HOUSE BILL NO. 1673

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO ANTONIO SIMPSON, OF TUNICA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Antonio Simpson, of Tunica County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction for the crime of armed robbery, on March 26, 1997, and
- 8 also convicted for the crime of aggravated assault on March 26,
- 9 1997, for which he was sentenced to six (6) years with each count
- 10 to run concurrently, in the custody of the Mississippi Department
- 11 of Corrections, followed by five (5) years probation.
- 12 He completed all terms and conditions of his sentence and was
- 13 discharged on March 3, 2003. The Legislature is informed that he
- 14 has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen
- 15 in a good and lawful manner.
- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after its passage.
