Re: Your Freedom of Information Law Request

Dear Mr. Aaron:

This letter is in response to the Freedom of Information Law request dated April 5, 2019, addressed to the Office of the Manhattan Borough President, wherein you ask for copies of records consisting of copies of correspondence to and from this office regarding the Dyckman Street bike lanes.

You are granted access to all disclosable documents responsive to your request. You are, however, denied access to other responsive records which may exist in our files which are exempt from disclosure pursuant to Public Officers Law ("POL") §87(2). Particularly, you are denied access to records that are exempt from disclosure pursuant to POL §87(2)(g) by virtue of their status as inter-agency or intra-agency materials which are not statistical or factual tabulations or data, instructions to staff that affect the public, final agency policy or determinations, or external audits. In connection with this exception, please be advised that all communications between the staff of the Manhattan Borough President and members or staff of the New York City Council, or with other government agencies is exempt from disclosure unless it falls within the specific exceptions to such exemption set forth in §87(2)(g).

Your request resulted in our compilation of a 22 pages documents. There is a statutory fee of \$0.25 per page. However, it is the policy of this office to forego collection the fee when the total amount is minimal. I therefore attach here the documents responsive to your request
