on the amount of forgiveness allowed for each loan. This is a special feature of the PPP loans under Section 1106 of the CARES Act. To be clear, I request information on loans made under the PPP both as authorized under Section 1102 of the CARES Act and as authorized under future laws that extend the program. I also request information on Emergency EIDL Grants made possible under Section 1110 of the CARES Act and any future law. If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the act. I will also expect you to release all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any information or to deny a waiver of fees.

The PPP and EIDL programs collectively have been the focus of intense public interest since the program involves hundreds of billions of taxpayer dollars, directly affects tens of millions of Americans, and is taking place during a national emergency. The PPP program in particular has been the focus of controversy involving lending activity by the banks and the nature of the recipients.
