The Office of the Secretary FOIA office received your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, dated March 2, 2020, on March 2, 2020 and assigned it control number **OS-20-00353**. Please cite this number in any future communications with our office regarding your request.

Any and all written or electronic communications, including email attachments, sent or received by David Bernhardt that contain one or more of the following words or phrases: "ECPO", "ECMSHCP", "Collier", "Colliers", "Spilker", "Hunton", and/or "panther". This request seeks records produced since January 1, 2018.

Ten Workday Extension

Because we will need to search for and collect requested records from field facilities or other units that are separate from the office processing the request, the Office of the Secretary FOIA office is taking a 10-workday extension under 43 C.F.R. § 2.19.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of FOIA. *See* <u>5 U.S.C. 552(c)</u>. This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.

The 2007 FOIA amendments created the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS) to offer mediation services to resolve disputes between FOIA requesters and Federal agencies as a non-exclusive alternative to litigation. Using OGIS services does not affect your right to pursue litigation.
