I understand that upon completion of my term of active duty I will, if qualified, be transferred to the Army Reserve and required to serve in a Reserve Component for a period which, when added to my active duty service, totals 6 years, unless sooner discharged in accordance with standards prescribed by the Secretary of Defense.
