This is an interim response to your 9 February 2019, Freedom of Information Act request documents relating to "Col (Ret) David Walker."

Your initial request dated 9 February 2019, was reviewed by SAF/IGS and determined to be properly withheld under the Freedom of Information Act (b)(7)(A) of Title 5, United States Code, Section(s) 552. FOIA exemption (b)(7)(A) permits the withholding of records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, when could cause some articulable harm which would be reasonably expected to interfere with ongoing, pending, or prospective law enforcement proceedings.

Since the initial determination, the investigation is complete and SAF/IGS is processing your request.

Our organization has a significant number of pending FOIA requests, which prevents us from making a response determination within 20 workdays, we have instituted multitrack processing of requests. Based on the information you provided, we have placed your request in the complex track.
