To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to you today to appeal the response to my FOIA request 2019-ICFO-02002, which requested copies of the code implementing the Risk Classification Assessment (RCA), which was filed on August 1, 2018. [Please see the attached *Original Request*.]

On June 23, 2019 I received a response from ICE FOIA Officer Catrina M. Pavlik-Keenan that stated that the records I requested were publicly available and directed me to two URLs where I would be able to find the information. [Please see the attached *Response*.]

Unfortunately, the URLs in that response are not publicly accessible, and thus I am unable to access the information that was to be provided to me through the FOIA request. When I click on the URLs I receive a notice that the site cannot be reached. I assume because these documents are actually contained on internal ICE server ([insight.ice.dhs.gov](http://insight.ice.dhs.gov)).

I have contacted ICE about the mistake, but have not heard anything since their initial response and am thus appealing on the grounds that they have erroneously responded that the information is publicly available and failed to conduct a comprehensive search.
