This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated March 24, 2020, to the United States Office of Personnel Management (OPM).

Your request seeks: “Copy of former Director Dale Cabaniss's resignation letter, from March 2019.” We are writing to respond to your request. After a thorough search of our files, it has been determined that OPM has no records responsive to your request. All records regarding Dale Cabaniss resides with the White House, you may file a FOIA request with the Office of Management and Budget for the records you are seeking.

The undersigned is responsible for this determination. You have the right to appeal this determination. Should you wish to do so, pursuant to 5 CFR 294.110, you must send a copy of your initial request, a copy of the letter denying the request, and a statement as to why you believe the denying official erred within 90 days from the date of this letter to:
