On 4/13/2019 On a neighbor, observed three males working on a notorhome on Fallert Rd at approximately 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM. One of the males was later identified as Brian Butts. Another male was recognized as Michael Veatch. At 2129 hrs, Cowlitz County Deputy Sheriff Justin DeRosier is dispatched to a parking complaint of a motorhome blocking the roadway near the 100 block of Fallert Rd, Cowlitz County, Washington.

While driving to the motorhome parking complaint, at 2159 hrs Deputy DeRosier performs a traffic stop on a white Chevrolet pickup truck near the 1000 block of Kalama River Rd. During the course of the traffic stop Deputy DeRosier identifies the driver as Michael Veatch and the passenger as the traffic stop Deputy DeRosier identifies the driver as Michael violation and Deputy DeRosier continues up Kalama River Rd to the motorhome parking complaint on Fallert Rd.

At approximately 2211 hours, Deputy DeRosier arrived at the complaint of a motorhome blocking the roadway near the 100 block of Fallert Rd, Cowlitz County, Washington. Within minutes he reported he had been shot. He described the fleeing suspect to responding deputies. Deputy DeRosier succumbed to gunshot injuries and died at the hospital. He was later determined to have been shot multiple times in the torso.

1 Responding police officers located a motorhome and a white Chevy S10 pickup at the shooting scene. The registered owner of the motorhome was contacted who stated it had been 2 given to Brian Butts. The entire Kalama River Rd area was contained and a large scale 3 manhunt was conducted in the area. At approximately 0200 hours Matthew Veatch was located 4 5 near the dead end of Modrow Rd. He was disheveled and muddy. Detectives conducted several recorded interviews with Matthew Veatch during which he was read the Miranda 6 7 Warning twice. Matthew told them he was at his residence, when he heard what sounded to be gunshot last night. Minutes later his brother, Michael Veatch, 8 arrived in a vehicle. He appeared more serious than normal. Approximately 10 minutes after 9 10that Brian Butts arrived from the bushes to their residence. He appeared dirty and stated he needed to get out of there. Matthew said his mom was standing outside with Matthew 11 when Butts walked out of the woods asking for help. Matthew observed a handgun in Brian's 12 front pocket. Matthew said Butts gave him a pistol to "get rid of" and Matthew placed the 13 14 firearm in a locked cabinet in his room with the intention of disposing of the weapon later. 15 Detectives would later locate the firearm in Matthew Veatch's room and learn it had previously been reported stolen. 16 17 were now Michael and Matthew At the Veatch residence located at 18 Each of them had different Veatch. 19 accounts of Brian Butts' arrival. (said she never saw Butts at their home, but Matthew 20 said Cheryl was standing outside with Matthew when Butts walked out of the woods asking for 21 help. They all reported hearing police sirens in the area. 22 and Michael Veatch ran down to the motorhome to assist Butts after hearing the gunshots. 23 Matthew admitted to leading Brian Butts on foot away through the woods to escape. Matthew 24 reported they walked through the dark woods for several hours before separating near Modrow 25 Rd. Matthew stated he did not know where Butts went after Matthew was contacted by Law 26 Enforcement near Modrow Rd. 27

On 4/14/19 Michael Veatch was contacted at He stated he had tried to 29 help Brian Butts with a broken down motorhome on Fallert Rd the previous day on 4/13/19. 30 Michael said he went with Donald Grandchamp to Kalama for gas, leaving Butts near the 31 motorhome. When they were returning, they were stopped by a Cowlitz Deputy Sheriff for a 32 bad taillight. After the traffic stop the Deputy continued up Kalama River Rd for a complaint 33 about a motorhome. Michael and Donald tried to fix the tail light and then drove by the 34 deputy's vehicle that was positioned towards Butts's motorhome. He claimed they continued 35 past the scene to Michael's residence. Michael denied seeing any people at the motorhome or 36 the Deputy's car when they drove by. Michael Veatch's cell phone was collected and logged as 37 Evidence Item #117 with Clark County Sheriff's Office case number 19-3549 at the Clark 38 County Evidence Unit located at 812 W. 11th St, Vancouver, Clark County, State of 39 Washington. 40 41 42

He said when they passed the 2 motorhome on Fallert Rd he saw the deputy's car there. 3 standing near his car with his gun out and said he could hear the Deputy giving commands to 4 5 the occupants in the motorhome. 6 7 On 4/15/19 p was interviewed again by Detectives. Donald admitted he was trying to help Brian Butts move the motorhome to the Veatch residence at 389 8 Fallert Rd. After the motorhome broke down they drove to Kalama for gas. He said Michael 9 Veatch and he drove back towards Fallert Rd. They were stopped by the deputy on Kalama 10 stated they had been listening to the police scanner and knew the deputy was River Rd. 11 headed to the motorhome on Fallert Rd. After the deputy left the traffic stop, Michael Veatch 12 used his cell phone to call Brain Butts and warn him the deputy was on his way. stated 13 when they drove by the deputy he had his gun out and was yelling at the motorhome. I 14 said they were waived through by the Deputy and continued up to the Veatch house where they 15 would later tell detectives that when were told about the gunshots. and 16 Michael Veatch arrived at her house, I told her they had "driven past a bad scene" and 17 further stated there was a cop down. cell phone was collected and logged as 18 Evidence Item #118 with Clark County Sheriff's Office case number 19-3549 at the Clark 19 County Evidence Unit located at Clark County, State of 20 Washington 21 22 During the large scale manhunt for Brian Butts, Woodland PD contacted 23 sleeping in his car on China Garden Road. He was briefly interviewed and released. Later 24 investigation found that] is a known acquaintance of Butts and that they had been in 25 admitted that he had contact with Butts just 2 days earlier. He denied prison together. 26 any later contact as well as denying that he had Butts' phone number or knowing how to contact 27 him. 28 29 There are only two roads that lead from the area of the murder, Kalama River Rd and 30 Spencer Creek Rd. China Garden Rd is south of the area where the murder occurred. However 31 China Garden Rd can also be used to escape the area. There are no direct roads between 32

Spencer Creek Rd and China Garden, but there is a clear trail under and along the power lines that lead from Spencer Creek to China Garden Rd. Butts' was located near 441 Spencer Creek Rd that is only 600 yards from the power line trail leading south. It is likely that Butts contacted to wait on China Garden Rd to assist in his escape.

On 04/14/19 at approx. 1900 hours information was received by Cowlitz County of a suspicious person at the 400 block of Spencer Creek Road. The suspicious person was contacted by two Kelso Police officers and an armed confrontation ensued. The suspicious person matched the physical description provided by Deputy DeRosier of the person who shot him. Brian Butts was identified as the male killed by officers during the confrontation.

A search warrant was also served on a white Chevrolet S-10 pickup truck parked next to the motorhome where Deputy DeRosier was shot. However, a more definitive way to determine the possessor of a device is to 3 examine how the device is used over a period of days or weeks. Such records, including call 4 5 detail records, location information, text messages if available, and similar data files, can show consistent patterns of usage that will help determine the user of the device. Examination of all 7 this data is necessary to accurately determine who possessed the device at dates and times 8 critical to the investigation. 9

1 2 Evidence relating to the crimes of: 3 Murder in the First Degree in violation of RCW 9A.32.030, 4 Rendering Criminal Assistance in the First Degree in violation of RCW 9A.76.070 5 6 **EXPERTISE OF AFFIANT:** 7 8 I am Deputy Sheriff with the Clark County Sheriff's Office; I have been so employed since January 9 2014. I had been a Reserve Deputy for 4 years and have completed 480 hours of Reserve Deputy Law 10 Enforcement Training. While employed by the Clark County Sheriff's I attended the Basic Law 11 Enforcement Academy in Burien Washington. While at the Criminal Justice Training Center I received 12 approximately 720 hours of Basic Law Enforcement Training. Upon completion of my academy training, 13 I completed a three and a half month Field Training program where I was instructed by veteran deputies. 14 This training included the investigations of crimes of abuse, domestic violence and assault. 15 16 I have been assigned and have had the opportunity to work all patrol shift assignments giving me 17 a wide array of law enforcement experience and encounters. In this capacity I have been involved in numerous cases ranging from child abuse, assaults, kidnaping, domestic violence and other crimes. I am 18 19 also a certified Field Training Officer (FTO) where I train and observe newly hired deputies. I worked as a 20 patrol Deputy until April 2017. Following my patrol assignment, I was assigned to the Clark County 21 Sheriff's Office Major Crimes Unit as a Detective. While assigned to the Major Crimes Unit I received 22 addition training Homicide Investigation, Crime Scene Photography, and interview techniques. As a MCU 23 Detective I have worked numerous investigations of crimes including homicide, robbery, forgery and 24 neglect. 25 26 **PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT:** 27 28 The facts set forth in this affidavit are based on my own personal knowledge; knowledge

29 obtained from other individuals during my participation in this investigation, including other law 30 enforcement officers; interviews of cooperating witnesses; review of documents and records related to 31 this investigation; communications with others who have personal knowledge of the events and 32 circumstances described herein; and information gained by my training and experience. 33

10 traffic stop on a white Chevrolet pickup truck near the 1000 block of Kalama River Rd. During the course 11 of the traffic stop Deputy DeRosier identifies the driver as Michael Veatch and the passenger as

12 He gives them a verbal warning for a traffic violation and Deputy DeRosier continues up

13 Kalama River Rd to the motorhome parking complaint on Fallert Rd.

At approximately 2211 hours, Deputy DeRosier arrived at the complaint of a motorhome blocking the roadway near the 100 block of Fallert Rd, Cowlitz County, Washington. Within minutes he reported he had been shot. He described the fleeing suspect to responding deputies. Deputy DeRosier succumbed to gunshot injuries and died at the hospital. He was later determined to have been shot multiple times in the torso.

19 Responding police officers located a motorhome and a white Chevy S10 pickup at the shooting 20 scene. The registered owner of the motorhome was contacted who stated it had been given to Brian 21 Butts. A search of Longview Police Department police reports involving Brian Butts indicated his cell 22 phone number is the entire Kalama River Rd area was contained and a large scale 23 manhunt was conducted in the area.

At approximately 0200 hours Matthew Veatch was located near the dead end of Modrow Rd. He was disheveled and muddy. Detectives conducted several recorded interviews with Matthew Veatch during which he was read the Miranda Warning twice. Matthew told them he was at his residence, when he heard what sounded to be gunshot last night. Minutes later his

- 28 brother, Michael Veatch, arrived in a vehicle. He appeared more serious than normal. Approximately 10 29 minutes after that Brian Butts arrived from the bushes to their residence. He appeared dirty and stated 30 he needed to get out of there. Matthew said his mom was standing outside with Matthew when 31 Butts walked out of the woods asking for help. Matthew observed a handgun in Brian's front pocket.
- 32 Matthew said Butts gave him a pistol to "get rid of" and Matthew placed the firearm in a locked cabinet
- 33 in his room with the intention of disposing of the weapon later. Detectives would later locate the


There are only two roads that leave from the area which was contained by the man hunt for the murderer, Kalama River Rd and Spencer Creek Rd. China Garden Rd is south of the area where the 25 murder occurred, however China Garden Rd could be used to escape the area via overland hiking. There are no direct roads between Spencer Creek Rd and China Garden, but there is a clear trail under and 26 27 along the power lines that lead from Spencer Creek to China Garden Rd. Butts' was located near 441 Spencer Creek Rd that is only 600 yards from the power line trail leading south. It is likely that Butts 28 29 contacted Roberts to wait on China Garden Rd to assist in his escape.

1 2 I am Deputy Sheriff with the Clark County Sheriff's Office; I have been so employed since January 2014. I had been a Reserve Deputy for 4 years and have completed 480 hours of Reserve Deputy Law 3 Enforcement Training. While employed by the Clark County Sheriff's I attended the Basic Law 4 Enforcement Academy in Burien Washington. While at the Criminal Justice Training Center I received 5 approximately 720 hours of Basic Law Enforcement Training. Upon completion of my academy training, 6 I completed a three and a half month Field Training program where I was instructed by veteran deputies. 7 8 This training included the investigations of crimes of abuse, domestic violence and assault. 9 10 I have been assigned and have had the opportunity to work all patrol shift assignments giving me a wide array of law enforcement experience and encounters. In this capacity I have been involved in 11 12 numerous cases ranging from child abuse, assaults, kidnaping, domestic violence and other crimes. I am also a certified Field Training Officer (FTO) where I train and observe newly hired deputies. I worked as a 13 14 patrol Deputy until April 2017. Following my patrol assignment, I was assigned to the Clark County Sheriff's Office Major Crimes Unit as a Detective. While assigned to the Major Crimes Unit I received 15 addition training Homicide Investigation, Crime Scene Photography, and interview techniques. - 1 DeRosier is dispatched to a parking complaint of a motorhome blocking the roadway near the 100 block
- 2 of Fallert Rd, Cowlitz County, Washington.
- While driving to the motorhome parking complaint, at 2159 hrs Deputy DeRosier performs a traffic stop on a white Chevrolet pickup truck near the 1000 block of Kalama River Rd. During the course of the traffic stop Deputy DeRosier identifies the driver as Michael Veatch and the passenger as Donald Grandchamp. He gives them a verbal warning for a traffic violation and Deputy DeRosier continues up Kalama River Rd to the motorhome parking complaint on Fallert Rd.
- 8 At approximately 2211 hours, Deputy DeRosier arrived at the complaint of a motorhome 9 blocking the roadway near the 100 block of Fallert Rd, Cowlitz County, Washington. - 13 Responding police officers located a motorhome and a white Chevy S10 pickup at the shooting scene. The registered owner of the motorhome was contacted who stated it had been given to Brian 14 15 Butts. The entire Kalama River Rd area was contained and a large scale manhunt was conducted in the area. At approximately 0200 hours Matthew Veatch was located near the dead end of Modrow Rd. He 16 17 was disheveled and muddy. Detectives conducted several recorded interviews with Matthew Veatch during which he was read the Miranda Warning twice. Matthew told them he was at his residence, 18 19 when he heard what sounded to be gunshot last night. Minutes later his 20 brother, Michael Veatch, arrived in a vehicle. He appeared more serious than normal. Approximately 10 21 minutes after that Brian Butts arrived from the bushes to their residence. He appeared dirty and stated 22 he needed to get out of there. 19 I know from training and experience people often communicate with each other by phone to include cellular phones. Suspect(s), victim(s), and witnesses(s) use their phones before, during and after 20 21 a crime. The history of phone calls with the phone company/carrier and in the electronic memory of a 22 cellular phone is a useful aid in identifying additional suspects or witnesses. Call histories can confirm or 23 refute statements by the suspect(s), victim(s) and witnesses. Also, phone call records can establish a 24 time line of contacts made by the suspect(s) or victim(s). Many modern cellular telephones transmit 25 their locations by using built in GPS or directions from cellular towers. Cellular service providers often 26 retain this data which can show a location of a phone over time.

A cellular telephone (cell phone) communicates via radio waves, typically via antenna towers (also known as "cell towers.") In order to transmit or receive calls and data, a cell phone must be connected to a cellular service provider's network. These communications can include traditional telephone calls, voice over Internet conversations (VoIP), text, email, peer-to-peer communications (devices communicating directly with each other), communications using social networking websites, and other communications using the internet. Depending on the service provider and the device used by the customer/subscriber, these communications can use a variety of bands/frequencies.

Service providers retain information about cellular telephone signals and transactions at each tower or satellite, whether or not a particular device sent or received any communication.
