismael Rodriguez Lopez lying in a prone position with hands cuffed behind his back in the middle of the floor. The air conditioners located in a window on the west wall was running and a weapon that was later identified as a model 550 Remington .22 caliber rifle bearing serial number 0B9 was positioned on the couch with the barrel pointing in a southern direction.

**NOTE:** CSU Wingert later rendered the rifle safe, removing one live round from the chamber and one live round from the tube. It was observed that safety was in the firing position.



At approximately 2:05 a.m., I located Claudia Gonzalez Linares, who was present in the residence during the shooting incident and was sitting in a Southaven police patrol car. Claudia did not speak English therefore Olive Branch Police Officer Jose Lazo, Badge # 3432 was made available and translated Claudia's recollection of what occurred.

MBI Crime Scene Analyst Dywana Broughton and Kristopher Wingert processed the scene by taking photos and collecting all available evidence.

7/24/17 at approximately 3:07 a.m., Southaven Police Detective Seth Kern relinquished, one Glock 17 Gen 4 Austria, 9mm bearing the serial #BAYZ326 with an attached TLR light. I removed one live round from the chamber collected two magazines containing numerous live rounds that was assigned to Officer Zachery Durden.

Collected by CSU, One Remington arms, Model 550-I, 22 Rifle bearing no visible serial number, which contained numerous live rounds was collected by CSU.

**Note:** Ismael R. Lopez was transported away from the scene by Hernando Funeral Home at the directive of Desoto County Coroner Billy Baldwyn at approximately 0350 hours.

According to Claudia Linares; Claudia and Ismael were in bed around 10:00 p.m. They were awakened by their barking dog. Ismael got up quick and she heard voices and she looked out the window. She saw patrol cars and cops walking, she then heard gun shots and got scared. She indicated to Ismael that it was the police and ran to the living room. She indicated that the entrance door was open and observed her husband lying on the floor. She called for her husband who would not respond. She was directed outside and handcuffed.

### Summary of what SGT Jones indicated...

According to SGT Thomas Jones, on the Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup> 2017 at approximately 0007 hours, they received a call to help locate Samuel Pearman at 5878 Surrey Lane for domestic aggravated assault charges in Tate County.

After Sgt. Thomas arrived of Surrey Lane, he observed Officers Durden and Maze were parked on Neshoba east. Officer Durden and Maze pointed to the residence on the west side of the street. They approached the residence and did not observe any numeric visible.

SGT Jones positioned himself on the southeast corner of the residence to observe the front door and rear of the resident. Officer Durden approached the front door and knocked several times. Officer Maze positioned himself near the center of the residence in the front yard.

SGT Jones observed the porch light on as Officer Durden knocked at the door numerous times. A dog could be heard barking from inside the residence.

A short time later, the porch light was turned off. With the light from the street light SGT Jones saw a large dog run from the residence. Officer Durden activated his flash light, which illuminated the door. SGT Jones could see a gun barrel extend out the door towards Officer Durden. Officer Durden was backing up and yelling "drop the gun" several times. SGT Jones heard a gunshot (Officer Maze fired at the dog). Then Officer Durden fired three to four rounds from his weapon.

Afterwards, Officer Maze and Durden moved for cover towards a large tree in the yard as SGT Jones moved for cover behind a car in the yard.

Next, they could hear a female voice coming from inside the residence, who was later identified as Claudia Linares. Linares complied with commands to exit. She was placed in handcuffs and detained for safety.

A short time later, Officer Long arrived and instructed SGT Jones to leave the scene and go to the station. >

According to Officer Samuel Maze, on Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup> 2017 at approximately midnight Southaven dispatch sent SGT Tommy Jones and Officer Zachery Durden to attempt to locate Samuel Pearman, who was reported to reside at 5878 Surrey Lane. Pearman was wanted for domestic aggravated assault by Tate County Sheriff's Dept. Due to felonious nature of the call, Officer Maze responded to the address to assist.

After arriving, Officer Durden, Maze and SGT Jones arrived near Surrey Lane. SGT Jones utilized a GPS, which indicated the 5878 was located on the west side of Surrey Lane. A decision was made to approach the residence.

Officer Durden approached and knocked on the door. Officer Maze positioned himself near the left side of the door in the front yard. SGT Jones positioned himself near the south end of residence with view of both officers.

After knocking at the door, Officers heard footsteps leading to the front door and the porch light went out. Officer Maze observed Officer Durden activated a flash light to illuminate the

door. Officer Maze then observed the barrel of a rifle protruded from the front door pointed towards Officer Durden.

At the same time, Officer Maze encountered an aggressive dog charging at him from the front porch. Officer Maze began to walk backwards and believed the dog was going to attack him. At the same time, Officer Durden could be heard saying "put the gun down" several times. The dog made a quick lunge towards Officer Maze, which resulted in him firing one round towards the dog.

Afterwards, Officer Maze observed the barrel still pointed at Officer Durden. Officer Durden fired numerous shots towards the front door. The officer retreated to a tree located nearby. Officer Maze went to his vehicle and retrieved a ballistic shield. When he returned, he noticed a female present.

Officer Maze and Durden re-entered the residence to secure it from additional threats. They returned to Ismael Rodrigues Lopez and began to render aid. Officer Maze observed the male breathing laboriously and cuffed the male's hands behind his back.

Moments later, Officer Long arrived and instructed him to return to the station. Detective Bryan Rosenberg took possession of Officer Maze's weapon.>

Officer Durden, Maze and SGT Jones arrived near Surrey Lane and began to look for the address by the numerics on the roadside mailbox. The officers approached a mobile home with a flood light illuminating the front porch located on the west side of Surrey Lane. Officer Durden was doubtful about the address and decided to knock at the door with the thought that someone would answer the door and point them to the correct address.

Officer Durden knocked at the door several times and stepped off the porch positioning himself in the well lite area of the front yard. Officer Durden observed the porch light go out. Officer Durden activated the light attached to his gun to illuminate the door and observed a male aiming a rifle at him. The stock of the rifle was placed in the males' right shoulder and his head was slightly leaning to the right while it was aimed towards him (Officer Durden). This resulted in Officer Durden, yelling "put the gun down" numerous times. As the male positioned himself behind the door, Officer Durden heard a gunshot. Officer Durden fired numerous shots at the male before retreating for cover near a tree in the yard.

A short time later, a female exited the residence with her hands up and yelling. The female was secured by SGT Jones as Officer Durden and Maze secured the residence from addition threats. Officer Durden returned to the room where the male was located and begin providing aid until he was relieved by Officer Tom Long. 


# **Synopsis:**

On Sunday, July 23rd, 2017, Tate County Sheriff Deputy Stanley Perry responded to a domestic disturbance at the Citgo located at 9670 Hwy 306 in Independence. TCSO Deputy Perry obtained information from the victim, Katie Sullivan, w/f, who identified Samuel Dwayne Pearman, II w/m of 5878 Surrey Lane as the suspect. Deputy Perry contacted Southaven PD radio room and requested assistance with locating Pearman at 5878 Surrey Lane.

A short time later, Southaven Officers, Samuel Maze and Zachery Durden arrived on Surrey Lane. The officers approached 5881 Surrey Lane, which is a single wide mobile home which faces east to Surrey Lane.

As the officers approach the resident the entrance door opens, a Pitbull dog exits the house aggressively towards the officers. Shortly, officers encounter Ismael Lopez Rodriguez at the door possessing a 22 caliber rifle.

These actions allegedly resulted to Officer Samuel Maze firing several shots at the aggressive dog and Officer Zackary Durden allegedly fired several rounds at Ismael Rodriguez as he stood at the door exhibiting the 22 caliber rifle.

Short time later, Ismael succumb to death from the gunshot wound and was pronounced deceased by the Desoto County Coroner.

This shooting occurred while the Southaven Police Officers were attempted to locate Samuel Pearman of 5878 Surrey Lane, Southaven, MS, who was wanted for aggravated assault in Tate County. The officer arrived at 5881 Surrey Lane, Southaven and encountered Ismael Lopez, who pointed a loaded rifle towards Officer Durden after officers knocked at his door, which led to the shooting death.

# Summary

The purpose of this investigative report is to outline from all available evidence, the facts and circumstances that occurred before, during and after the death of Ismael Rodrigues Lopez on Monday, July 24, 2017 at 5881 Surrey Lane, Southaven (Desoto County), Mississippi.

This case was initiated when 26 year old W/M, Samuel Pearman allegedly committed Domestic Aggravated Assault against 26 year old W/F, Katie Sullivan in Tate County, Mississippi. Pearman fled prior to law enforcement arriving, which led to Deputy Perry requesting assistance from the Southaven Police Department locating Pearman at 5878 Surrey Lane, Southaven, MS.

Southaven Police Patrolman, Officer Zachery Durden, Officer Samuel E. Maze and SGT Thomas Jones responded to the area to attempt to locate Pearman at 5878 Surrey Lane. They approached a residence thought to be 5878 Surrey Lane, which was later determined to be 5881 Surrey Lane. The residence was occupied by 36 year old H/M, Ismael Rodriguez Lopez, 45 year old H/F, Claudia Gonzalez Linares and a dog. They were awakened by a knock and the barking dog. Ismael got up and went to the door.

According to the officers, the porch light went out, the door opened which allowed the dog to run out and Ismael was observed pointing a Remington .22 caliber rifle towards Officer Durden. At approximately the same time, Officer Maze encountered the dog and fired one shot as the dog charged aggressively.

As Officer Durden was giving verbal commands to Ismael to drop the weapon, he heard the single shot while he continued to observe Ismael with the rifle. Officer Durden fired numerous rounds towards Ismael, striking Ismael as he fled away from the door. Ismael sustained apparent gunshot wound to the back of his head, which Ismael later succumbed to his injuries, which resulted to death.

# Investigative Facts, Findings and Circumstances

On Sunday, July 23, 2017 at approximately 2022 hours, Tate County Sheriff

Department (TCSD) Deputy Stanley Perry (<a href="https://decemperced.org/">hereinafter referred to as Deputy Perry</a>) was investigating a domestic assault at the Citgo located at 9670 Hwy 306 in Tate County Mississippi. It was alleged that Samuel Dwayne Pearman (<a href="https://decemperced.org/">hereinafter referred to as Pearman</a>) of 5878 Surrey Lane of Southaven, MS allegedly committed domestic aggravated assault upon Katie Sullivan of 5881 Sycamore Road of Coldwater, MS.

Pearman fled the scene prior to the arrival of TCSD.

At approximately 2350 hours, Deputy Perry contacted Southaven Police

Department (SPD) for assistance with in attempting to locate Pearman at 5878 Surrey

Lane, Southaven MS. The attempt to locate request was broadcast via police radio and

SPD Patrol Officers Zachary Durden (aka Zack), Samuel Maze (aka Sam) and SGT Thomas

Jones (aka Tom) responded to the area. [Hereinafter referred to as Officers Maze, Durden and SGT Jones)

At approximately 0019 hours, SPD Patrol Officers Maze, Durden and SGT Jones arrived on Surrey Lane, Southaven MS and located a mobile home thought to be 5878 Surrey Lane, which was later identified as 5881 Surrey Lane. Officer Durden knocked at the door of the residence, as Officers Maze and SGT Jones observed from a distance.

The officers could hear someone walking towards front door of the residence before they observed the porch light go out. As the door opened, an aggressive dog exited and a male later identified as Ismael Rodrigues Lopez (herein after referred to as

Lopez) appeared at the door aiming a rifle at Officer Durden.

At the same time, the aggressive dog charged at Officer Maze. This resulted in Officer Maze firing one shot at the dog with his duty weapon (Glock 17 9mm, serial # BAYZ260).

At approximately the same time, Officer Durden was verbally commanding Lopez to drop the weapon repeatedly while continuing to observe the threat of the rifle. Officer Durden allegedly fired numerous rounds from his duty weapon (Glock 17 Gen 4, 9mm, serial # BAY326). Officer Durden observed Lopez lying on the floor prior to being directed to take cover from addition threats.

Short time later, Southaven dispatch was informed of the shooting and EMS was requested to respond.

At approximately 12:30 a.m., I, Mississippi Bureau of Investigation (MBI) Agent Jeris Davis received a telephonic call from the MBI acting Lieutenant Bryan Sullivant regarding the officer involved shooting on Surrey Lane Southaven, MS.

#### On Scene Briefing

At approximately 12:50 a.m., I arrived and met with Southaven Police Detectives, Lt. Mark Little and Detective Seth Kern and received the following summary of information surrounding the shooting death.

< SPD Officers Zachary Durden, Samuel Maze and SGT Tom Jones were
 assisting Tate County Sheriff Dept. (TCSD) with locating Samuel Dewayne

In doing so, Officer Durden, Maze and SGT Jones arrived and approached the

mobile home and Officer Durden knocked at the door, which lead to Ismael approached and opening the entrance door. As Ismael opened the door an aggressive dog charge at the Officers Maze and Lopez pointed a rifle at Officer Durden, which led to Officer Durden command him to put the gun down before firing numerous shots at Lopez >. End of Summary.

Moments later, Mississippi Bureau of Investigations Crimes Scene Analyst Dywana Broughton and Kristopher Wingert arrived and received a briefing of the known details surrounding shooting incident. CSU examined the scene and collected the following items:

Item # 1. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard northeast of the porch. Item # 2. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard northeast of the porch. Item # 3. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard northeast of the porch. Item # 4. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" form the yard northeast of the porch. Item # 5. A magazine containing 15 live rounds stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard northeast of the porch.

Item #6. A cartridge case stamped "WIN 9mm LUGER+P" from the yard southeast of the porch.

Item #7. A Remington ARMS, MODEL 550-I, 22 S.L. & R.,OB9, Rifle, no serial number found,

containing one liver round stamped "C" removed from the chamber and seven live rounds

removed from the tube.

Item #8. A projectile remove from the ground from the found southeast of the porch.

Item #9. A projectile removed from the wooden railing north-side of the porch.

I observed yellow crime scene tape securing the wide area ranging from southeast area to the north area of the mobile home bordering Surrey Lane. At the edge of the roadway I notice several mailboxes. *One was a black mailbox labeled "5881" attached* 

the letter "B" attached to a blue metal pole with the vertical numeric "5878" erected from the ground. The third was black mailbox, labeled with the letter "A" attached to pole erected from the ground. There was numerous Southaven Medical staff police personal and patrol vehicles present outside of the tape. The entrance door facing east towards Surrey Lane had a porch light illuminating to the right of the door. There was a concert pad with elevated steps that lead to the entrance doorway.







After entering the opened entrance door, observed a male later identified as Ismael Rodriguez Lopez lying in a prene position with hands cuffed behind his back in the middle of the floor. The air conditioners located in a window on the west wall was running and a weapon that was later identified as a model 550 Remington .22 caliber rifle bearing serial number 0B9 was positioned on the couch with the barrel pointing in a southern direction.

**NOTE:** CSU Wingert later rendered the rifle safe, removing one live round from the chamber and one live round from the tube. It was observed that safety was in the firing position.

At approximately 2:05 a.m., I located Claudia Gonzalez Linares, who was present in the residence during the shooting incident and was sitting in a Southaven police patrol car. Claudia did not speak English therefore Olive Branch Police Officer Jose Lazo, Badge # 3432 was made available and translated Claudia's recollection of what occurred.

MBI Crime Scene Analyst Dywana Broughton and Kristopher Wingert processed the scene by taking photos and collecting all available evidence.

7/24/17 at approximately 1:35 a.m., Southaven Police Detective Bryan Rosenberg relinquished one Glock 17 Gen 4 Austria 9mm bearing the serial #BAYZ260 with an attached TLR light. I removed one live round from the chamber and collected one magazine containing numerous live rounds. Officer Samuel Maze weapon was collected from SPD Detective Rosenberg.

7/24/17 at approximately 3:07 a.m., Southaven Police Detective Seth Kern relinquished, one Glock 17 Gen 4 Austria, 9mm bearing the serial #BAYZ326 with an attached TLR light. I removed one live round from the chamber collected two magazines containing numerous live rounds that was assigned to Officer Zachery Durden.

Collected by CSU, One Remington arms, Model 550-I, 22 Rifle bearing no visible serial number, which contained numerous live rounds was collected by CSU.

**Note:** Ismael R. Lopez was transported away from the scene by Hernando Funeral Home at the directive of Desoto County Coroner Billy Baldwyn at approximately 0350 hours.

According to Claudia Linares; Claudia and Ismael were in bed around 10:00 p.m. They were awakened by their barking dog. Ismael got up quick and she heard voices and she looked out the window. She saw patrol cars and cops walking, she then heard gun shots and got scared. She indicated to Ismael that it was the police and ran to the living room. She indicated that the entrance door was open and observed her husband lying on the floor. She called for her husband who would not respond. She was directed outside and handcuffed.

## Summary of what SGT Jones indicated...

According to SGT Thomas Jones, on the Monday, July 24th 2017 at approximately 0007 hours, they received a call to help locate Samuel Pearman at 3878 Surrey Lane for domestic aggravated assault charges in Tate County.

After Sgt. Thomas arrived of Surrey Lane, he abserved Officers Durden and Maze were parked on Neshoba east. Officer Durden and Maze pointed to the residence on the west side of the street. They approached the residence and did not observe any numeric visible.

SGT Jones positioned himself on the southeast corner of the residence to observe the front door and rear of the resident. Officer Durden approached the front door and knocked several times. Officer Maze positioned himself near the center of the residence in the front yard.

SGT Jones observed the porch light on as Officer Durden knocked at the door numerous times. A dog could be heard barking from inside the residence.

A short time later, the porch light was turned off. With the light from the street light SGT Jones saw a large dog run from the residence. Officer Durden activated his flash light, which illuminated the door. SGT Jones could see a gun barrel extend out the door towards Officer Durden. Officer Durden was backing up and yelling "drop the gun" several times. SGT Jones heard a gunshot (Officer Maze fired at the dog). Then Officer Durden fired three to four rounds from his weapon.

Afterwards, Officer Maze and Durden moved for cover towards a large tree in the yard as SGT Jones moved for cover behind a car in the yard.

# Summary of what Officer Maze indicated...

According to Officer Samuel Maze, on Monday, July 24th 2017 at approximately midnight Southaven dispatch sent SGT Tommy Jones and Officer Zachery Durden to attempt to locate Samuel Pearman, who was reported to reside at 5878 Surrey Lane. Pearman was wanted for domestic aggravated assault by Tate County Sheriff's Dept. Due to felonious nature of the call, Officer Maze responded to the address to assist.

After arriving, Officer Durden, Maze and SGT Jones arrived near Surrey Lane. SGT Jones utilized a GPS, which indicated the 5878 was located on the west side of Surrey Lane. A decision was made to approach the residence.

At the same time, Officer Durden could be heard saying "put the gun down" several times. The dog made a quick lunge towards Officer Maze, which resulted in him firing one round towards the dog.

Afterwards, Officer Maze observed the barrel still pointed at Officer Durden. Officer Durden fired numerous shots towards the front door. The officer retreated to a tree located nearby. Officer Maze went to his vehicle and retrieved a ballistic shield. When he returned, he noticed a female present.

Officer Maze and Durden re-entered the residence to secure it from additional threats. They returned to Ismael Rodrigues Lopez and began to render aid. Officer Maze observed the male breathing laboriously and cuffed the male's hands behind his back.

Moments later, Officer Long arrived and instructed him to return to the station. Detective Bryan Rosenberg took possession of Officer Maze's weapon.>

# Summary of what Officer Durden indicated...

According to Officer Durden's written statement, on Monday July 24, 2017 at approximately 0005 hours, he was dispatched to 5878 Surrey Lane to attempt to locate Samuel Pearman, who was wanted for domestic aggravated assault in Tate County.

Officer Durden, Maze and SGT Jones arrived near Surrey Lane and began to look for the address by the numerics on the roadside mailbox. The officers approached a mobile home with a flood light illuminating the front porch located on the west side of Surrey Lane. Officer Durden was doubtful about the address and decided to knock at the door with the thought that someone would answer the door and point them to the correct address.

Officer Durden knocked at the door several times and stepped off the porch positioning himself in the well lite area of the front yard. Officer Durden observed the porch light go out. Officer Durden activated the light attached to his gun to illuminate the door and observed a male aiming a rifle at him. The stock of the rifle was placed in the males' right shoulder and his head was slightly leaning to the right while it was aimed towards him (Officer Durden). This resulted in Officer Durden, yelling "put the gun down" numerous times. As the male positioned himself behind the door, Officer Durden heard a gunshot. Officer Durden fired numerous shots at the male before retreating for cover near a tree in the yard.

A short time later, a female exited the residence with her hands up and yelling. The female was secured by SGT Jones as Officer Durden and Maze secured the residence from addition threats. Officer Durden returned to the room where the male was located and begin providing aid until he was relieved by Officer Tom Long. 

On Monday, July 24, 2017 at approximately midnight, I Southaven Police Officer Samuel Maze, was on my way to the Southaven Police Department to complete several reports. Southaven Dispatch notified Southaven Police Officer Zachary Durden and Southaven Police Officer Tommy Jones to respond to 5878 Surrey Lane in Southaven, Mississippi, to attempt to locate an individual for Tate County Sheriff's Department. Southaven Dispatch stated the individual was Samuel PEARMAN, who was wanted for aggravated assault, and was believed to be at this address. Due to the felonious nature of the warrant, I informed Southaven Dispatch that I would also respond to the call on Surrey Lane.

Officer Durden and I pulled our patrol cars into the Desoto Woods subdivision, and began discussing how we were going to approach the residence where PEARMAN was supposedly at. I requested Southaven Dispatch to send a picture of PEARMAN to my city e-mail. Southaven Dispatch sent a copy of PEARMAN's driver's license information to me, and I was able to determine that PEARMAN was a caucasian male with dark hair. I entered the address Southaven Dispatch had provided into my patrol laptop to try and locate the residence we were going to. From my past experience of patrolling the Desoto Woods subdivision, I knew that Surrey Lane had several street lamps that illuminated the street. I informed Officer Durden that Surrey Lane had several street lamps illuminating the street, and that we should approach the residence from the East to better conceal our patrol cars. Officer Durden and I drove our patrol cars to Westminster Lane, turned North, and then turned Westbound on Neshoba Road.

Officer Durden and I parked our patrol cars East of the intersection of Neshoba Road and Surrey Lane. I informed Officer Durden I believed the residence to be Southwest of where we were parked, based on the where the address was plotting on my patrol laptop. As Officer Durden and I walked towards the residence, we were attempting to walk in the shadows, and avoid the light of the street lamps. When responding to calls, it is common officer safety practice to park our patrol cars away from the location, and walk the rest of the way. While walking towards the residence, several dogs began barking from a yard from Neshoba Road, behind where we were standing.

As Officer Durden and I began walking to the residence we believed PEARMAN to be at, Officer Jones arrived in his patrol car, and parked under a street lamp. I mentioned to Officer Durden that Officer Jones may be parked directly in front of the residence we were walking to. Officer Durden stated he did not believe the residence Officer Jones was parked at was the correct address, rather that the correct address was further North of the intersection.

As Officer Durden and I made contact with Officer Jones, I informed Officer Jones I believed the residence he was parked in front of was the residence we were looking for. Officer Jones stated the residence PEARMAN was supposedly at was further North down Surrey Lane. I asked Southaven Dispatch to restate the address they had provided earlier. Southaven Dispatch stated the address was 5878 Surrey Lane. Once hearing the address again, I noticed the address of the house I believed PEARMAN to be at was not the correct address. Officer Durden informed me and Officer Jones that his global positioning system was plotting 5878 Surrey Lane just North of the intersection of Surrey Lane and Neshoba Road, and on the Western side of Surrey Lane. Officer Jones retrieved his shotgun from his patrol car, and he, Officer Durden, and I began walking towards the location Officer Durden stated.

Upon arriving at the believed location, Officer Durden and I began looking at the residences for the street numbers to determine which residence we were looking for. I was not able to see any address numbers on the houses in the area we were looking. I began looking at the mailboxes, which were on the western side of the street, and noticed that there were multiple mailboxes that did not have address numbers. I informed Officer Durden I could not see any addresses which matched the one provided by Southaven Dispatch. During my experience of patrolling the Desoto Woods subdivision, it is common to be sent to a residence which does not have the numerics of the address posted on the mailbox or the

house. During these types of events, it is common for officers to knock on the door of a residence to confirm where the correct address is.

Officer Durden, Officer Jones, and I walked into the driveway of the residence we believed was the one PEARMAN was supposedly at. I asked Officer Durden and Officer Jones if they believed we were at the correct address, and both stated they believed we were at the residence. The residence was a mobile home, which had a very bright porch light, which illuminated a majority of the front yard. I noticed there were several vehicles in the driveway, and the driveway was littered with vehicle parts and trash. We began approaching the residence. Officer Durden and I both withdrew our duty pistols from our holsters on our approach to the residence; Officer Jones was carrying his patrol shotgun. I informed Southaven Dispatch we had arrived on scene. Southaven Dispatch advised all officers to hold radio traffic until further notice. There was a large tree in the front yard, and I saw a small cable wrapped around it, with one end laying on the ground several feet away. I informed Officer Durden and Officer Jones there was possibly a dog at the residence.

There was a wooden fence on the South end of the mobile home, and this is where Officer Jones stood so that he would be able to see the back of the residence. Officer Durden stated he was going to go to the front door and knock on it. I saw that the front porch, which was on the Northeast side of the mobile home, was elevated, and had a railing around it. Common officer safety is to knock on the front door, then step away from the door incase someone answers the door with a weapon. I informed Officer Durden to knock and then to step off the porch so he would not be "in the funnel". I noticed there were several windows on the front of the mobile home. One on the Southeast side, where Officer Jones was standing; one near the roof of the mobile home, which I believed to be a bathroom window, and a double-paned window next to the front porch, which I believed to be a bedroom window or a living room window. From my training and experience, I decided to stand near the double-paned window so that I could see Officer Durden and Officer Jones, and also handle a threat if one were to appear in the window.

I looked at Officer Jones, and he nedded his head at me, signaling that he was ready. I looked at Officer Durden, who was standing on the front porch, and nodded at him, signaling to him I was also ready for him to knock on the door. Officer Durden was completely illuminated by the light given off by the porch lamp; I was partially illuminated where I was standing. Officer Durden forcibly knocked on the front door several times, then stepped off the perch into the yard. Officer Durden positioned himself in a way that he could easily been seen and recognized as a police officer, and so that he could also move to cover if he needed.

After several seconds I began hearing someone walking from the South end of the mobile home to the North end, where Officer Durden was standing. I got Officer Durden's attention, and signaled to him with my left hand that someone was walking in his direction. Several seconds later, the bright front porch light went out, ad I thought to myself, "well, they aren't going to answer the door". I began sidestepping through the yard towards Officer Durden so I could see the front door better. As I was walking his way, Officer Durden turned his flashlight on, illuminating the front porch and front door. As he did so, I saw the barrel of a rifle protruding from the front door, pointing in Officer Durden's direction. At the same time, I saw a large dog running off the front porch, charging at me. I pointed my duty pistol at the dog, and began walking backwards. The dog was very aggressive, snarling, and baring his teeth, and I believed the dog was about to attack me. While I was walking backwards, the dog stopped approximately four to five feet from in front of me. Officer Durden began giving loud, audible, verbal commands to "put the gun down!". Officer Durden gave the command to "put the gun down!", multiple times. While Officer Durden was giving verbal commands to "put the gun down", the dog continued snarling and baring his teeth at me, and slowly walking in my direction. The dog made a quick lunging motion towards me, and I thought the dog was trying to bite me. I fired my duty weapon once at the dog to keep him from attacking me. I then began looking back at the front door, and could still see the barrel of the rifle pointed in Officer

Durden's direction. Officer Durden then fired his duty weapon multiple times. I began quickly sidestepping towards Officer Durden, pointing my duty pistol at the front door of the mobile home. I could hear a woman screaming from within the mobile home, near the front door.

Officer Durden began informing Southaven Dispatch that shots had been fired, the suspect was down, to notify and send emergency medical personnel, and that he had fired his duty weapon approximately four to five times. An Officer began asking on the radio of there were any injured officers at the scene, and Officer Durden stated no officers were injured. While Officer Durden was informing Southaven Dispatch of the events, I noticed Officer Durden was standing in a exposed position in the middle of the front yard. I began telling Officer Durden "Zack, walk to me!" multiple times. Officer Durden began side-stepping to my location, and when he got within arms reach, I grabbed him by the back of his ballistic vest and pulled him behind the large tree in the yard. Officer Durden then reloaded his duty pistol with a magazine from his duty belt. Officer Jones was standing to my left, and he stated, 'we need to get the shield". I told Officer Durden to remain where he was until I got back. I holstered my duty pistol and ran back to my patrol car to retrieve the ballistic shield I carry for our shift. I retrieved the ballistic shield, and ran back to Officer Durden and Officer Jones' location behind the tree.

When I arrived back with Officer Durden and Officer Jones, a woman was standing with them. I assumed she was the woman I had heard screaming inside the residence earlier. Officer Durden stated to me "we have to go in there and help him". I told Officer Durden we were not going inside the residence, because we could not see inside the residence; we did not know who else was inside the residence, nor if there anyone else was inside with a weapon. Officer Durden stated he had seen the individual whom he had fired his duty pistol at, laying on the floor inside the front door. I asked the female if anyone else was inside the residence, and she shook her head as if to say no, and stated "no". I told Officer Jones we needed to detain the woman and take her to a safe location away from the front of the mobile home. Officer Jones was already holding his handcuffs, and began placing them on the female.

I told Officer Durden that if he could see the suspect laying on the floor, that we could go ahead and clear the residence for additional potential threats. Officer Durden and I began approaching the front porch of the residence. Officer Durden began looking into the mobile home, take short steps as he began checking the interior of the residence for threats. I asked Officer Durden what he could see inside the residence. Officer Durden stated there was a room directly to our right once inside the mobile home, and a hallway to our left. I squeezed Officer Durden on the back of his left arm to inform him I was ready for him to go inside the residence. Officer Durden stepped inside the residence, and took a step to the left of the door, I immediately stepped inside the residence, and took a step to the right, checking the room to our right for threats, there were none.

As I walked back to where Officer Durden was standing in the living room, Officer Durden stated, "we have to start helping the guy". Officer Durden was pointing his duty pistol in the direction of the hallway. The suspect was laying in the middle of the living room floor, facedown, with his feet towards the front door. I could see the suspect was wounded in his torso, and had a large wound on the back of his head. There was blood and brain matter on the floor surrounding the suspect. I could hear the suspect breathing; however, it was very laborious. I told Officer Durden we were going to finish clearing the structure for additional threats before we began rendering aid to the suspect. I could see a hunting style rifle laying on a couch next to the front door.

Officer Durden and I began walking down the hallway of the mobile home. I saw there were two doors on our left, one on our right, which appeared to be a door leading outside, and one at the end of the hallway. The hallway was very tight, and it was difficult for Officer Durden and I to tactfully clear the hallway. Officer Durden stated he was going to clear the first room on our left. I told him to go ahead, and as he began doing so, I moved past him, covering his back. Officer Durden stated there was no on in the

first room. Officer Durden told me that he would clear the second room on our left, which he did. I told Officer Durden that since the hallway was so tight, and the door at the end of the hallway was closed, I was going to open the door, and for him to stand back in the room he had just cleared. I approached the last door, and quickly opened the door, stepping backwards in the process. As I opened the door, the same dog that had attempted to bite me outside quickly ran out of the room and began growling at Officer Durden and I. I told Officer Durden not to move. The dog quit growling, and began urinating on the floor where it stood. I believed that the dog was scared, and only wanted to get away from us; however, due to the tightness of the hallway, the size of the dog and the potential threat it could be, I decided to spray the dog with my OC spray. The dog began blinking its eyes, drooling, and shaking its head. I told Officer Durden to "get skinny", and we both leaned against the hallway wall. As we did, the dog ran past us back towards the living room of the mobile home. I informed Officer Durden I was going to "dump into the last room, and for him to follow behind me". Officer Durden and I cleared the last room. Officer Jones informed Southaven Dispatch there was a large dog inside the residence. I informed Southaven Dispatch we had cleared the structure.

Officer Durden and I quickly walked back to the living room, and began giving aid to the suspect. Officer Durden asked me if I had any latex gloves in my pocket, and I informed him that I did not. I told Officer Durden to go get some gloves, and that I would begin working on the suspect. Officer Durden ran out of the mobile home to retrieve gloves.

The suspect was laboriously breathing, and it sounded as if he was snoring. Due to the potential threat the suspect still posed, I decided to place handcuffs on the suspect, detaining him. I saw the suspects right hand partially concealed under right leg. His left arm was completely concealed under his body. I pulled the suspects arms from under his body and placed him in handcuffs. Officer Durden then returned to the mobile home and stated that we need to turn the suspect over. As we began turning him over, I noticed the suspect appeared to be a Hispanic male, or a dark complected caucasian male. Officer Thomas Long arrived on scene, and came into the mobile home. Officer Long began yelling at Officer Durden to get out of the mobile home. Officer Durden walked out of the mobile home. I informed Officer Long the suspect had a wound in the middle of his back, and a wound on the back of his head. Officer Long then grabbed the suspect by the feet, and pulled him back towards the door, so we would have more room to begin rendering aid. Officer Long stated we need to apply Quick Clot to the suspect, and apply a chest seal. Patrol Captain Brent Vickers arrived on scene, and came into the mobile home. Officer Long began yelling at Captain Vickers to "get Maze out of here". Captain Vickers then grabbed me and helped me out of the mobile home. Captain Vickers began asking me if I was ok, and I told him I was not injured. Captain Vickers lead me back to where Officer Durden's and my patrol car were parked.

Officer Durden and I remained near our patrol cars until additional officers arrived on scene, and began checking on us. Criminal Investigations Detective Seth Kern arrived on scene and began speaking with Officer Durden. Detective Kern took possession of Officer Durden's duty pistol. Special Operations Captain Wayne Perkins arrived on scene, and began speaking with him. I informed Captain Perkins I wanted to speak with my Police Benevolence Association attorney. Captain Perkins stated he would begin working on it. Detective Bryan Rosenberg arrived on scene, and informed me that he needed my pistol. I gave my pistol to Detective Rosenberg, and he placed another pistol in my duty holster. Officer Whitney Walley then transported me to the Southaven Police Department. While in-route to the Southaven Police Department, Tony Farese, my Police Benevolence Association attorney contacted me, and began discussing with situation with me.

Zachary Durden - Statement

On Monday, July 24, 2017 at approximately 0005 hours (12:05 a.m.), I, Southaven Police Officer Zachary Durden, was dispatched to 5878 Surrey Lane located in the Desoto Woods subdivision on an attempt to locate call. Southaven Police Officer Sam Maze and Southaven Police Officer Tommy Jones were also enroute to this location as well. We were attempting to locate a white male, Samuel Pearman, who was wanted for aggravated assault through Tate County.

When Officer Sam Maze and I turned on to Surrey Lane from Great Oaks Drive, we turned East on Tuscany Way, then North on Westminister Lane, then West on Neshoba Road. Southaven Police Officer Maze was following me while driving West on Neshoba Road, approaching Surrey Lane. According to my Garmin gps in my car, 5878 Surrey Lane was located just North of Neshoba Road. We stopped and parked our vehicles on Neshoba Road in front of the trailer that was at the corner of Neshoba Road and Surrey Lane. When I exited my patrol vehicle and Southaven Police Officer Maze exited his patrol vehicle, he told me that the gps on his computer was showing the residence was South of Neshoba Road and I told him that my personal gps was showing it was North of Neshoba Road.

Southaven Police Officer Sam Maze and I then saw Southaven Police Officer Tommy Jones in his patrol car, driving North on Surrey Lane approaching Neshota Road and park two or three trailers South of Neshoba Road on Surrey Lane. I heard Southaven Police Officer Maze make the comment that he thought Southaven Police Officer Tommy iones had parked in front of 5878 Surrey Lane. Southaven Police Officer Sam Maze and I walked towards Officer Tommy Jones and asked him if he was parked in front of the trailer that we were trying to locate. Tommy Jones replied that the correct trailer was North of us. We all three looked for the marest mail ox and walked North on Surrey Lane to see if the numbers were getting bigger or smaller to determine if we were walking in the right direction. I remember while walking North, the first address I saw was a smaller number than 5878 and the next address I saw was also smaller than 5878 but since the numbers were getting larger, we all three knew we were heading in the right direction. On the West side of the Road on Surrey Lane, there was a trailer that had a front yard that was well lit by a flood light on the front of the trailer. I don't recall what the numbers on the address were for the trailer before this one or the one before that, but knowing that the numbers were getting larger and closer to 5878, we all three were convinced that the well lit trailer on the West side of Surrey Lane was 5878 Surrey Lane. I looked on the trailer for the correct numbers but could not locate any numbers on the trailer. Even though we were all convinced that this was 5878 Surrey Lane, I figured if it was the wrong address, whoever answered the door would tell us it was the wrong address and be able to point us in the right direction of the correct address.

As we approached the trailer with the front yard that was well lit, I saw a couple of cars in the front yard and a tree. The South side of the front yard had shadows and the North side of the front yard was very

well lit by the flood light on the front of the trailer. The front door of the trailer, which was facing East towards the road, was located closer to the Northern part of the trailer. The door knob on the front door from the outside, was located on the left side of the door. The flood light that was illuminating the front yard, was North of the door but close to the door. The trailer had a few wooden steps that led up to the front door on a small wooden deck-like area. Southaven Police Officer Tommy Jones had his shotgun with him and positioned himself on the South side of the front yard close to one of the vehicles in the yard. Southaven Police Officer Tommy Jones had his shotgun with him due to the nature of the call and due to the fact that the male we were attempting to locate was wanted for a violent felony through Tate County. Southaven Police Officer Sam Maze was positioned just North of him and closer to the road in the front yard but still in the area of the yard that was not well lit. I looked around the area of the trailer and saw that on the North side of the trailer, there was a fence. Southaven Police Officer Tommy Jones told me that there was a fence on the South side of the trailer as well. Looking at the trailer from the front yard, all the lights appeared to be turned off inside the trailer and I could not hear any noise coming from inside the trailer.

I walked up to the front door of the trailer and knocked four to five times loud enough to wake someone up if they were sleeping. I went down the wooden steps at the front door and positioned myself in the area of the yard that was well lit. Due to the nature of the call, I had my handgun in my hand and held it behind my right leg. I positioned myself in the area of the yard that was well lit on purpose so that whoever answered the door or looked out a window before answering the door, would be able to clearly see that it was a police officer who had knocked on their door. From where I was standing, I was just slightly North of the front door in the front yard. While I was standing in the well lit area of the yard, Southaven Police Officer Sam Maze got my attention and signaled to me that he could hear someone walking in the trailer towards the end where the front door located. I nodded my head at Officer Maze and continued to watch the front door. Approximatley five to seven seconds after I nodded at Officer Maze, the flood lights were turned off. Since I was standing directly in the light, when the lights were turned off, everything was completely dark. I waited approximately a second or two before using the light attatched to my handgun to illuminate the front door. When I shined the light from my handgun on the front door, I immediately saw a male aiming a rifle directly at me. I could tell the stock of the rifle was in his right shoulder and his head was slightly leaning to the right as if he was taking aim. I could clearly see the end of the barrel of the rifle pointed directly in my direction. I began to yell "police" but about making it halfway through that word, all I could yell over and over again was, "Put the gun down." I yelled "Put the gun down" three to four times. I got into a ready stance slightly lowering my body and saw what looked like him taking cover behind the door. The door wasn't even halfway opened when I had first shined my light on the door and after getting into a ready stance, I saw him shift to his left, exposing less of himself in the doorway and looked like an attempt to use the front door as cover. I then heard a gunshot but I did not know where the gunshot came from. I knew that I had given the male at the doorway mulitple verbal commands to put the gun down and the male never put the gun down. I shot three to four rounds from my handgun at the male with the rifle. After shooting three to four rounds, my magazine from my handgun fell out. While keeping the light from my weapon illuminating

the front door and watching the front door, I was moving slowly towards Officer Sam Maze and reloading my handgun. While moving slowly towards Officer Sam Maze, I could see through the opening of the front door, the male laying on the floor inside the trailer. I immediately got on my radio and said that shots were fired, there was one male suspect down, requested EMS and that I had fired three to four rounds from my handgun. Dispatch came back over the radio copying my traffic and asked if any officers were hurt. I replied to dispatch and told them that all the officers on scene were ok.

I was with Officer Sam Maze behind the tree that was in the front yard and he left running towards his patrol car telling me he was going to go get the shield. While he went to go get the shield, Southaven Police Officer Tommy Jones was still positioned behind the car with his shotgun pointed towards the front door. A female then came out of the trailer with her hands up yelling. I told her to walk towards me and that she was safe. When she walked to me, I told Officer Tommy Jones that I was sending the female to him. She walked to him and about that time, Officer Sam Maze had returned from his patrol vehicle. I told him we were going to go inside and clear the tgailer to make the scene safe. Officer Sam Maze told me we needed to wait for back up before leaving officer Tommy Jones outside by himself and going inside the trailer. I then told Officer Sam Maze that the male inside was on the floor and had been shot and we needed to give him medical attention as soon as possible. Officer Sam Maze and I began running towards the front door of the trailer and cleared the inside of the trailer. The male was laying face down in the living room by the front of the hallway. When Officer Sam Maze and I opened the master bedroom door, a pitbull came out, growling and seemed extremely aggresive. A bathroom door was right next to me, so I went through that door and quickly cracked the door to avoid getting to close to the pitbull. The pitbull stood right in from of the bathroom door facing Officer Sam Maze in the hallway staring and growling at him. Officer Sam Maze didn't want to shoot and kill the pitbull so he used his pepper spray in an attempt to get the pitbull to go back into the master bedroom. The pitbull backed up and I was able to slip out of the bathroom and go back down the hallway towards the living room. I knelt down by the male and saw that he was bleeding. Right as I was about to attempt to turn him over, Southaven Police Officer Tom Long came in and told me that I didn't need to be in the trailer anymore and told me to leave. I left the trailer and multiple officers arrived on scene. Criminal Investigations Detective Seth Kern arrived on scene and took possession of my handgun. A new handgun was issued to me and another police officer took me back to the Southaven Police Department.

On Monday 07/24/17 at 0007 hrs (12:07 P.M. CST) I, Sgt. T. Jones, received a call to locate a Samuel Pearman at 5878 Surrey Lane. Dispatch advised that Pearman was wanted by Tate County SO for aggravated assault. They advised the subject was possibly at this location.

I arrived on Surrey Lane and stopped my unit on the 5800 block of Surrey at Neshoba. Officers Durden and Maze had parked on Neshoba east of Surrey. Officers Durden and Maze pointed to a residence on the west side of the roadway on Surrey north of Neshoba. We approached a house on foot. When we approached the residence, I did not see any numbers on the residence.

I went to the south side of the residence. There was a wooden fence and a gate that was open. I positioned myself so I could see the front and rear of the residence. Officer Durden went to the front door and Officer Maze covered Officer Durden.

The front porch outside light was the only light on at the residence. Officer Durden went to the front door and knocked four to five times. I could hear a dog barking inside the residence. A short time later the front light to the residence was turned off. There was enough light from the street lights for me to see a large dog run from the front door of the residence. Officer Durden used a light so he could see the front door. When Officer Durden used his light, I could see a gun barrel sticking out the front door. The barrel was pointed at Officer Durden.

Officer Durden was backing up and yelling to drop the gun. He yelled this three to four times. I heard a gunshot and then Officer Durden fired three to four rounds. Officer Maze told Officer Durden to get back. They moved back to a large tree in the yard. I moved to a car in the driveway to cover the officers as they moved back.

Officer Durden stated the subject was down inside the residence. I asked if one of them had the shield in their vehicle. Officer Maze stated he did and went to retrieve it. We could then hear a female in the residence. Officer Durden told her to come out of the residence. Officer Durden repeated his commands about three times for her to come out of the residence. She finally did. When the female came out of the residence, I put handcuffs on her and detained her for officer safety until we could secure the scene.

Officer Maze came back with the shield. Officers Maze and Durden went into the residence. The female advised that the dog was in the rear bedroom of the residence. I advised officers over the radio of this.

Officer Long was the next officer to arrive on the scene. Officer Long went into the residence. Officers Durden and Maze advised the residence was secure for EMS. Officer Laboe arrived on the scene and asked what did I need. I advised him to stand by with the female. I secured the

shotgun in my unit. I then moved my patrol unit from Surrey and Neshoba to Surrey and Brookside to block the roadway.

I went back up to the residence. I went to the female. A Desoto County deputy stated he had talked to her while I was gone. I walked the female to my patrol unit. Since the scene was secure, I removed the handcuffs from her. She was placed in back of the patrol unit. I asked if she would like some water. She stated she did. I had an extra unopened bottle of water in the front seat that I gave her.

A short time later Detective Kern and Officer Long walked up to my unit. He asked if I knew the females name or not, and whether or not I had talked to her. I advised him I did not, but a deputy had talked to her when she was outside the residence. Officer Long gave me the keys to unit 3109 and I moved it to were my unit was. Officer Long stayed with the female at that location.

I was told to leave the scene and go to the station . I left the scene and went to the Southaven Police Department.

There were several patrol cars and cops walking. This is all I remember for the moment, it all happened so quickly.


