ON EDITORIAL BOARD OF BARNARD BULLETIN AS WAS COPLON. RESIGNED IN NOV., FORTYTHREE AND WENT TO CAL. WHERE SHE IS EMPLOYED AS REPORTER FOR "HAYWARD REVIEW", HAYWARD, CAL., AS OF FEB. TWENTYTWO, FORTYFOUR. FILE HAS PERSONAL LETTER FROM [REDACTED] TO ROBERT WOHLFORTH STATING IN EFFECT THAT THERE WERE PRACTICALLY NO LIBERAL PAPERS ON THE COAST BUT THAT THEY DID MANAGE TO GET "P.M." NO APPLICATION FOR EMPLOYMENT IN [REDACTED] FILE. FILE OF [REDACTED] REFLECTS THAT SHE ENTERED ON DUTY AS A JUNIOR STENOGRAPHER SEPT. FOURTEEN, FORTYTWO WITH THE ANTI-TRUST DIVISION. SHE MADE THE STATEMENT THAT SHE WAS DEEPLY INTERESTED IN INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AND WANTED TO LEARN MORE ABOUT ECONOMICS. FILE OF SARAH ~~BECKER~~, WHO ALSO APPEARED IN COPLON-S ADDRESS BOOK, INDICATED THAT SHE HAD BEEN TRANSFERRED TO THE EWS FROM WASHINGTON, D.C. IN MAY, FORTYTHREE. HER RESIDENCE IN WASHINGTON PRIOR TO COMING TO NY WAS THREE ZERO SEVEN DECATUR ST., NW, WASHINGTON, D.C. HER TRANSFER TO NY BECAME EFFECTIVE SEPT. FOURTEEN, FORTYTHREE WHILE SHE WAS CLASSIFIED AS AN EXPERT. SHE WAS PROMOTED FROM EXPERT TO ECONOMIST NOV. TWENTYNINE, FORTYFOUR. IN MAY, FORTYFIVE BECKER WAS TRYING TO GET TRANSFERRED TO THE ANTI-TRUST DIVISION, WASHINGTON, D.C. A REVIEW WILL BE MADE
