28 **EXPERTISE OF AFFLIANT:**

30 I am Deputy Sheriff with the Clark County Sheriff's Office; I have been so employed since
31 January 2014. I had been a Reserve Deputy for 4 years and have completed 480 hours of
32 Reserve Deputy Law Enforcement Training. While employed by the Clark County Sheriff's I
33 attended the Basic Law Enforcement Academy in Burien Washington. While at the Criminal
34 Justice Training Center I received approximately 720 hours of Basic Law Enforcement
35 Training. Upon completion of my academy training, I completed a three and a half month Field
36 Training program where I was instructed by veteran deputies. This training included the
37 investigations of crimes of abuse, domestic violence and assault.
38

39 I have been assigned and have had the opportunity to work all patrol shift assignments giving
40 me a wide array of law enforcement experience and encounters. In this capacity I have been
41 involved in numerous cases ranging from child abuse, assaults, kidnaping, domestic violence

1 and other crimes. I am also a certified Field Training Officer (FTO) where I train and observe
2 newly hired deputies. I worked as a patrol Deputy until April 2017. Following my patrol
3 assignment, I was assigned to the Clark County Sheriff's Office Major Crimes Unit as a
4 Detective. While assigned to the Major Crimes Unit I received addition training Homicide
5 Investigation, Crime Scene Photography, and interview techniques. As a MCU Detective I have
6 worked numerous investigations of crimes including homicide, robbery, forgery and neglect.
7
8

9 **Your affiant is informed and aware of this based on the following:**

10
11 The facts set forth in this affidavit are based on my own personal knowledge;
12 knowledge obtained from other individuals during my participation in this investigation,
13 including other law enforcement officers; interviews of cooperating witnesses; review of
14 documents and records related to this investigation; communications with others who have
15 personal knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; and information gained
16 by my training and experience.
17

18 Because this affidavit is submitted for the limited purpose of establishing probable
19 cause in support of the application for a search warrant, it does not set forth each and every fact
20 that others or I have learned during the course of this investigation. I have set forth only the
21 facts that I believe are necessary to establish probable cause to believe that evidence, fruits and
22 instrumentalities of the listed offenses will be found on or in the listed location(s).
23

24 On 4/13/2019 [REDACTED], a neighbor, observed three males working on a
25 motorhome on Fallert Rd at approximately 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM. One of the males was later
26 identified as Brian Butts. Another male was recognized as Michael Veatch. At 2129 hrs,
27 Cowlitz County Deputy Sheriff Justin DeRosier is dispatched to a parking complaint of a
28 motorhome blocking the roadway near the 100 block of Fallert Rd, Cowlitz County,
29 Washington.
30

31 While driving to the motorhome parking complaint, at 2159 hrs Deputy DeRosier
32 performs a traffic stop on a white Chevrolet pickup truck near the 1000 block of Kalama River
33 Rd. During the course of the traffic stop Deputy DeRosier identifies the driver as Michael
34 Veatch and the passenger as [REDACTED]. He gives them a verbal warning for a traffic
35 violation and Deputy DeRosier continues up Kalama River Rd to the motorhome parking
36 complaint on Fallert Rd.
37

38 At approximately 2211 hours, Deputy DeRosier arrived at the complaint of a
39 motorhome blocking the roadway near the 100 block of Fallert Rd, Cowlitz County,
40 Washington. Within minutes he reported he had been shot. He described the fleeing suspect to
41 responding deputies. Deputy DeRosier succumbed to gunshot injuries and died at the hospital.
42 He was later determined to have been shot multiple times in the torso.
43

1 Responding police officers located a motorhome and a white Chevy S10 pickup at the
2 shooting scene. The registered owner of the motorhome was contacted who stated it had been
3 given to Brian Butts. The entire Kalama River Rd area was contained and a large scale
4 manhunt was conducted in the area. At approximately 0200 hours Matthew Veatch was located
5 near the dead end of Modrow Rd. He was disheveled and muddy. Detectives conducted
6 several recorded interviews with Matthew Veatch during which he was read the Miranda
7 Warning twice. Matthew told them he was at his residence, [REDACTED] when
8 he heard what sounded to be gunshot last night. Minutes later his brother, Michael Veatch,
9 arrived in a vehicle. He appeared more serious than normal. Approximately 10 minutes after
10 that Brian Butts arrived from the bushes to their residence. He appeared dirty and stated he
11 needed to get out of there. Matthew said his mom [REDACTED] was standing outside with Matthew
12 when Butts walked out of the woods asking for help. Matthew observed a handgun in Brian's
13 front pocket. Matthew said Butts gave him a pistol to "get rid of" and Matthew placed the
14 firearm in a locked cabinet in his room with the intention of disposing of the weapon later.
15 Detectives would later locate the firearm in Matthew Veatch's room and learn it had previously
16 been reported stolen.

17
18 At the Veatch residence located at [REDACTED] were now Michael and Matthew
19 Veatch, [REDACTED]. Each of them had different
20 accounts of Brian Butts' arrival. [REDACTED] said she never saw Butts at their home, but Matthew
21 said Cheryl was standing outside with Matthew when Butts walked out of the woods asking for
22 help. They all reported hearing police sirens in the area. [REDACTED] claimed both Matthew
23 and Michael Veatch ran down to the motorhome to assist Butts after hearing the gunshots.
24 Matthew admitted to leading Brian Butts on foot away through the woods to escape. Matthew
25 reported they walked through the dark woods for several hours before separating near Modrow
26 Rd. Matthew stated he did not know where Butts went after Matthew was contacted by Law
27 Enforcement near Modrow Rd.

28
29 On 4/14/19 Michael Veatch was contacted at [REDACTED]. He stated he had tried to
30 help Brian Butts with a broken down motorhome on Fallert Rd the previous day on 4/13/19.
31 Michael said he went with Donald Grandchamp to Kalama for gas, leaving Butts near the
32 motorhome. When they were returning, they were stopped by a Cowlitz Deputy Sheriff for a
33 bad taillight. After the traffic stop the Deputy continued up Kalama River Rd for a complaint
34 about a motorhome. Michael and Donald tried to fix the tail light and then drove by the
35 deputy's vehicle that was positioned towards Butts's motorhome. He claimed they continued
36 past the scene to Michael's residence. Michael denied seeing any people at the motorhome or
37 the Deputy's car when they drove by. Michael Veatch's cell phone was collected and logged as
38 Evidence Item #117 with Clark County Sheriff's Office case number 19-3549 at the Clark
39 County Evidence Unit located at 812 W. 11th St, Vancouver, Clark County, State of
40 Washington.

1 On 4/14/19 [REDACTED] was also contacted at 389 Fallert Rd. During
2 interviews, he gave a similar statement as Michael Veatch. He said when they passed the
3 motorhome on Fallert Rd he saw the deputy's car there. [REDACTED] described the Deputy as
4 standing near his car with his gun out and said he could hear the Deputy giving commands to
5 the occupants in the motorhome.

6
7 On 4/15/19 [REDACTED] was interviewed again by Detectives. Donald
8 admitted he was trying to help Brian Butts move the motorhome to the Veatch residence at 389
9 Fallert Rd. After the motorhome broke down they drove to Kalama for gas. He said Michael
10 Veatch and he drove back towards Fallert Rd. They were stopped by the deputy on Kalama
11 River Rd. [REDACTED] stated they had been listening to the police scanner and knew the deputy was
12 headed to the motorhome on Fallert Rd. After the deputy left the traffic stop, Michael Veatch
13 used his cell phone to call Brain Butts and warn him the deputy was on his way. [REDACTED] stated
14 when they drove by the deputy he had his gun out and was yelling at the motorhome. [REDACTED]
15 said they were waived through by the Deputy and continued up to the Veatch house where they
16 were told about the gunshots. [REDACTED] would later tell detectives that when [REDACTED] and
17 Michael Veatch arrived at her house, [REDACTED] told her they had "driven past a bad scene" and
18 further stated there was a cop down. [REDACTED] cell phone was collected and logged as
19 Evidence Item #118 with Clark County Sheriff's Office case number 19-3549 at the Clark
20 County Evidence Unit located at [REDACTED] Clark County, State of
21 Washington

22
23 During the large scale manhunt for Brian Butts, Woodland PD contacted [REDACTED]
24 sleeping in his car on China Garden Road. He was briefly interviewed and released. Later
25 investigation found that [REDACTED] is a known acquaintance of Butts and that they had been in
26 prison together. [REDACTED] admitted that he had contact with Butts just 2 days earlier. He denied
27 any later contact as well as denying that he had Butts' phone number or knowing how to contact
28 him.

29
30 There are only two roads that lead from the area of the murder, Kalama River Rd and
31 Spencer Creek Rd. China Garden Rd is south of the area where the murder occurred. However
32 China Garden Rd can also be used to escape the area. There are no direct roads between
33 Spencer Creek Rd and China Garden, but there is a clear trail under and along the power lines
34 that lead from Spencer Creek to China Garden Rd. Butts' was located near 441 Spencer Creek
35 Rd that is only 600 yards from the power line trail leading south. It is likely that Butts
36 contacted [REDACTED] to wait on China Garden Rd to assist in his escape.

37
38 On 04/14/19 at approx. 1900 hours information was received by Cowlitz County of a
39 suspicious person at the 400 block of Spencer Creek Road. The suspicious person was
40 contacted by two Kelso Police officers and an armed confrontation ensued. The suspicious
41 person matched the physical description provided by Deputy DeRosier of the person who shot
42 him. Brian Butts was identified as the male killed by officers during the confrontation.

1 Later on a search warrant was obtained for the Veatch property at [REDACTED]
2 During the search of a red Ford pickup truck found on the property and registered to Matthew
3 Veatch, a cell phone was located in the glove box believed to belong to Matthew Veatch. The
4 cell phone was collected and logged as Evidence Item #82 with Clark County Sheriff's Office
5 case number 19-3549 at the Clark County Evidence Unit located at [REDACTED]
6 Clark County, State of Washington
7

8 A search warrant was also served on a white Chevrolet S-10 pickup truck parked next to
9 the motorhome where Deputy DeRosier was shot. Brian Butts was reported to be driving the
10 vehicle earlier in the day on 4/13/19. A wallet belonging to Brian Butts was found in the
11 vehicle along with a cell phone believed to belong to Brian Butts. The cell phone was collected
12 and logged as Evidence Item #33 with Clark County Sheriff's Office case number 19-3549 at
13 the Clark County Evidence Unit located at [REDACTED] Clark County, State of
14 Washington
15

16 I know from training and experience people often communicate with each other by
17 phone to include cellular phones. Suspect(s), victim(s), and witnesses(s) use their phones
18 before, during and after a crime. The history of phone calls with the phone company/carrier and
19 in the electronic memory of a cellular phone is a useful aid in identifying additional suspects or
20 witnesses. Call histories can confirm or refute statements by the suspect(s), victim(s) and
21 witnesses. Also, phone call records can establish a time line of contacts made by the suspect(s)
22 or victim(s). Many modern cellular telephones transmit their locations by using built in GPS or
23 directions from cellular towers. Cellular service providers often retain this data which can
24 show a location of a phone over time.
25

26 A cellular telephone (cell phone) communicates via radio waves, typically via antenna
27 towers (also known as "cell towers.") In order to transmit or receive calls and data, a cell phone
28 must be connected to a cellular service provider's network. These communications can include
29 traditional telephone calls, voice over Internet conversations (VoIP), text, email, peer-to-peer
30 communications (devices communicating directly with each other), communications using
31 social networking websites, and other communications using the internet. Depending on the
32 service provider and the device used by the customer/subscriber, these communications can use
33 a variety of bands/frequencies. Cellular telephones are also used for taking and storing
34 photographs, acquiring, creating, modifying, storing and sending documents, pictures, notes,
35 music, mapping directions to places, etc.
36

37 Subscriber information is obtained by the service provider when an account is
38 established and typically includes the below-described information. Providers of electronic
39 communications services, such as the above-listed service provider, in the normal course of
40 business, also collect customer-related usage data. This data is created and retained whenever a
41 cellular telephone is turned on to register its availability to receive communications on the
42 network, or when the device actually sends or receives communications.
43

1 I also know based on my training and experience that obtaining subscriber information
2 for a particular device is often useful in determining who possessed the device on a particular
3 date and time. However, a more definitive way to determine the possessor of a device is to
4 examine how the device is used over a period of days or weeks. Such records, including call
5 detail records, location information, text messages if available, and similar data files, can show
6 consistent patterns of usage that will help determine the user of the device. Examination of all
7 this data is necessary to accurately determine who possessed the device at dates and times
8 critical to the investigation.

9
10 Cell Phone Records:

41 such as motive. It is also possible that the incident may have been recorded on the electronic

devices as well. All cell phones and electronic devices collected with this warrant will be downloaded, analyzed and formulated into a report by a trained specialist in the future.



8 I am Deputy Sheriff with the Clark County Sheriff's Office; I have been so employed since January
9 2014. I had been a Reserve Deputy for 4 years and have completed 480 hours of Reserve Deputy Law
10 Enforcement Training. While employed by the Clark County Sheriff's I attended the Basic Law
11 Enforcement Academy in Burien Washington. While at the Criminal Justice Training Center I received
12 approximately 720 hours of Basic Law Enforcement Training. Upon completion of my academy training,
13 I completed a three and a half month Field Training program where I was instructed by veteran deputies.
14 This training included the investigations of crimes of abuse, domestic violence and assault.

16 I have been assigned and have had the opportunity to work all patrol shift assignments giving me
17 a wide array of law enforcement experience and encounters. In this capacity I have been involved in

4 On 4/13/2019 [REDACTED] a neighbor, observed three males working on a motorhome on
5 Fallert Rd at approximately 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM. One of the males was later identified as Brian Butts.
6 Another male was recognized as Michael Veatch. At 2129 hrs, Cowlitz County Deputy Sheriff Justin
7 DeRosier is dispatched to a parking complaint of a motorhome blocking the roadway near the 100 block
8 of Fallert Rd, Cowlitz County, Washington.

9 While driving to the motorhome parking complaint, at 2159 hrs Deputy DeRosier performs a
10 traffic stop on a white Chevrolet pickup truck near the 1000 block of Kalama River Rd. During the course
11 of the traffic stop Deputy DeRosier identifies the driver as Michael Veatch and the passenger as [REDACTED]
12 [REDACTED]. He gives them a verbal warning for a traffic violation and Deputy DeRosier continues up
13 Kalama River Rd to the motorhome parking complaint on Fallert Rd.

14 At approximately 2211 hours, Deputy DeRosier arrived at the complaint of a motorhome
15 blocking the roadway near the 100 block of Fallert Rd, Cowlitz County, Washington. Within minutes he
16 reported he had been shot. He described the fleeing suspect to responding deputies. Deputy DeRosier
17 succumbed to gunshot injuries and died at the hospital. He was later determined to have been shot
18 multiple times in the torso.

19 Responding police officers located a motorhome and a white Chevy S10 pickup at the shooting
20 scene. The registered owner of the motorhome was contacted who stated it had been given to Brian
21 Butts. A search of Longview Police Department police reports involving Brian Butts indicated his cell
22 phone number is [REDACTED]. The entire Kalama River Rd area was contained and a large scale
23 manhunt was conducted in the area.

24 At approximately 0200 hours Matthew Veatch was located near the dead end of Modrow Rd. He
25 was disheveled and muddy. Detectives conducted several recorded interviews with Matthew Veatch
26 during which he was read the Miranda Warning twice. Matthew told them he was at his residence, [REDACTED]
27 [REDACTED] when he heard what sounded to be gunshot last night. Minutes later his
28 brother, Michael Veatch, arrived in a vehicle. He appeared more serious than normal. Approximately 10
29 minutes after that Brian Butts arrived from the bushes to their residence. He appeared dirty and stated
30 he needed to get out of there. Matthew said his mom [REDACTED] was standing outside with Matthew when
31 Butts walked out of the woods asking for help. Matthew observed a handgun in Brian's front pocket.
32 Matthew said Butts gave him a pistol to "get rid of" and Matthew placed the firearm in a locked cabinet
33 in his room with the intention of disposing of the weapon later. Detectives would later locate the
34 firearm in Matthew Veatch's room and learn it had previously been reported stolen. During his contact
35 with detectives Matthew Veatch provided his cell phone number as [REDACTED]

4 Matthew when Butts walked out of the woods asking for help. They all reported hearing police sirens in
5 the area. [REDACTED] claimed both Matthew and Michael Veatch ran down to the motorhome to assist
6 Butts after hearing the gunshots. Matthew admitted to leading Brian Butts on foot away through the
7 woods to escape. Matthew reported they walked through the dark woods for several hours before
8 separating near Modrow Rd. Matthew stated he did not know where Butts went after Matthew was
9 contacted by Law Enforcement near Modrow Rd.

10 On 4/14/19 Michael Veatch was contacted at [REDACTED] He stated he had tried to help Brian
11 Butts with a broken down motorhome on Fallert Rd the previous day on 4/13/19. Michael said he went
12 with [REDACTED] to Kalama for gas, leaving Butts near the motorhome. When they were
13 returning, they were stopped by a Cowlitz Deputy Sheriff for a bad tail light. After the traffic stop the
14 Deputy continued up Kalama River Rd for a complaint about a motorhome. Michael and [REDACTED] tried to
15 fix the taillight and then drove by the deputy's vehicle that was positioned towards Butts's motorhome.
16 He claimed they continued past the scene to Michael's residence. Michael denied seeing any people at
17 the motorhome or the Deputy's car when they drove by. Michael Veatch's cell phone was collected and
18 logged as Evidence Item #117 with Clark County Sheriff's Office case number 19-3549 at the Clark

20 his contact with detectives Michael Veatch provided his cell phone number as [REDACTED] The phone

23 gave a similar statement as Michael Veatch. He said when they passed the motorhome on Fallert Rd he
24 saw the deputy's car there. [REDACTED] described the Deputy as standing near his car with his gun out

29 towards Fallert Rd. They were stopped by the deputy on Kalama River Rd. [REDACTED] stated they had been
30 listening to the police scanner and knew the deputy was headed to the motorhome on Fallert Rd. After
31 the deputy left the traffic stop, Michael Veatch used his cell phone to call Brain Butts and warn him the
32 deputy was on his way. [REDACTED] stated when they drove by the deputy he had his gun out and was
33 yelling at the motorhome. [REDACTED] said they were waived through by the Deputy and continued up to
34 the Veatch house where they were told about the gunshots. [REDACTED] would later tell detectives
35 that when [REDACTED] and Michael Veatch arrived at her house, [REDACTED] told her they had "driven past a bad
36 scene" and further stated there was a cop down. [REDACTED] cell phone was collected and
37 logged as Evidence Item #118 with Clark County Sheriff's Office case number 19-3549 at the Clark

1 County Evidence Unit located at 812 W. 11th St, Vancouver, Clark County, State of Washington. During
2 his contact with detectives Donald Grandchamp provided his cell phone number as [REDACTED] The
3 number was confirmed by calling the cell phone collected from Grandchamp.

4 During the large scale manhunt for Brian Butts at approximately 0600, Woodland PD contacted
5 [REDACTED] sleeping in his car near the dead end of China Garden Road. He was briefly interviewed
6 and released. Later investigation [REDACTED] was contacted by detectives after he was reported to
7 have made suspicious statements in a McDonald's drive-thru about the police thinking he was the one
8 who murdered a deputy. [REDACTED] was interviewed and admitted he knows Brian Butts from prison. He
9 stated he last saw Brian two days ago. [REDACTED] gave his cell phone number as [REDACTED]
10 told detectives he lives in Longview with his girlfriend. On 4/13/19 he was in a fight with his girlfriend
11 and he left to "cool off." He said he drove to China Garden Mountain, which is one of the places he goes

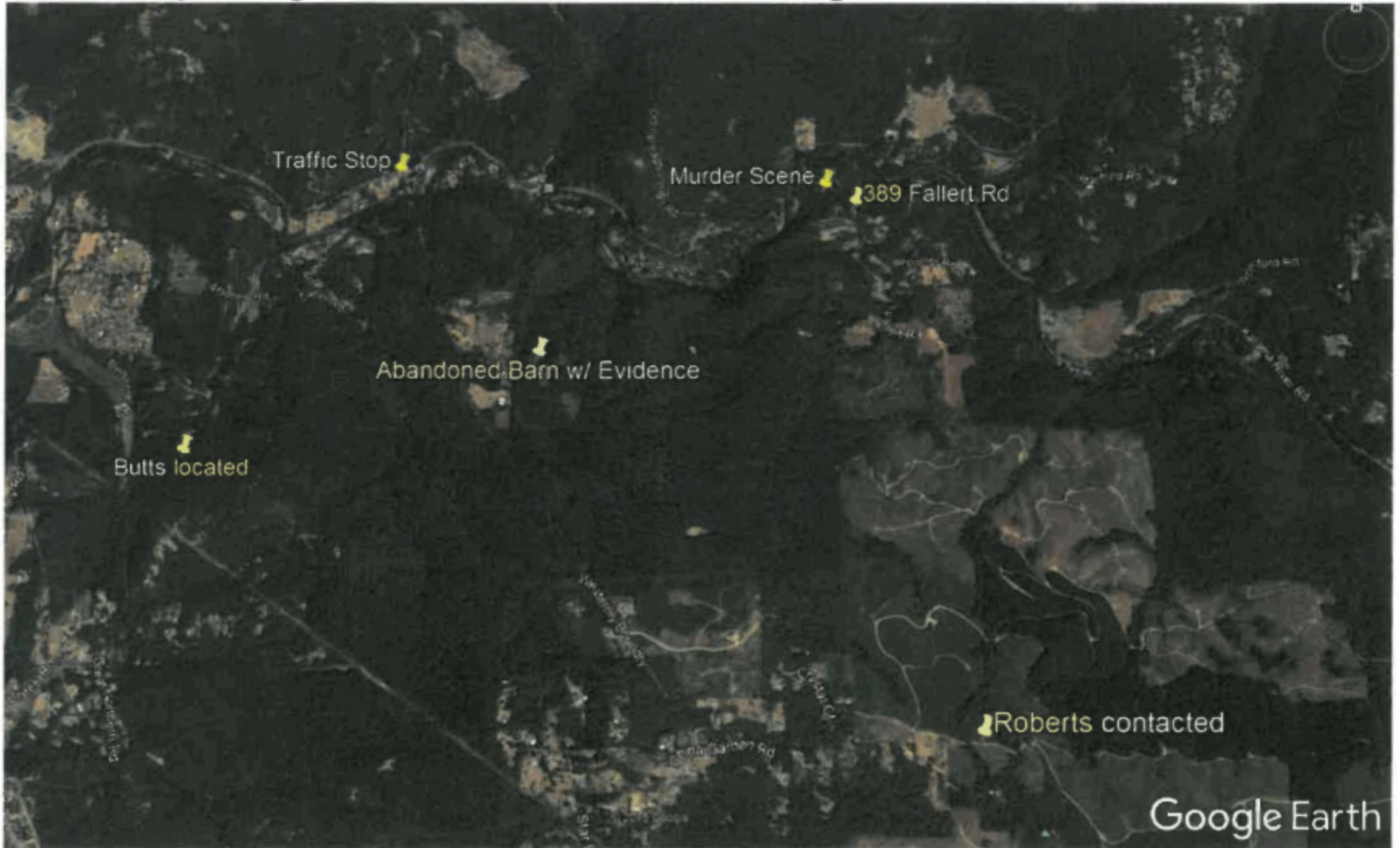

15 residence in Longview. Local deputies also noted that he was located near a large communications
16 tower which has flashing lights that can be seen for miles. It is surmised that [REDACTED] was there to pick
17 up Butts, who could attempted to use the flashing communications tower as a navigational beacon in
18 the large wooded area. This plan would have required some ability to communicate from Butts to
19 [REDACTED] either through the direct use of Butt's own cell phone or through another phone Butts had
20 access to including Michael Veatch's cell phone, Matthew Veatch's cell phone, [REDACTED]
21 cell phone and the Veatch house phone.

29 contacted Roberts to wait on China Garden Rd to assist in his escape.

30 On 04/14/19 at approx. 1900 hours information was received by Cowlitz County of a suspicious
31 person at the 400 block of Spencer Creek Road. The suspicious person was contacted by two Kelso
32 Police officers and an armed confrontation ensued. The suspicious person matched the physical
33 description provided by Deputy DeRosier of the person who shot him. Brian Butts was identified as the
34 male killed by officers during the confrontation.

4 During interviews with both Matthew Veatch and [REDACTED] provided detectives with [REDACTED]
5 [REDACTED] as the home phone number for the Veatch residence at [REDACTED]. A search
6 of the Kalama Telephone Company online Telephone Directory lists "Veatch C" for [REDACTED] at [REDACTED]
7 [REDACTED]. The area where these incidents took place has limited cell phone coverage. During
8 this investigation, communication using cell phones by the investigators was not reliable. It is likely
9 suspects in this investigation would have used the house phone landline to communicate. Witnesses

3 A search warrant was also served on a white Chevrolet S10 pickup truck parked next to the
4 motorhome where Deputy DeRosier was shot. Brian Butts was reported to be driving the vehicle earlier
5 in the day on 4/13/19. A wallet belonging to Brian Butts was found in the vehicle along with a cell phone
6 believed to belong to Brian Butts. The cell phone was collected and logged as Evidence Item #33 with
7 Clark County Sheriff's Office case number 19-3549 at the Clark County Evidence Unit located at 812 W.
8 11th St, Vancouver, Clark County, State of Washington.

9 On 4/18/19 Detectives Justin Messman and Fred Neiman interviewed [REDACTED] is

I am Deputy Sheriff with the Clark County Sheriff's Office; I have been so employed since January 2014. I had been a Reserve Deputy for 4 years and have completed 480 hours of Reserve Deputy Law Enforcement Training. While employed by the Clark County Sheriff's I attended the Basic Law Enforcement Academy in Burien Washington. While at the Criminal Justice Training Center I received approximately 720 hours of Basic Law Enforcement Training. Upon completion of my academy training, I completed a three and a half month Field Training program where I was instructed by veteran deputies. This training included the investigations of crimes of abuse, domestic violence and assault.

I have been assigned and have had the opportunity to work all patrol shift assignments giving me a wide array of law enforcement experience and encounters. In this capacity I have been involved in numerous cases ranging from child abuse, assaults, kidnaping, domestic violence and other crimes. I am also a certified Field Training Officer (FTO) where I train and observe newly hired deputies. I worked as a patrol Deputy until April 2017. Following my patrol assignment, I was assigned to the Clark County Sheriff's Office Major Crimes Unit as a Detective. While assigned to the Major Crimes Unit I received addition training Homicide Investigation, Crime Scene Photography, and interview techniques. As a MCU Detective I have worked numerous investigations of crimes including homicide, robbery, forgery and neglect.

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT:

The facts set forth in this affidavit are based on my own personal knowledge; knowledge obtained from other individuals during my participation in this investigation, including other law enforcement officers; interviews of cooperating witnesses; review of documents and records related to this investigation; communications with others who have personal knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; and information gained by my training and experience.
