Dear Mr. McMullen:

This is in further response to our letter dated November 15, 2018, regarding your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, 5 U.S.C. § 552, to the Department of State (DOS) for specific cables sent and/or received by officials representing DOS and/or its organizational components.

After carefully reviewing the remaining 17 records, we determined that 10 of the documents are appropriate for release in part pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(1), which protects information that is properly classified in the interest of national security pursuant to Executive Order 13526, and 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), which concerns material the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of an individual's personal privacy. All released material is enclosed. Seven of the documents originated with or contain information under the purview of another federal agency and have been referred to the appropriate agency for review and direct response to you.



Appeals must be postmarked within 90 calendar days of the date of this initial agency decision letter. Please include a copy of this letter with your written appeal and clearly state why you disagree with the determinations set forth in this response.
