We are writing to appeal your decision under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) that "no responsive records were located" by the 1st Marine Division and the wider USMC for our request, DON-USMC-2019-009636 submitted through FOIA Online on July 30, 2019 (DON-USMC-2019-009636).

We have reason to believe, per reliable active duty military sources, that a report and or documents on this incident exists.

We once again request a thorough search for any records from administrative investigations (commonly referred to as "JAGMAN" investigations) and other investigation, relating to U.S. Marines Robert Zurheide and Brad Shuder killed during Operation Vigilant Resolve in or around Fallujah, Iraq in the winter or spring of 2004; and records from an investigation or report ordered by then-Lieutenant General Gregg Olsen into the deaths of Marines and injuries to others from 2nd Battalion, 1st Marine Division that may relate to actions taken by or ordered by Marines with the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines, including then-Marine Captain Duncan Hunter.

We look forward to your expeditions response.
