## Description

### Description

Pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. s. 552, I request loan level information about companies that received subsidies for SBA 7(a) loans under Section 1112 of the CARES Act, "Subsidy for Certain Loan Payments." The section enables the SBA to pay the principal, interest, and fees that are owed on specified loans for six months. In addition to the information the SBA commonly releases through its "SBA 7(a) & 504 loan data reports" on its FOIA website, for each loan, I request the beginning date of the 6-month period that the SBA paid the loan payments, the end date, and the amount

paid by the SBA under Section 1112. On 4/23/2020, I submitted a request about other SBA loans made under the CARES Act (Tracking number) SBA-2020-000914. If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the act. I will also expect you to release all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any information or to deny a waiver of fees.

**Expedited Justification** I am requesting expediting processing for this request under (f)(1)(iv) of the law: "An urgency to inform the public about an actual or alleged Federal Government activity, if made by a person primarily engaged in disseminating information." The SBA's lending programs collectively have been the focus of intense public interest since the programs involve hundreds of billions of taxpayer dollars, directly affects tens of millions of Americans, and is taking place during a national emergency.
