This is our final response to May 17-18, 2017 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests addressed to the NCI FOIA office; and received in this office, on May 17-18, 2017. You were informed that your requests were aggregated. You requested copies of the grant applications and progress reports or other supporting documents that were submitted by the applicants for the following: 1R43CA108391-01 and 1R43CA097851-01 (formally 1R44CA097851-01). You are also requesting a copy of grant application 2R44CA103406-02 awarded by the National Cancer Institute (NCI) of the National Institutes of Health (NIH).

Enclosed is 1 CD (equivalent to 187 pages) for the following grants: 1R43CA097851-01 (35 pages), 2R44CA097851-02 (62 pages), 5R44CA097851-03(33 pages), and 2R44CA103406-02 (57 pages). It is Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) policy to expunge all budget information, eRA common user names, consultant(s), square footage, number of employees, calendar months, percentage of efforts, dates of birth, social security numbers, working hours, letter to Center for Scientific Review, source of private support and any patentable or proprietary material wherever they appear throughout the grant material. This information has been removed from the enclosed material.

Requesters who ask for grant applications usually want to receive only material that will help in understanding the process that led to the awards, or to improve their own methods of drafting grant applications. Requesters usually do not want material that applicants believe would harm them if released. We have found that the spirit of the FOIA can be enhanced through a spirit of cooperation among requesters of materials and those who submitted the materials.

In this instance, we asked the grantee for advice concerning patent rights and other confidential commercial or financial information and the material that we are furnishing reflects that advice. If you feel that materials have been omitted that should have been made available to you, please write to me and I will consult with the NIH Freedom of Information Officer.

In reference to Grant# 1R43CA108391-01; those records have been destroyed. While we believe that an adequate search of appropriate files was conducted for the records you requested, you have the right to appeal this determination that no records exist which would be responsive to part of your request.
