Re New York letter to the Bureau dated 1/24/49.

Reference is made to Washington Field teletype to New Haven dated [redacted] in the case entitled ARTHUR ROBERT ROSENBAUM, W.A.A., L.G.E.W. requesting the New Haven office to interview [redacted]

[redacted] who had once been a member of the State Department branch, Local #3, U.P.W.A. [redacted] was interviewed at that time and gave information about ROSENBAUM, MARCELLE DIANE ELINSON, and a group of U.P.W.A. members in Washington, D.C. who followed the Communist Party line, which Mrs. RAFF claimed she had opposed.

This information was forwarded to the Washington Field by letter dated [redacted] entitled "STATE DEPARTMENT BRANCH, LOCAL #3, U.P.W.A.; [redacted] SECURITY MATTER - C". This information was also set out in detail with respect to ROSENBAUM and ELINSON in the report of SA FRANK V. BATTLE dated [redacted] at New Haven in the case entitled "ARTHUR ROBERT ROSENBAUM, W.A.A., Washington, D. C., L.G.E.W.", a copy of which was forwarded to the Washington Field Office.

Since the files of the New Haven Office contain no further information about [redacted] and the Bureau and Washington Field have this information in detail, no further action is contemplated by this office.
