- Protect inmates/detainees, other employees, and members of the community who are threatened by the actions of any inmate/detainee
- Prevent escapes
- Maintain or regain order within the facility
- Protect property

Policies

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Policy & Definitions



Policies

- Use of force shall be employed only as a last resort when it reasonably appears that other alternatives are not feasible in a given situation
- Only the minimum force reasonably believed necessary should be used when a situation requires the use of force
- Force is never used to impose punishment
- Deadly force may only be used when firearms are expressly defined by a contract agreement.

Policies

Employee Responsibilities:

- All security and custody personnel are trained in methods of self-defense and use of force as a last resort to control inmates/detainees
- Each employee is responsible for being thoroughly familiar with all policies relating to the use of force and restraining devices
- Any violations of provisions of this policy shall be subject to disciplinary procedures

Policies

Basic Information

- Data regarding uses of force is confidential except for basic information, which includes:
 - The time and place of the incident
 - Names of inmate/detainee(s) and staff directly involved
 - A brief narrative of the incident
 - A brief description of any injuries sustained
 - Any civil action
 - Any criminal charge or administrative disciplinary action that may have been filed as a result of the incident

Definitions

Minor Use of Force: consists of any physical contact with an inmate/detainee in a confrontational situation to control behavior or to enforce order, including the placement of hands on the inmate/detainee in an effort to cause him to do anything involuntary.



Policy & Definitions



Definitions

Major Use of Force: A minor use of force becomes major under any of the following conditions:

- If restraints are applied in order to restore or preserve order unless such restraints are routinely required to assure control of an individual or group
- Chemical agents, batons, or other instruments are used
- If a canine is used to apprehend an inmate (take downs or bite holds) and touches an offender in an aggressive manner

Definitions

Major Use of Force

- If any offensive or defensive physical contact or hold is employed including any of the following:
 - physical blows
 - hard pushes
 - come along holds
 - pressure point techniques
 - defensive holds
 - bruise or wound is identified by the medical staff as of occurring due to minor force.

Policy & Definitions



Definitions

Deadly Use of Force: Major use of force becomes deadly force if authorized firearms are used

- Used when all other reasonable measures have failed to bring the situation under control



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Policy & Definitions



Definitions

Immediate Use of Force: The ability to instantly use force and/or apply restraints when the behavior of an offender constitutes a serious threat to the inmate, staff, others, or property to the institutional security and good order.

- Staff may respond with or without the presence or direction of a supervisor



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Policy & Definitions



Definitions

Calculated Use of Force: A situation involving an isolated area where the risk of immediate, direct threat to the inmate or to others is low. There is time for the deliberate use of force (e.g. application of restrains), staff must first determine if the situation can be resolved without resorting to force.



- Needs to be prearranged to be documented via video camera.

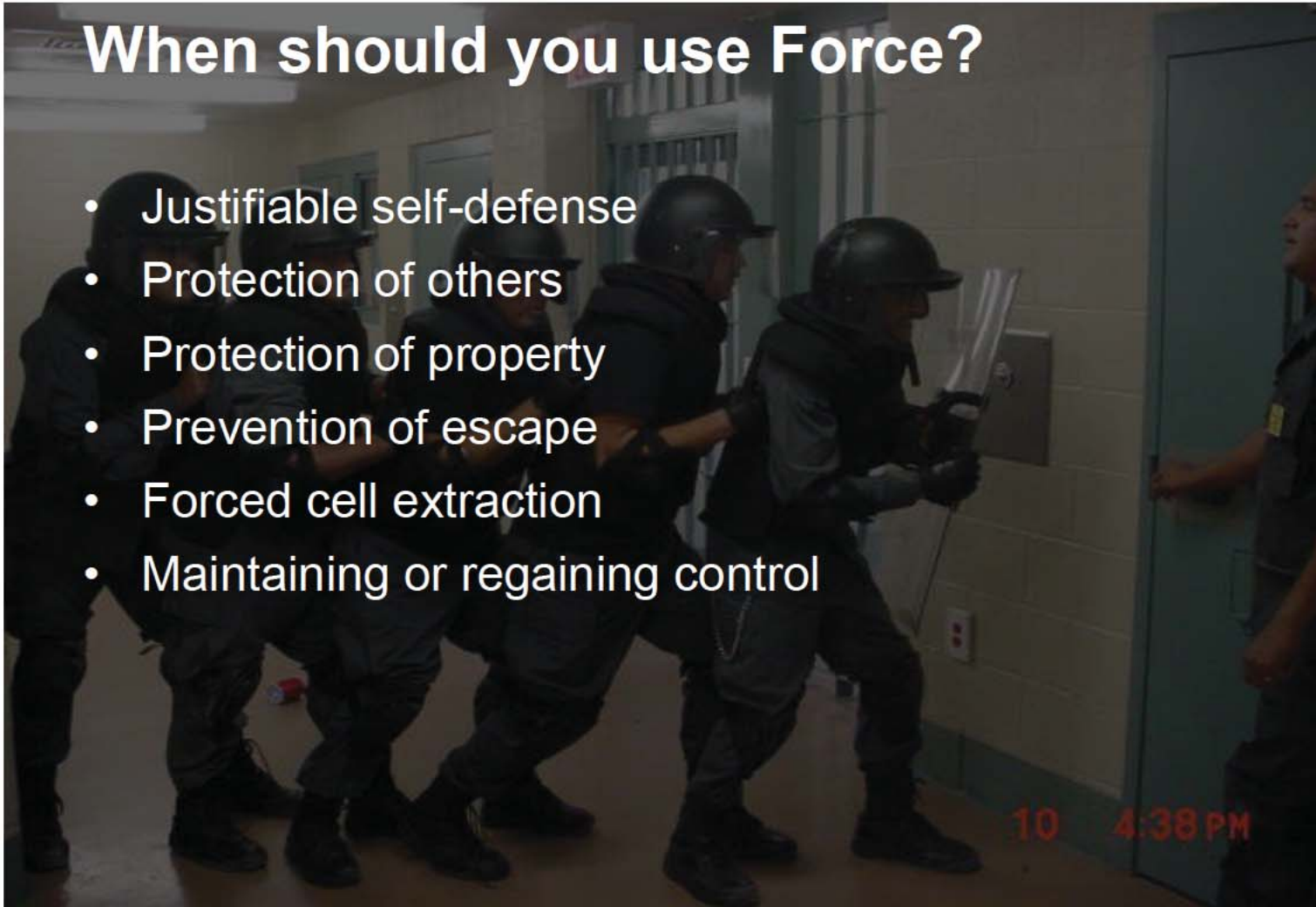

Use of Force Conditions



When should you use Force?

- Justifiable self-defense
- Protection of others
- Protection of property
- Prevention of escape
- Forced cell extraction
- Maintaining or regaining control



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Use of Force Conditions



Medical Staff

- Medical staff will be present during a major use of force whenever possible
 - Calculate Use of Force: Medical staff is altered before action occurs
 - Immediate Use of Force: Medical staff will be altered as soon as possible by a Supervisor

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Use of Force Conditions



Minor Use of Force



All of the following must exist for a minor use of force:

- Immediate compliance is necessary to preserve the order and safety and physical property of the institution, its employees, its inmates/detainees or others persons
- Verbal persuasion is impractical or fails to achieve compliance
- Standard disciplinary sanctions and procedures alone are insufficient to respond to the behavior
- The minor use of force can be reasonably expected to directly lead to a necessary level of compliance

Use of Force Conditions



Major Use of Force

When all of the following conditions exist:

- Imminent and immediate danger to employees, inmates, or other persons exist
- Minor use of force would not be sufficient to manage the situation
- All reasonable actions have been taken to stabilize the situation, including additional staff to help defuse the situation
- To prevent serious property damage and to prevent escape
- To maintain or regain control of the facility in the even of a:
 - Rebellion
 - Riot

Use of Force Conditions



Deadly Use of Force

- **Deadly force may only be used to prevent serious life threatening injury to a person or to prevent an escape when such response is specifically authorized by contract agreement**
- **Deadly force may be used when necessary:**
 - To quell a rebellion
 - To quell a riot or disturbance in which loss of life or serious life threatening injury to any person or escape is imminent
 - Where previous lesser means of major force have proved ineffective
- **Authorization for the use of deadly force shall be made by the senior officer on duty at the facility, or higher authority**

Force Options



Authorized Force Options

The authorized force options include:

1. Command Presence (“Show of Force”) – entering into a scene
2. Verbal Tactics – words, language
3. Empty-Handed Control or Weaponless Control
4. Mechanical Restraints
5. Chemical Agents
6. Baton or Impact Weapons
7. Deadly Force

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Force Options



Command Presence (“Show of Force”)

- The presence (“Show of Force”) of a staff person, particularly someone with authority or influence over the inmate/detainee, may be adequate control for non-threatening situations
- People act differently under different circumstances and a corrections officer's intervention into a situation creates a new set of circumstances



Force Options



Verbal Tactics

- To avoid needless violence, corrections officers must redirect human behavior with words of persuasion and advice
- Verbal controls include:
 - Listening to the inmate/detainee
 - Attempting to calm or reason with him
 - Explaining the consequences of his behavior



Force Options



Weaponless Control

- When words do not control, weaponless control should be used
- Weaponless control and techniques include:
 - Restraining holds
 - Impact or stunning blows
 - Pain compliance techniques to cause the person to cease resistance

Force Options



Mechanical Restraints

Mechanical restraints are temporary restraining devices and provide only limited control:

- handcuffs
- leg irons
- straitjackets
- soft restraints

IMPORTANT NOTE:
Inmates/detainees shall not be restrained to a stationary object (e.g., cell bars or fences)



Security staff shall remove restraints at:

- The direction of a security supervisor
- Once the inmate/detainee is calm
- In a secured area and the situation is defused

Force Options



Mechanical Restraints

- Mechanical restraints shall be used when reasonably necessary to include the following:
 - Transport outside the facility
 - Movement inside the facility in accordance with facility procedures
 - Under medical advice to prevent the inmate/detainee from attempting suicide or inflicting serious physical injury upon himself
 - When an inmate/detainee creates a disturbance, to include throwing projectiles or destroying property
 - As soon as possible when it appears that an inmate/detainee may become violent or disruptive

Force Options



Mechanical Restraints



Watch out for:

- Placing an inmate/detainee in a face down position following the application of restraints is strictly prohibited
- Restraints should never be applied in a way that causes discomfort, restricts the blood flow, or breathing of the inmate/detainee
- When an inmate/detainee resists or sustains injuries during the application of handcuffs, a Use of Force Report is required

Force Options



Four/five Point Restraints

- The Warden may authorize four/five point restraints if the inmate/detainee is harmful to himself
- The medical staff must be notified to assess the inmate/detainee's medical and mental health condition, and to advise whether the inmate/ detainee should be placed in a medical/mental health unit and is restrained in a four/five point position



Force Options



Four/five Point Restraints

- The following minimum procedures must be followed:
 - Direct visual observation must be continuous prior to obtaining approval from the medical staff
 - Subsequent visual observation must be made at least every 15 minutes
 - Restraint procedures are in accordance with guidelines approved by the designated health authority
 - Four/five point restraints should be used only in ***extreme instances*** and only when other types of restraints have proven to be ineffective

Force Options



Chemical Agents

- Chemical agents can effectively coerce, disorient, or incapacitate an individual for several minutes after contact when used properly
- Only staff properly trained in the use of chemical agents shall be allowed to deploy them
- Chemical agents shall be used only with the authorization of the Facility Administrator

Force Options



Chemical Agents

- Chemical agents may be useful to control the following situations:
 - In self-defense or in the defense of other persons
 - When an immediate threat to the security of any part of the facility exists
 - To quell a disturbance that is likely to develop into a serious disorder or riot
 - To prevent an escape
 - To support efforts to remove an inmate/detainee from a cell when he has established a barricade in the cell
 - To compel an inmate/detainee in a contained area to comply with direct orders

Force Options



Chemical Agents Usage Restrictions

No inmate/detainee shall be:

- Removed from his assigned cell and placed into another cell for the purpose of administering chemical agents
- Handcuffed for the purpose of administering chemical agents
- Stripped of his clothing or comfort items for the explicit purpose of administering chemical agents
- Returned to an area where chemical agents have been used until the area has been fully decontaminated



Force Options



Chemical Agents Deployment

1. Administer three one-second bursts at a distance of more than five feet unless circumstances deem otherwise
2. If the inmate/detainee continues to be disruptive, a second set of three one-second bursts may be administered after five minutes
3. If the second application is not effective, then an alternative avenue of force will be utilized

Force Options



Impact Weapons/Batons

- Use of the baton is proper in lawful situations requiring a degree of force greater than that readily provided by weaponless control techniques, but less than that provided by resorting to the use of deadly weapon
- The baton will be used only with the Warden's approval
- Only those staff properly trained in the use of intermediate/impact weapons shall utilize batons

Force Options



Impact Weapons/Batons

- Primary use of the baton is for defense and only then to prevent serious bodily injury to another person or to prevent serious property damage
- If it becomes necessary to strike an inmate/detainee in self defense or defense of another, the blow should be to a non-vital area, such as:
 - Clavicle (collarbone)
 - Knee (inside or out)
 - Arms (particularly the elbow)
- The baton should never be used to apply a choking technique
- The baton will be used only with the Warden's approval

Force Options



Deadly Force

- Employees are instructed to use firearms only after all reasonable non-deadly force alternatives have been exhausted
- When the use of deadly force is necessary, it shall be limited to the minimum degree of force necessary under the particular circumstances
- Only staff who are weapons qualified may draw or be authorized to use firearms in the course of their duties

Force Options



Deadly Force

These steps will be followed if a firearm is to be utilized:

1. Give a verbal warning
2. Aim to shoot center mass to render inmate/detainee incapable of continuing with the action prompting the use of deadly force
3. Staff utilizing deadly force shall consider the possibility of death or serious injury to the inmate/detainee, one's self or to other persons

Force Options



Deadly Force

- **Any Correctional Officer who willfully or wantonly fires or otherwise discharges his or her weapon carelessly/randomly may be prosecuted in accordance with state law**

Force Options



Deadly Force Incident

- When an officer is involved in a deadly force incident he/she must:
 1. Determine the physical condition of any injured person
 2. Render first aid when necessary
 3. Summon necessary medical aid
 4. Notify the supervisor of the incident and location
 5. Remain on the scene (unless injured) until investigators arrive
 6. Protect his weapon(s) for examination, treat it as potential evidence, and submit it for investigation
 7. Prepare a detailed report of the incident

Force Options



Firearms

Firearms will not be discharged:

- If not all options of force have been exhausted
- In any case where there is reason to believe that the life of an innocent bystander will be endangered
- From any moving vehicle unless it is to protect from imminent death or great bodily harm
- Until the officer is sure that an escape is occurring or has occurred and the person is an escapee
- As a warning, except during escapes, unless exceptional circumstances exist to justify the firing
- Until the employee is sure of the target and what lies beyond

Videotaping

Videotaping



Policy

Videotaping

- All authorized use of force incidents will be videotaped, if there is a reasonable opportunity to planned strategy in dealing with disruptive or violent inmates/detainees
- Videotaping will continue until the inmate/detainee is returned to secure housing, and when all restraints have been removed.

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Videotaping



Importance



- The video camera is one of the most important tools for a corrections officer
- It is a record that is irrefutable evidence of the event if used correctly
- Inmates/detainees know this and understand that they cannot change the story that a video camera shows

Use of Force

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Videotaping



Procedures

- Video equipment shall be requested any time an employee expects a confrontational situation or as soon as possible after an unexpected confrontational situation arises
- Video use of spontaneous and unanticipated use of force incidents, including spontaneous use of force chemical agents, will begin as soon as possible by a trained staff member
- Each Shift Supervisor will designate video camera operators on their shift

Videotaping



Procedures

- Upon being advised of the use of force incident the camera operator will begin videotaping uninterrupted, until the incident is under control and the inmate/detainee(s) is returned to secure housing
- In situations other than spontaneous use of force, a video camera will be deployed prior to the use of force
 - The inmate/detainee's behavior should be documented if at all possible

Videotaping



Identification

- **All staff** involved in the incident should be identified on camera by name and title
 - Extraction team members and CERT members will be identified prior to donning their helmet, for positive identification.
- The security supervisor or camera operator shall record a brief statement on the video equipment to include:
 - Date/time, unit/facility
 - Name/rank of security supervisor
 - Name/rank of video camera operator
 - Inmate/detainee's name and number
 - Location

Videotaping



Narrative

- A narrative explaining the incident should be videotaped if time permits followed by the introduction of the participants
- A narrative is most significant:
 - It not only shows what is happening but also explains the incident for everyone that views the tape
 - If called into the courtroom, tapes provide insight for a person that has never worked in a correctional setting to understand the event

Videotaping



Camera Operator Responsibilities

- The camera operator videotaping the incident shall ensure that the:



- Camera has a videotape ready to record
- Date and time display are correct
- Lighting is operational
- Camera is turned on as soon as possible or when an incident begins

Videotaping



Videotaping Incident

- Inmate/detainee and employee participants should stay in view and are recorded at all times so far as possible, except:
 - When directed by a supervisor to film something else
 - When the inmate/detainee is unclothed, he should be filmed from the waist up
 - Body cavity searches are not to be videotaped
 - Strip searches related to a major use of force, however, shall be videotaped without regard to nudity

Videotaping



Videotaping Incident

- The security supervisor shall ensure that a full front and back view of each inmate/detainee participant is videotaped following a major use of force, and while videotaping:
 - Ask the inmate/detainee if he has any injuries, if none are visible, as a result of the use of force
 - If the inmate/detainee does not respond to the question, security staff shall inform him that his non-response is interpreted to mean he does not have any injuries

Videotaping



Taping Termination

- Videotaping of a use of force incident shall continue until the incident is terminated by the security supervisor
- If the inmate/detainee is being transported off the unit/facility, videotaping may be discontinued once the inmate/detainee is placed in the transport vehicle and its doors secured
- Staff shall state on camera the reason for discontinuing videotaping

Videotaping



Medical Examination Taping

- Videotaping shall not interfere with life-saving techniques being administered by medical staff
- In order to comply with the of medical information confidentiality, videotaping of post use of force physicals will occur as follows:
 - Through a window of a closed door
 - With the privacy screen on the shower cage when the inmate/detainee is in the shower for decontamination purposes
 - The privacy screen in the exam room will be placed in order to afford privacy

Videotaping



Post Incident Actions

- The tape of the incident will be
 - identified and
 - logged and
 - stored for at *least two* years
- Tapes are confidential and should not be removed from the facility or released to the news media unless approved by both Regional and Corporate Offices

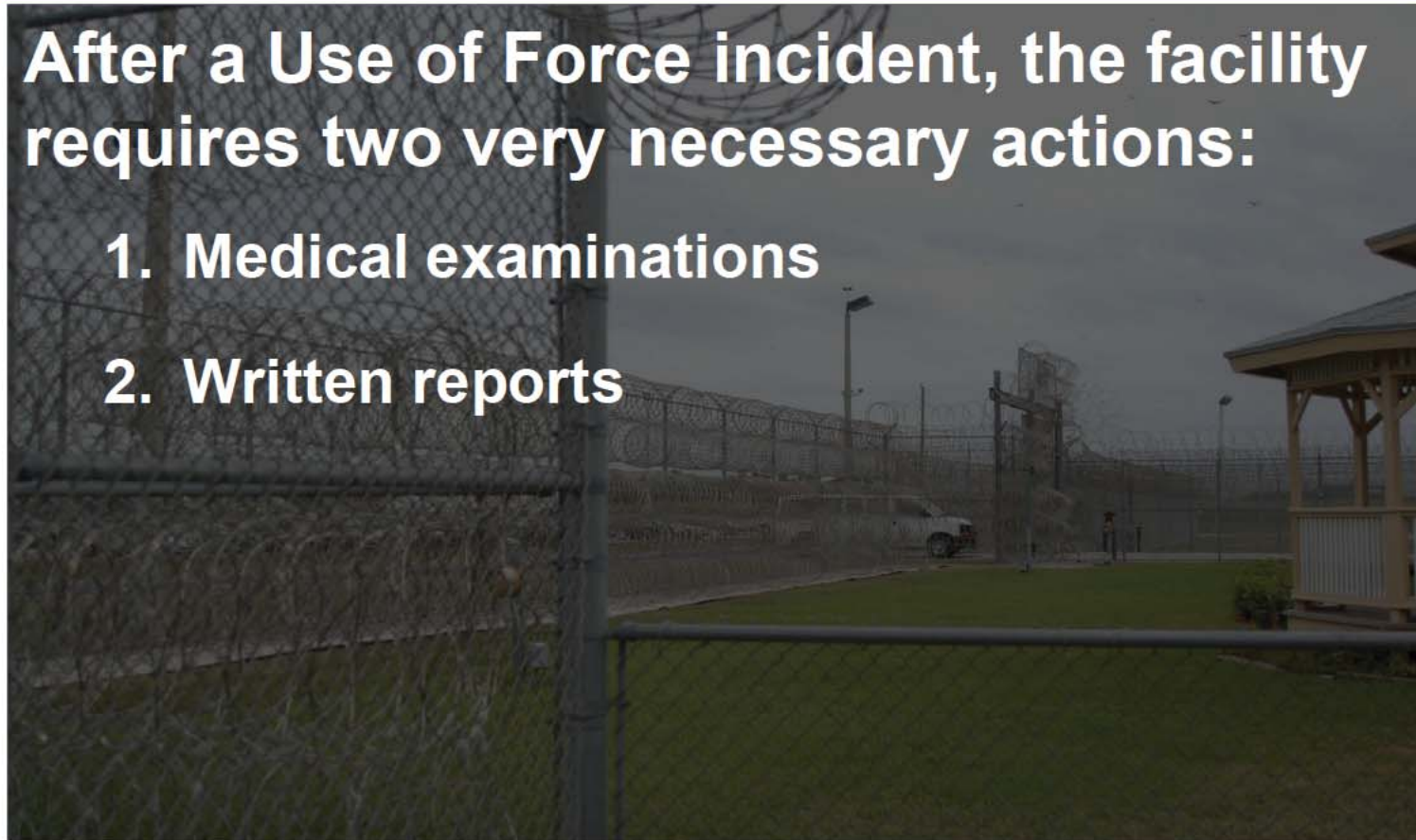
Post Incident Procedures



Key Activities

After a Use of Force incident, the facility requires two very necessary actions:

- 1. Medical examinations**
- 2. Written reports**



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Post Incident Procedures



Medical Examinations

- Immediately following any use of force medical staff will conduct physical examinations of all persons involved in a use of force



- This prevents the inmates/detainees from making any false claims and protects staff from liability issues
- Medical examinations are not based on inmate/detainee response; inmate/detainee participants will always be examined by medical staff

Post Incident Procedures



Medical Examination

- If it is impractical to take an inmate/detainee to the unit infirmary, or if he refuses to go, then medical staff will go to where he is located and conduct a physical examination
- If an inmate/detainee refuses to undergo an examination, the medical staff must at least provide a visual assessment of his condition
- If an employee desires treatment by a private physician, the employee will submit the name of the physician and facility to the medical staff

Post Incident Procedures



After Use of Chemical Agents

- The inmate/detainee will be examined as soon as possible after the chemical agent has been used, but not to exceed one hour after the first exposure
- The inmate/detainee will be monitored for any signs of respiratory distress, i.e. labored breathing, excessive or persistent coughing, or other signs of distress

Post Incident Procedures



After Use of Chemical Agents

- Staff will avoid placing the inmate/detainee in a lying position, either face down or face up
- The inmate/detainee will be maintained in a sitting or standing position for at least 45-60 minutes after the use of chemical agents
- The inmate/detainee will be re-assigned to a non-contaminated area

Post Incident Procedures



After Use of Chemical Agents

- Individuals and the area affected by the chemical agents shall be decontaminated as soon as possible
- Personnel and inmates/detainees will be decontaminated by flushing the contaminated areas with generous amounts of water (especially the eyes) for five to ten minutes or until the irritation is gone
- It is recommended not to rub affected area with cloth or apply anything other than water

Post Incident Procedures



After Use of Chemical Agents

- Inmates/detainees should be allowed and encouraged to shower and change both inner and outer wear for decontamination purposes
- If an inmate/detainee refuses to shower or change this will be documented on the Incident Report.
 - Medical will be advised in this instance
- Force shall not be used to decontaminate an inmate/detainee

Post Incident Procedures



Policy

Written Reports

- Written reports must be submitted to the Facility Administrator no later than the conclusion of the tour of duty whenever there is a:
 - Discharge of a firearm or other weapon
 - Use of chemical agents to control inmates/detainees
 - Use of force to control inmates/detainees, or
 - Inmate/detainee remaining in restraints at the end of the shift

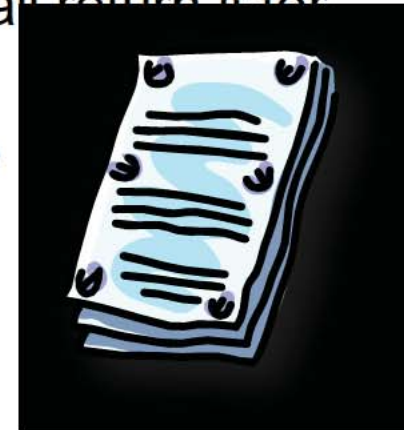


Post Incident Procedures



Written Reports

- Any employee who uses or observes the Use of Force must report the incident to his/her supervisor immediately
- It is the security supervisor's responsibility to provide forms to all persons (employees and inmates/detainees) required to report a use of force
- Upon collection of the forms, the security supervisor will ensure each one is complete
 - If incomplete, the security supervisor shall return it for completion
 - If not typed, use of force reports shall be legibly completed in black ink



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Use of Force

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Post Incident Procedures



Forms

- After a Use of Force, the following reports are required to be completed:
 - Employee Use of Force Report
 - Offender Participant Statement
 - Witness Statement
 - Employee
 - Inmate/detainee
 - Medical Statement

Post Incident Procedures



Employee Use of Force Report

- The employee use of force report will include:
 - An account of the events prior to the use of force
 - An accurate and precise description of the incident and reasons for employing force
 - A description of any injuries
 - A description of the type and amount of force used
 - control techniques employed
 - methods of restraint
 - areas of the body impacted, and
 - A description of the weapon or device utilized if any
 - Others present (i.e. inmates/detainees, employees, etc.) and describe their participation, if any
 - Any verbal orders given before or during the incident

Post Incident Procedures



Offender Participant Statement

- Once an offender participant has undergone a physical examination, the security supervisor will provide him with an Offender Participant Form
- If an inmate/detainee has difficulty completing the form, he may seek aid of fellow inmate/detainee or staff
 - The statement must be voluntary and
 - Include only information the offender provides

Post Incident Procedures



Witness Statement

- Each employee who witnesses the use of force on an inmate/detainee will complete the form
- The video camera operator will include a notation that he was the video camera operator
- If a medical staff member witnesses a use of force, he must complete the form
- Any other person who the security supervisor has reason to believe may have information, which could help explain what transpired, should complete the form

Post Incident Procedures



Witness Statement

- Each inmate/detainee who witnesses an application of force on another inmate/detainee shall be asked to complete the form
- If an inmate/detainee has difficulty completing the form, he may seek the aid of fellow inmates/detainees or staff employees; however,
 - The statement must be voluntary and
 - Include only information the offender provides

Post Incident Procedures



Medical: Use of Force Injury Report

- Following examination, medical staff shall complete a form on all employee and inmate/ detainee participants in a use of force incident
- Each injury sustained during the use of force shall be fully described
- If an employee uses a private physician, that information is included on the form
- The doctor must sign the medical report; if no injuries occur, a nurse can sign the medical report

Post Incident Procedures



Staff Responsibilities

- All written reports shall be submitted to the security supervisor no later than the conclusion of his/her shift
- Failure of any employee to accurately and completely report any incident where force was used may result in disciplinary action
- An employee shall not collaborate with another employee or with an inmate/detainee in order to write a statement

MANY OTHER OFFICERS ALONG WITH MYSELF STARTED PULLING THEM APART TO PLACE THEM IN GUFFS AND TAKE THEM OUTSIDE. EVEN THEN, ALL DETAINEES WERE NOT COMPLYING & REFUSING TO BE CUFFED. IT WAS A STRUGGLE TO GET THEM OUT BUT WE EVENTUALLY GOT IT DONE.




