MONTH FBIHQ HAS BEEN ADVISED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE {DOJ} THAT THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS IS CONSIDERING SEVERAL PIECES OF LEGISLATION REGARDING ANIMAL RESEARCH LABORATORY BREAK-INS. THE DOJ HAS ADVISED THAT THERE IS SIGNIFICANT SPECIAL INTEREST PRESSURE ON CONGRESS TO PASS LEGISLATION WHICH WOULD PROTECT ANIMAL AND HEALTH RESEARCH PROPERTY, FACILITIES AND PERSONNEL FROM ATTACKS. MEMBERS OF THE APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL STAFFS, WHICH ARE HANDLING THIS LEGISLATION, HAVE REQUESTED INPUT FROM FBIHQ PERSONNEL CONCERNING THIS LEGISLATION. TO FACILITATE THESE BRIEFINGS, FBIHQ NEEDS A BRIEF SUMMARY OF ALL INVESTIGATIONS INVOLVING CAPTIONED GROUP.

WITHIN FIVE WORKING DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS TELETYPE, RECEIVING OFFICES WILL PROVIDE FBIHQ WITH A SUMMARY OF THE INVESTIGATIONS OF CAPTIONED ORGANIZATION BEING CONDUCTED BY THE RESPECTIVE DIVISIONS. DALLAS SHOULD PROVIDE A SUMMARY AND CURRENT STATUS OF ITS INVESTIGATION OF THE JULY 4, 1989, TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY, LUBBOCK, TEXAS, BREAK-IN. LAS VEGAS SHOULD SUBMIT A SUMMARY AND CURRENT STATUS OF ITS INVESTIGATION OF THE MAY 23, 1989, BREAK-IN AT THE NEVADA YOUTH TRAINING CENTER. PHOENIX SHOULD PROVIDE A SUMMARY AND CURRENT STATUS OF ITS

INVESTIGATION OF THE APRIL 2, 1989, BREAK-IN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA, TUCSON, ARIZONA. PHILADELPHIA SHOULD PROVIDE A SUMMARY AND CURRENT STATUS OF ITS INVESTIGATION OF THE JANUARY 13-14, 1990, BREAK IN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA, PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA. LOS ANGELES AND SACRAMENTO SHOULD PROVIDE A SUMMARY AND CURRENT STATUS OF THEIR RESPECTIVE INVESTIGATIONS.

ALL OFFICES SHOULD SUBMIT THEIR RESPONSES NOT ONLY TO FBIHQ BUT ALSO TO LOS ANGELES, WHICH IS OFFICE OF ORIGIN IN THIS MATTER, FOR INCLUSION IN THE ALF RENEWAL LHM.

NOTE: BY MEMO DATED JANUARY 30, 1990, THE CONGRESSIONAL AFFAIRS OFFICE ADVISED THE DOMESTIC TERRORISM UNIT THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE HAD ADVISED FBIHQ THAT CONGRESS WAS CONSIDERING SEVERAL PIECES OF LEGISLATION REGARDING ANIMAL RESEARCH LABORATORY BREAK-INS. DOJ ADDED THAT THERE WAS SIGNIFICANT SPECIAL INTEREST PRESSURE ON CONGRESS TO PASS LEGISLATION WHICH WOULD PROTECT ANIMAL AND HEALTH RESEARCH PROPERTY, FACILITIES, AND PERSONNEL FROM ATTACKS. IN ADDITION, FBIHQ PERSONNEL HAVE BEEN REQUESTED TO BRIEF APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL STAFF COMMITTEES ON CAPTIONED ORGANIZATION. THIS TELETYPE REQUESTS THE RECEIVING OFFICES TO PROVIDE A SUMMARY OF THE CURRENT INVESTIGATION BEING CONDUCTED BY THE DIVISIONS IN THE CAPTIONED ORGANIZATION TO ASSIST IN PREPARATION FOR THESE BRIEFINGS.

BY SEPARATE TELETYPE, ALL FIELD OFFICES WILL BE TASKED TO CONTACT LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES CONCERNING ALF BREAK-INS.
