"I, [redacted] make the following free and voluntary statement to SA [redacted] who has identified himself as a Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. No threats or promises have been made to me and I understand this document could be used in a court of law. I am [redacted] old, have completed 14 years of education and can read and write the English language.

I had been working on the car for approximately 30 to 45 minutes when two unmarked Chicago Police Department cars pulled up across the street and slightly behind me. Each car had three detectives and all six detectives got out of the cars and approached me. I had never seen any of these individuals before. One of the detectives, later identified as Lt. (FNU) BUNDE W/M, early 40's, 6'1", 230 pounds, short red hair and a small mustache, who I would recognize again, asked me my name and at the same time placed a handcuff on my left wrist. I told the policemen my name was [redacted] and they then completed handcuffing my hands behind my back. The police officers said nothing more, guided me to the police car and placed me in the first car. Several of the officers were searching my [redacted]

[redacted] and also the [redacted] I would probably be able to recognize one or two of the officers who searched the cars. I was driven to the police station at 91st and Cottage Grove [redacted] I probably could not recognize the officer who drove us to the station.

"When we arrived at the police station, I was taken to the second floor and handcuffed to a ring in the holding room. I was handcuffed to this ring for several hours at which time a [redacted] (LNU) unhandcuffed me and took me into an adjoining room. Lt. BUNDE, [redacted] (LNU) and I were the only people in this room. I would recognize [redacted] (LNU) if I saw him again. [redacted] (LNU) was a white male approximately [redacted] years old. Both Lt. BUNDE and [redacted] (LNU) started asking me questions about a homicide and also wanted information about [redacted]. I didn't give Lt. BUNDE and [redacted] (LNU) any information and BUNDE finally said he was tired and told [redacted] to hold me until the next day. BUNDE said he would be back to torture me and give me an idea what the electric chair was like. I told BUNDE that I didn't know anything. BUNDE said he was going home to get a good nights sleep and would be back at the station the following day to get my confession. BUNDE also made the comment that this station always gets confessions out of [redacted] because [redacted] could not take pain. BUNDE said he would be back to get me and left the room. I was then placed in another room. About 6:30 - 7:00 am the next day [redacted] BUNDE arrived at the station about 8:30 - 9:00 am and told [redacted] and BUNDE came into the room where I was being held. BUNDE threw two chairs and took the chair I was sitting in and turned the chair over. BUNDE told me to [redacted]. BUNDE then left the room and returned about 10 to 15 minutes later. [redacted] pulled up a chair and asked me if I wanted to answer the questions I had been asked yesterday. I told BUNDE I didn't know anything about a murder. BUNDE then hit me on the right side of my face with the back of his right hand. I was hit about 20 to 25 times over a period of about 20 minutes. I was also hit twice over the head with a gun and kicked twice in the shoulders. BUNDE then left the room and when he returned unzipped my pants and told me he was going to stop me from fucking. BUNDE stuck something inside my pants and told me he would kill me if my attorney would show up at the station. I was then released from the police station. No charges were ever filed against me. I have read this page and four other hand written pages of this statement and now sign it because it is true.

A. I was picked up the night before and kept handcuffed in a room overnight in area 2. Lt. Burge told the officers to leave me there because he was going to come back in the morning and torture me. Lt. Burge got there at about 0800 hrs., and [redacted] and then he asked some other officers who she was. He asked [redacted] He came back into the room with me and said he had gotten pretty drunk before he got here. When he came in he threw two chairs at me and then he turned the chair over that I was sitting in and I fell on the floor. He told me to [redacted] He left out of the room again for a couple of minutes. When he came back into the room I was handcuffed to the wall and he pulled a chair up and sat down and asked if I was ready to cooperate. Then he started hitting me with the back of his fist on the right side of my face about 25 times while my hand was handcuffed to the wall. He said, "I don't know who let your [redacted] in here, but there ass is in hot water." He pulled his gun out and put it in about two inches from my face. He kept pulling a little on the trigger then he hit me on the head with the gun on the top right side of my head. He started to hit me again with the back of his fist and asked if it was aggravating, then he said, [redacted]

Q. Please tell me what occurred that you saw on 09 June 1982 at about 0930 hrs. while in the vicinity of Area 2 Police Headquarters?
A. I was there last night on 08 June 1982 at about 12 midnight. I did not see him at that time. The police told me that he was not there. I told them that I knew that he was there. Then I went back there this morning at about 6:45 A.M. I asked to see [REDACTED] and after the police officer checked I was allowed to go upstairs where I saw [REDACTED] handcuffed to a wall on a wall in a room. [REDACTED] told me that they were holding him on a case that the police said that he knew something about. [REDACTED] told me that he didn't know anything about the case. [REDACTED] looked fine at this time. [REDACTED] said that he was fine, but that he was glad that I was there because one of the officers said that he was going to come back and torture [REDACTED] if he didn't tell about the case. The officer said that he was going to get some equipment to torture [REDACTED] I told [REDACTED] that everything was alright because they wouldn't let me up here if they were going to do something to him. I stayed there until the officer came in. This officer told me that I had to get out of there. I immediately walked out of the room where [REDACTED] was. This officer started to walk away from me. I walked after him and I asked him if I could wait until my lawyer came. The officer said that he was Lt. Burge and that I couldn't wait, and that I should get out of his police station. I then went downstairs. I asked for the officer's name. I got his name and I left. I wanted to wait until my lawyer came. Then I saw [REDACTED] about an hour and a half later when he came to [REDACTED] house where I had gone to. And [REDACTED] told me that the police had blazed him. [REDACTED] face was all swollen at this time. He was shaking all over. He told me that Lt. Burge had done this to him. And I had observed that Lt. Burge had alcohol on his breath and that he had been drinking.

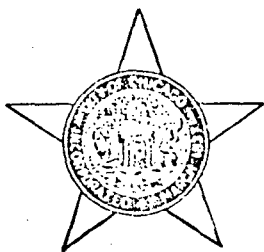

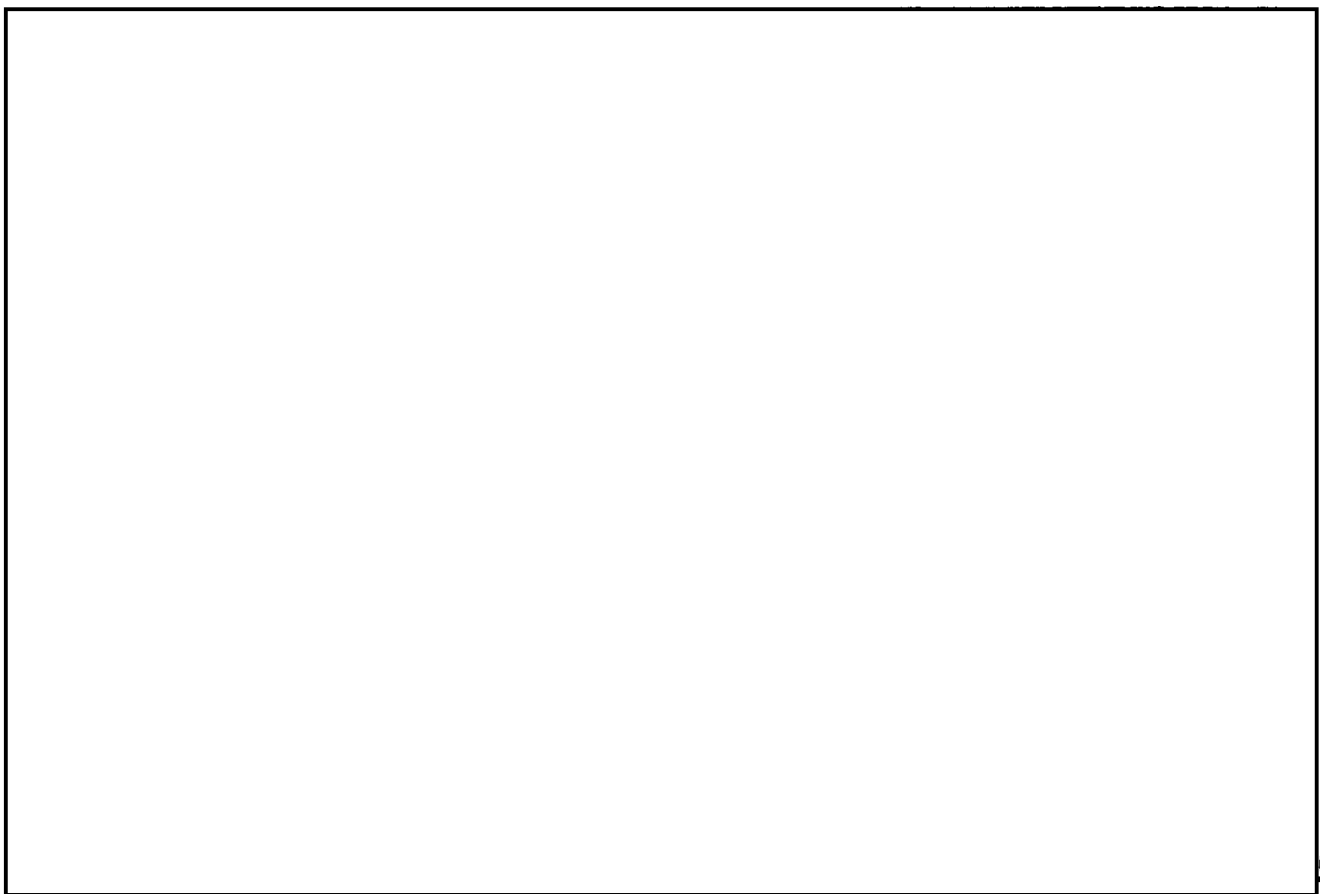

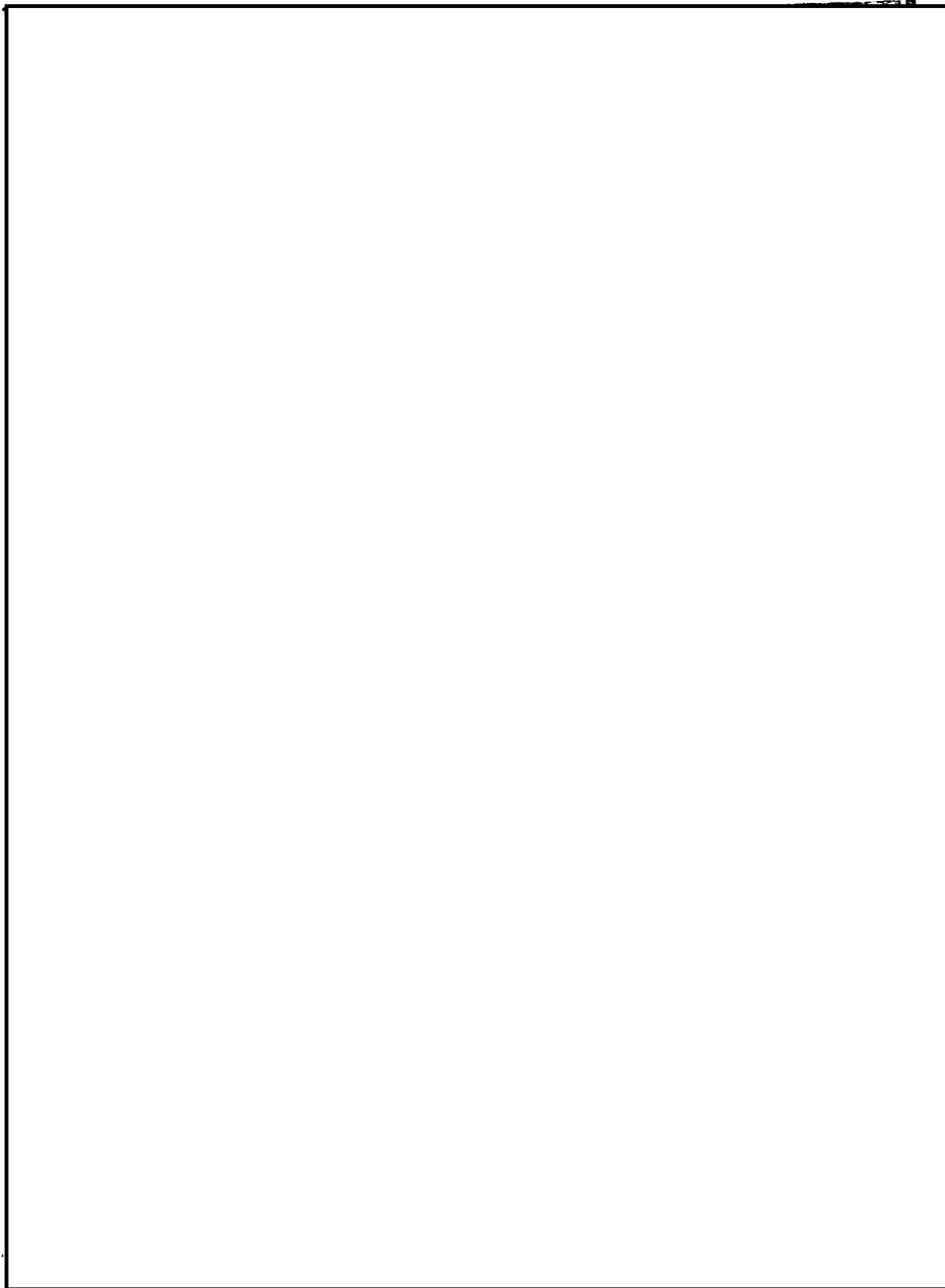
