This letter is the Department of Education's response to your four requests, dated September 10, 2019, for information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Copies of your requests are enclosed with this letter.


Also, enclosed with this letter you will find one DVD containing 723 pages of documents that have been found responsive to your requests. Certain information, however, has been withheld according to the FOIA exemptions specified below:

- 1. Proprietary information has been withheld under exemption (b)(4) of the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552 of the FOIA;
- 2. Records or portions of records relating to certain intra-agency information is exempt from disclosure pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(5) of the FOIA. This exemption permits the withholding of inter- or intra-agency information that could be withheld under civil discovery, including information subject to the deliberative process, attorney-client, or attorney-work product privileges; and
- 3. Records or portions of records relating to personal information are exempt pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) of the FOIA. Disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

Please note that the Department's search yielded no responsive records for FOIA request # 19-02225-F.
