I am unaware of any reason you would not be allowed to rent out your granny flat. Your parcel is zoned to allow a granny flat on your property. As long as you've gone through all the proper building permitting processes to build your granny flat, then you are able to rent it out. I am unaware of any regulation that would prohibit you from doing so.

If you'd like to learn more about all the requirements surrounding granny flats, the City developed a great handbook for homeowners like yourself.
