Also, the letter is very unclear that the emails as to all of the individuals and companies are from January 1, 2013 through the present. That language appears with AMC Holdings Co., LLC in your letter, and the date range should be in the paragraph above.

Finally, your letter mentions 30 business days, but does not cite unusual circumstances. The statute requires a response within 20 business days unless there are unusual circumstances.
